IMPORTANT – NEW DEADLINE FOR ARTICLES AND ADS – Please have your articles to us and the advertisements to Dave Shafer before the 25th of each month beginning NOW. New postal regulations require 10 days (not including Sunday and holidays) for delivery of bulk mail by the 1st of the month.

April 25 – deadline for the June issue; *May* 25 – deadline for the July issue; *June* 25 – deadline for the August issue.

The Show Me Doin's will be changing to a bi-monthly publication with the September/October 2007 issue. The deadline for information for both months of September and October is *July 25*. The deadline for the November/December issue will be *September 25*. The 150-word limit remains the same and will be strictly enforced. Make sure you include both months dance information in your article and advertisements.

These changes were recommended by the Publications Committee and the Missouri Federation Executive officers and were approved by the Board of Directors at the April 15 Federation meeting.
