from and where they have fun at? Probably not. Would some of these people make good square dancers? Definitely. So how do we get the word out that new square dancers are needed?

Many people think public relations (PR) and publicity are synomonous. Not true! Public relations is a planned effort by square dancers to create understanding, favor and support for square dancing programs and objectives among their members, the media and general public. In essence, the function of our public relations is to build and maintain a positive image of square dancing and dancers in our communities so that people will want to be a part of square dancing. Everyone likes to be a part of a winning team or organization that has a positive position or impact in their community. People do want to make a difference. PR includes anticipating benefits that affect the community as well as square dancing. Good PR means getting support for our programs, planning them, publicizing them and, yes, evaluating them. The key element in square dancing is that it serves square dancers as well as public interest. Yes, it is important to get photos and articles in the local papers, but it is more important to plan, promote and execute an event that will enhance the public's image of square dancing. What can you and your club do to enhance the image of square dancing in your community?
