


Nothing firm, but we expect our last Monday evening workshop to be the week before Thanksgiving week. Happy turkey day to everyone.

Leroy will be back with us Dec. 1st for our Frosty Frolic Dance. If we need to warm up fast, Leroy's our man for the job.





Each time a participant that has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.





Boundaries and Relations Committee: Don and Joann Miller - No report

Constitution and Bylaws Committee: No report

License Plate Coordinators, J.W. and Jan England: Balance on June 10, 2007, was \$76.20; balance on August 19, 2007, was \$241.20. A check for \$200.00 was presented to the treasurer leaving a current balance of \$41.20.

Membership Chairman, Linda Evans, reminded us membership dues are now due. Chairman Evans suggested dues need to be raised. Bettyrae Fluke moved we increase the dues to \$10.00 from each individual club to belong to the Federation. Motion was seconded and carried. This is a change to the Standing Rules page 3, Article VI (Membership Fee). The increase should be noted on membership applications for the new calendar year.

Travel Missouri: Ed and Sheryl Schofield. As of August 19, 2007, 1435 dangles were earned, with 29 added today, making 1464 total dangles.

Square Dancer of the Year Committee: Bob Turner says the committee has met and chosen the Square Dancer of the Year from the nominees and will be announced on Saturday night at the Festival.

Caller and Cuer Hall of Fame: Bob Turner reported for Dave Shafer that the winner will be announced on Saturday night at the Festival.

District Presidents' Report: Vicki Wittman stated the St. Louis Federation and the St. Louis League of Clubs have been meeting to combine, hopefully beginning the first of the year, and to be called St. Louis Metro Square and Round Dance Association. New bylaws will be finalized probably by the end of this year. Barb Turner thanked Marty and Caroll Altmann, Carolyn Herren, and Ray and Vicki Wittman for the huge amount of time they have spent getting this accomplished.

Vicki Wittman also reported for Annette Thornhill about the Alzheimer's Walk in Columbia, Missouri, on October 7, 2007, at Steven's Park. Be there at 1:45 to help with an exhibition and possible audience participation. This is a good way to advertise new classes.

Caller and Cuer for the year 2011: Edythe Weber brought a motion from the Caller/Cuer Committee to have the Board vote on the selections. Remember half of the raffle ticket money stays with your club. The Fashion show is still accepting models. Lebanon is having a city wide fest and the Federation is invited to have an information table. Also, the quilt will be displayed and chances may be purchased by others than dancers. The quilt is a large part of the money making process for the Festival.
