I have always encouraged our new dancers to dance often and to lots of different callers. It's all about repetition. That's what creates what is called "muscle memory". That being said, Mother Nature has not been cooperative, to say the least. Each time a dance gets cancelled, it puts another stretch of time between your time on the dance floor. Every time that happens, you think you won't remember how because it's been so long but it's important that you get back on the dance floor as soon as possible. The longer it stretches on, the harder it will be. Everyone started out as a new dancer and we're all willing to help you get over the rough patches. The more you dance, the easier it gets and the easier it gets, the more fun you will have. This would be a good way to get back into things.

If you have any questions, get in touch with Leann. We speak daily and she keeps me up to date on all the club happenings. She will be sending out the reminders for visitations and we request that you <u>please respond</u>, <u>whether you can go or not</u>. That helps us know if we have enough or need to cancel and allow those who said yes to make other plans.
