



Come join us for the best in dancing fun and a good cup of coffee. We'll see you across a square or around a round.



Complete at least 2 of the following: 100% Booster Club – State Festival 1/2 or full page ad in Festival Book Have a National Caller dance Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting Have a current District officer from club membership Have a current State officer from club membership Conduct complete set of lessons, any level Visit at another district's dance – one square (8 dancers) minimum
Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) with in the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.
A listing of all clubs that will receive HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the April issue of the <i>Doin's</i> .
