Teamwork is not only required, it is fun.

# OZARK LAKERS CELEBRATE 25TH ANNIVERSARY

## January 8, 2006

Can you imagine 27 couples taking square dance lessons all at one time? Six couples who lived in the Sunrise Beach and Laurie area and danced with the Camdenton Club wanted a club closer to home. They arranged for Norman Lyles to call and teach this big class in Laurie at the Laurie Terrace Mall beginning Sept. 7, 1980. The class graduated Jan. 11, 1981, and, with the six couples of square dancers, was organized as the Ozark Lakers Square Dance Club.

After graduation the Lakers moved to Sunrise Skateland at Laurie. Norman Lyles continued as the club caller. Members of the club became interested in round dancing and obtained cuers Al and Marge Brown to teach a class. The round dance class graduation in June 1982 started the club custom of alternating square and round dance tips at club dances.

In July 1982, Norman Lyles retired and the club chose Art Galvin to be their caller. The Browns retired from cuing and in 1988 Barb and Steve Skorupan were asked to cue and teach round dancing for the club. Art and Taw Huldah were with the Lakers until Art retired from calling in November 1995. They continue as honorary members of the club.

During these 25 years of square and round dancing, the club has participated in many social and civic events, conducted classes and demonstrations, and has become known as "the club with the friendly dancers."

The club is very fortunate to have three charter members, Hazel Saunders and Barb and Steve Skorupan, still dancing. Hazel and her late husband Chuck served as Missouri Federation presidents in 1992. In 1995 Barb Skorupan was inducted into the Missouri Federation Callers and Cuers Hall of Fame.

The Ozark Lakers moved in recent years from Skateland to the lower level hall of the Bank of Versailles in Laurie where they currently dance with guest callers on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month.

- Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4th celebration, fall festival, etc.)

Complete at least 2 of the following:

- 100% Booster Club – State Festival
- 1/2 or full page ad in Festival Book
- Have a National Caller dance
- Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- Have a current District officer from club membership
- Have a current State officer from club membership
- Conduct complete set of lessons, any level
- Visit at another district's dance – one square (8 dancers) minimum

**Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.**

A listing of all clubs that will receive HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the April issue of the *Doin's*.

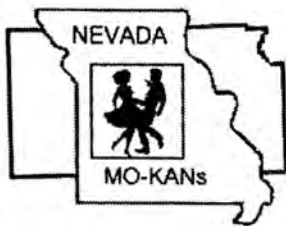

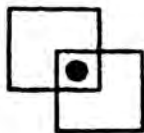

## Instructions for Registration (left side)

1. **Print legibly** all names, address, city, state, zip code, nation, and ages (the projected age on **June 21, 2006**) of youth (under eighteen) to ensure correct registration.
2. Correctly enter all amounts in the **Subtotals** including registration fee for each dancer plus quantity and amounts for all other materials. If tours are selected, complete and return the Tour Registration Form and payment with this registration.
3. **Important!** Daily schedules are only available with the purchase of a Program Book. Daily schedules will not be available separately at the Convention. Most delegates will want to purchase the Program Book.
4. **Correctly calculate Total** and include credit card information, (with signature), check or money order payable in U.S. funds, to the 55<sup>th</sup> National Square Dance Convention® and return it with the Registration Form. **Do not send cash.**
5. **All RV Camping is Full Hook-Up.** Indicate RV Camping on your Registration Form, and enclose the required fees (four-night minimum) to cover the nights that you intend to stay. Please check appropriate boxes. RV camp sites will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. If you plan to camp together, you must arrive together. Bus passes are recommended.
6. A \$5.00 fee **per registrant** will be assessed for cancellation or changes.

7. Check the **No box** on the **Housing Required** block if providing your own housing, or if staying in an RV area.
8. Check the date boxes for each night a room is required. If you request housing in the headquarters hotel (The Menger or Crockett Hotel) you must have four nights of lodging.
