
# Wheel-Around Squares Joplin Thursday/Sunday Mary "Mary" Castleberry

- 2. The TRAVEL MISSOURI traveling program includes visitation to the seven districts and the Missouri Federation Annual Festival.
- 3. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.
- 4. Participation in the TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant may at their discretion obtain the Travel Missouri Bar and earn dangles from the Program Manager. To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI Card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents or Club Presidents). Each time a participant that has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.
- 5. All checks should be made out to the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Rounds Dance.

- 1. The "add a buck" program is progressing. It takes a lot of money to start a national advertising campaign. The goal is to change the image of square dancing for baby boomers, and to have 50,000 square dancers within the next eight years.
- 2. Money was received from the "train bank."
- Edythe stated "Ask clubs not to schedule a club dance on February 29, 2008, as that day is for an ARTS Benefit Dance. There is hope that every district will host a benefit dance for the ARTS.
- 4. Check the ARTS web site www.arts-dance.org for continued updates.
- We continue to see competitive pricing on the travel website. The website address is www.arts-dancetravel.com.

**USDA report**: Jim and Edythe Weber. Edythe gave the following report.

- 1. USDA is continuing to work to establish a new credit card program. We will keep you updated as we get more information. Responses have been coming in slowly.
- 2. Continue to use and support the discount prescription drug card. It will save you money.
- 3. Enrollment in the long term care program is progressing very slowly.
- 4. Shop online on the new Fundlink shopping mall at the USDA website. They give a donation and support the USDA and handicapable dancers.

**Publications**: Bill and Carol Morris. Carol thanked the West Central District for the great festival and the DOIN's Dance. There were 42 renewals and 11 new subscriptions. Donations were \$609.00. A few ideas were mentioned on possibilities for the next festival.

**Editor:** Jim and Edythe Weber. Edythe gave report. About 90% send their articles by e-mail. She apologized for the Twilight Twirlers error. There will be a "pull out" location section in the January DOIN's, so please get the exact directions in writing to your dances to her, along with a cell phone contact number.

**Circulation**: Annette and Terry Thornhill. Annette stated the beginning balance 8/20/06 was \$106.00. Income for September/October \$879.00. Expenses September/October \$7.80. Check #1016 was sent to the Missouri Federation for \$771.20. Ending balance10/15/06 \$100.00. Petty Cash \$6.00. 687 November DOIN's will be sent.

For the November 2005 issue, 709 labels went to the publisher. For the November 2006 issue, 687 labels went to the publisher. Net loss of 22 subscriptions for the year 2006.

Five clubs are 100% DOIN's clubs. They are: Golden Valley Squares in Clinton; Beaux and Belles in Macon; Ozark Whirlers in Eldon; Tiger Squares in Columbia; and Ozark Lakers in Laurie.

The Southwest District has a Springfield DOIN's dance every year. It yielded 53 renewals and 23 new subscriptions and 10 callers.

**Advertising:** Dave and Dee Shafer. Dave gave the following report. Balance brought forward August 20, 2006, \$100.00. Income was \$611.00, Expenses \$121.53. Check to the Missouri Federation for \$489.47 leaving a balance on hand as of October 15, 2006 of \$100.00.

Dave distributed a page showing the advantages of advertising in The Show-Me DOIN's, plus a list of advertising rates and dimensions. He also passed out forms for Holiday Greeting ads.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

**2006 State Festival:** Dave and Mary Lou Marti. Dave said that working on the Festival for two years was a "labor of love". The Chamber of Commerce donated 26 dozen cinnamon rolls to the DOIN's dance. He reported out of 3,894 members only 839 attended the festival. Dave stated we need to work on people to attend. He mentioned the following statistics: Central has 386 members - 78 attended, West Central has 325 members - 156 attended, Southeast has 92 members - 15 attended, Southwest has 1217 members - 122 attended, St. Louis has 955 members - 72 attended, Northeast has 316 members - 93 attended, and Northwest has 765 members - 111 attended. There were 50 registered from out-of-state, 14 from Heart of America, 45 callers & cuers, 45 significant others, and 22 VIP's. 21% of total Missouri dancers attended. Discussion ensued on what to do when callers do not show (16 callers did not show). Only 3 notified committee in advance and one showed up and said he could not call. Kansas rule is if a caller does not show, he cannot call for 2 years. No decision was made.

**2007 State Festival**: Mark and Rosalee Mortensen. Mark said the 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Festival would be in Lebanon on October 19-21, 2007. The featured caller will be Tim Tyl and cuer will be Pat & Joe Hilton. There were 230 T-shirts sold and 150 pre-registered. There was a discussion about the high cost of Booster ribbons...3,000 ribbons cost over \$600.00. The returns on the 2006 ribbons was not good. Northwest had 16 out of 20 clubs with no sales, St. Louis had 14 out of 19 clubs with no sales, Central had 2 out of 10 clubs with no sales, Southwest had 17 out of 28 clubs with no sales, Northeast had 2 out of 8 clubs with no sales, and Southeast had 1 out of 3 clubs with no sales.

At the February meeting, packets with booster ribbons will be given to the District Presidents. There will be a Souvenir Program Book which will cost \$1.00 and will contain pictures and the history of the Federation. Ads are needed. There will be door prizes. A beautiful Route 66 King Size Quilt in Red, White and Black (100" x 80") will be raffled off (6 for \$5.00 or \$1.00 each.) Dan Wheeler will do the web site and hotels will be contacted shortly. Mark said to call him for any District special dances, so someone from the committee can try and be there

**2009 Caller/Cuer Nominees.** Barbara and Dave Turner. Since Barb was unable to get a cuer for 2009, Jim Riley gave her a name of one he contacted for 2010. She will contact Pam Young from Topeka, KS to cue for the 2009 state festival. A discussion ensued on how we choose featured callers and cuers. It was brought up that Article X, Section 8, page 10 of the Federation Standing

Rules states that a committee of three past presidents shall be appointed to find a caller and cuer, and the price will be at the discretion of the committee. The committee will receive input from Federation members.

2010 Caller/Cuer Nominees: Jim and Eloise Riley. No Report.

**Youth Ad Hoc Committee Report**: Sharon Crisel. Dave Shafer said we need to find ways to grow and not shrink. He reported there will be an Educational Seminar for the Missouri Association of Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance (MOAHPERD) at Lodge of the Four Seasons on November 11. The plan is to help teachers have the most current materials and methods to teach square dancing in the school districts. Dave Shafer and Jerry Routh will attend.

Sharon Crisel stated we are gardeners and the children are seeds. Seeds are the future of square dancing. Many youth groups are looking for ways to teach and entertain kids. She is working with Military Kids who are children of deployed parents. The University of MO. sponsors a fair which she attended and gave out many square dance freebies. The University of MO. has a grant program. Sharon has been in contact with a person from the University. Contact groups in your community to see if they would like to introduce square dancing to its members.

**Information Ad Hoc Committee Report**: Jim Weber. Jim talked about "Information Super Highway". We need to get information from the top to the bottom. He needs e-mail addresses from all seven districts, their clubs and their members. There was much discussion as to why information is not getting to all the dancers.
