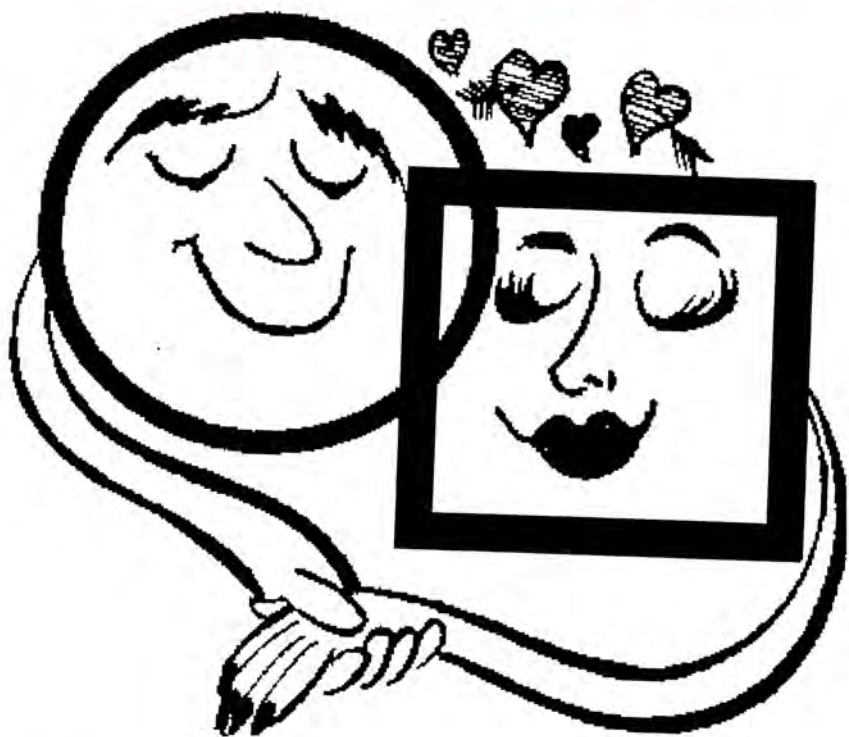

TRAVEL MISSOURI

TRAVEL MISSOURI is a statewide visitation program of the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs.

It has been approved by the Council of District Presidents as an enjoyable method to enhance the dancing experience by expanding to include different dancers, clubs, callers and areas of our great state.

Participants if they so desire, may let people know what they have done by displaying the TRAVEL MISSOURI Bar and District Dangles identifying where they have danced.

BASIC RULES

1. The TRAVEL MISSOURI is available to any dancer within the Missouri Federation.
2. The TRAVEL MISSOURI traveling program includes visitation to the seven districts and the Missouri Federation Annual Festival.
3. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.
4. Participation in the TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant may at their discretion purchase the Bar and earned Dangles from the Program Manager for \$8.00. After the first year the cost will be \$6.00 for a second set of dangles. You will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI Card which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents or Club Presidents. Each time a participant visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is then sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.
5. All checks should be made out to the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Rounds Dance.

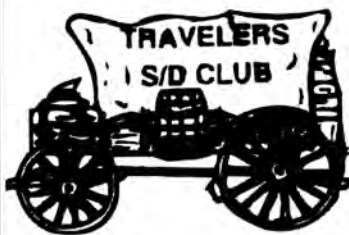
We hope all of our fellow dancers are experiencing a very wonderful New Year! We have been blessed with 10 new

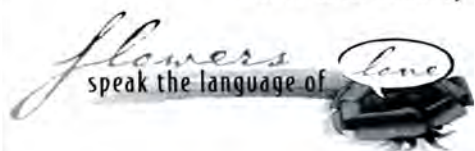

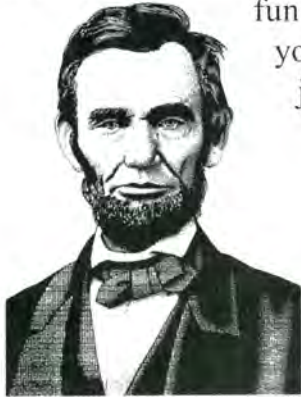

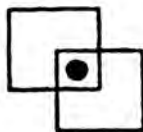

Treasurer's Report: Carolyn Herren. Carolyn reported a beginning balance on October 18, 2005 of \$852.99, October income from October 18-30, 2005 \$10,192.65, October expenses from October 18-30, 2005 \$556.19; November income \$209.99, November expenses \$1,195.42; December income \$-0-, December expenses \$1,866.55. Balance on hand December 11, 2005 \$7,637.47. CD Investments \$14,000. Total funds available \$21,637.47.

Correspondence: Sympathy cards were sent to Dave & Mary Lou Marti on the death of Dave's father and to Nadiene Burford on the death of her granddaughter. A letter was sent to Richard & Linda Peterson, President of the National Executive Committee indicating our support for the Kentuckiana Square Dance Association, Inc. in hosting the 59th National Square Dance Convention in Louisville, KY for 2010.

Boundaries and Relations: J. W. and Jan England. No report.

Constitution and Bylaws: Dave and Dee Shafer. Please see attached report submitted by Dave Shafer regarding the following changes: Article V Officers and Their Duties, Section 2. Duties-D. Also, under Standing Rules, Article X. Promotional Committee (three members) - Change #3 & 4 and renumber. These changes will be voted on at the February meeting.

Membership: Carolyn Herren. Carolyn reported that Central and Northeast Districts have not reported their new club data, Northwest District has 12 clubs with 246+ members, St. Louis District has 15 clubs with 770 members, Southeast District has 4 clubs with 92 members, Southwest District has 27 clubs and West Central District has

14 clubs for a total of 72 clubs and 1,108 members. Jim Weber said we need a list of the number of dancers in each district.

Promotion: Bettyrae and Marvin Fluke. Bettyrae stated the Promotions Committee has been an active working committee. The past two years they have promoted every phase of square dancing and are very happy about the many lessons going on. A dancer from Trenton T Squares who works for HyVee sent flyers to their employees and 9 out of 10 couples signed up. They have been working on the promotion of new callers - placing an ad in the DOIN's so clubs will hire them for a calling engagement. There are already 12 applications for "Let's Toot Our Horn." The committee is updating the Visitor Bureau Tri-Fold, therefore please fill out any changes and return to Tony and Cindy Ahart.

Bettyrae said that it was time for them to turn their responsibilities over to a younger, vibrant generation. However, they will continue to promote square dancing. They are very glad the Board accepted the Missouri State Flag and has the pledge in the Agenda. They have an active part on the 2006 State Festival committee, and will be supporting it very strongly. They wish the new committee well and hope they will surpass anything the current committee did the last two years in the promotion of square dancing.

Site Screening: Bob and Loretta Welch. No Report.

USDA/ARTS report: Jim and Edythe Weber. Edythe encouraged dancers to apply for the USDA Credit Card, use the prescription discount cards, and remember the long-term care insurance. The FREE prescription cards are still valid, even though Medicare came out with a similar plan. They will make sure you get a supply if you let them know you need them. USDA receives \$15 for each new credit card application, plus a percentage of the items charged. Be sure to submit applications for the \$1,000 Memorial Youth Fund Scholarship by February 1, 2006. Late entries are not accepted. The application will be in the January DOIN's. The ARTS has a Square Dance Travel Web Site. It is www.arts-dancetravel.com. 40% of the travel commissions will come back to square dancing. Cruises, hotels, tours etc. can be booked through this web site saving users money. The next time you need a hotel for a Federation meeting, book through them. There are magnet strips available for \$2.50 for your car. They say "Learn to Dance" with phone number and you can call 1-866-445-ARTS (2787) to get them.

Publications: Barb and Dave Turner. Barb stated Cass County Publishing Co. will no longer be printing the DOIN's after the January issue. Please let the Webers or Turners know if you know a good printing company. Jim Weber has contacted several printing companies and has received their bids. None are cheap. Expect expenses to rise and costs of advertising & subscriptions to go up.

Insurance: Dave and Barbara Turner. Dave said the Insurance packets were mailed and they are coming back slowly. Some clubs will be dancing without insurance for 1 - 3 months. . Balance on hand as of October 23, 2005 \$63.71. November Income \$1,430.90. November Expenses \$1,438.09. Balance on hand Nov. 30, 2005 \$56.62.

Historian: Linda and Doyle Collins. Doyle reported in Linda's absence. He said that in March 1970, the Missouri Federation established the 3rd weekend in October as State Square and Round Dance week. They found this to be an effective way of getting the attention of Missouri residents to enjoy the activity. Bob and Ginger Prescott from the Southwest District was a big help in getting the USDA to declare September as "National Square Dance Month." When the State Festival Program Book was started, the Federation decided there would always be a history in the book.

License Plate: Linda and Doyle Collins. Doyle reported the balance forward was \$1,037.61. December income was \$25.00. December expenses \$20.00. Balance on hand December 10, 2005 \$1,052.61. Jim Weber said we need to promote the license plate and take applications to all the dances.

Blue Bird: Connie and Kenny Hobbs. No report.
