
We will continue to look for ways to improve our financial status and will keep you briefed. Please be patient.




regulations require 10 days (not including Sunday and holidays) for delivery of bulk mail by the 1st of the month.





SQUARE DANCERS LOSE A GOOD FRIEND



Ivan R. Buckman 11-29-30 ~ 04-18-07

Lvan Buckman, member of the Tanglefoot Squares of the Northeast District, died Wednesday, April 18, 2007 at Boone Hospital, Columbia. He and his wife, Lois, were charter members of the club and were also secretaries of the Northeast District for a number of years. They were selected as State Square Dancers of the Year in 2005.

Ivan was born in Kirksville, resident of Linn County, son of Morgan Jasper and Clara Lee (Hisel) Buckman. He and his wife celebrated their 56th wedding anniversary April 15 at the hospital.

After graduation from Meadville in 1948 he attended Chillicothe Business College in Chillicothe and started working at the Chillicothe State Bank. His banking career of 30 years took him to Dawn, Rich Hill and in 1960 to Marceline where he remained until 1978. At that time he and Lois purchased the local newspaper and later a neighboring weekly and shopper. Although they sold the paper business in 1988 he remained working with the paper until retirement in 2001. He was a member of the First Christian Church in Marceline.

Ivan was involved in the community in many ways and was active at the time of his death as Commander of the American Legion, VFW, Masonic Lodge, Stadium Club, Tri-County Shrine, Puddle Jumpers Bass Club and of course Tanglefoot Squares.

He is survived by his wife, Lois, three daughters and two sons-in-law, all living locally; eight grandchildren, three of which are married; and an enormous amount of friends. He will be missed in a lot of places including around the square.

TRAVEL MISSOURI

TRAVEL MISSOURI is a statewide visitation program of the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs.

It has been approved by the Council of District Presidents as an enjoyable method to enhance the dancing experience by expanding to include different dancers, clubs, callers and areas of our great state.

Participants if they so desire, may let people know what they have done by displaying the TRAVEL MISSOURI Bar and District Dangles identifying where they have danced.

BASIC RULES

- 1. The TRAVEL MISSOURI is available to any dancer within the Missouri Federation.
- 2. The TRAVEL MISSOURI traveling program includes visitation to the seven districts and the Missouri Federation Annual Festival.
- 3. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.
- 4. Participation in the TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant may at their discretion obtain the Travel Missouri Bar and earn dangles from the Program Manager. To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI Card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents or Club Presidents). Each time a participant that has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.
