WHAT'S HAPPENING AT THE 49TH ANNUAL MISSOURI FEDERATION SQUARE AND ROUND DANCE FESTIVAL

This year the dance format is going to be different from the past few years. For example, we are going to **separate the rounds out from the square dancing**. I've been told that square dancers, who do not do rounds, do not want to sit out that long a period of time while waiting for the round dancers to dance. I've also been told by some square dancers that they like watching the round dancers dance! Uh Oh – now what? More dancers have told me that they would rather not sit out that long, and, callers have told me it's difficult to correlate tips in two different dance halls when one of them has rounds in it. Hence – rounds will be in one hall, squares in two other halls.

We are also trying out something different. We are going to have a **silent auction** where you can bid

and win on some fantastic prizes. More to come from your District President in the next few months.

Yes, to those of you who asked – **the floors in the two gyms are wood**, the floor in the cafeteria (for rounds), I think is vinyl. The key words on the cafeteria floor are "I think". I'm not sure but will check it out. There will also be three to four classrooms, where we can do advanced and lines, and have a separate room for the sewing clinic. Helias High School is huge.

For those of you who have pre-registered, and I hope that everyone will pre-register, you have or should have received a ribbon in the mail. This **pre-registration ribbon is your admission to the dance**. Therefore, when you arrive, all you have to do is pick up a schedule at the registration

desk and walk in. Your ribbon is your admission. Should you lose the ribbon, please stop at the registration desk where it will be replaced. Of course, a hard copy on paper of all those who have pre-registered will be there. If everyone pre-registers, then that committee will have more time to dance as will you, since you won't have to stand in line to register! And of course, your name will be entered into a drawing for a fabulous prize!

The **sewing clinic** will be open on Saturday afternoon. Joann Prater has arranged for Satin Stitches to bring embroidery and sewing machines which will be used to create your own fabric and then to make a zipper bag. There will also be a pattern exchange in the room, so, if you have any patterns you would like to share, give, or donate, or take new ones home with you, please bring them.

Debbie Bailey is working to make the **fashion show** an extraordinary one. I can't wait to see what she has planned for us. Nancy Wheeler has been showing off the quilt she has made – it recently made a showing at the NE District Dance. Wow – I hope I win it! And of course, don't forget our cash raffle – I hope I win one of those too. You can purchase **quilt and cash raffle tickets** either from your club or online at www.festival.squaredancemissouri.com. Remember that **your club keeps half of the money** received from the cash raffle tickets.

Our Jefferson City committee has been busy. Information on **what**

to see and do in Jefferson City will be available at the Jefferson City table. Highlights are guided tours of the State Capitol and the historic St. Peter Church, and the Cole County Historical Museum. I personally am looking forward to the collection of First Ladies Inaugural Ball Gowns. Hmmmmmm – I can see my weekend is going to be very busy. Dancing Friday night and Saturday morning, workshops Saturday afternoon, sewing clinic, fashion show, more dancing, sightseeing, Doin's dance.

And of course, **lots of big thank yous** to our own **fantastic State Callers and Cuers** for donating their time at the Festival and at the **Sunday morning Doin's dance**. This wouldn't be the outstanding dance it always is without them.

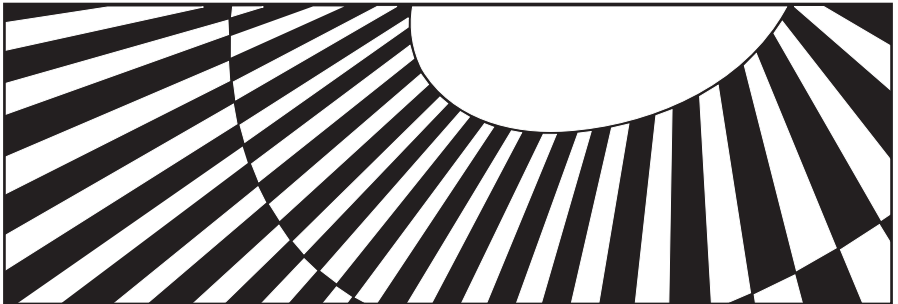

you will take time out to do some dancing. The Twirlers have three very good dances coming up in the next two months.

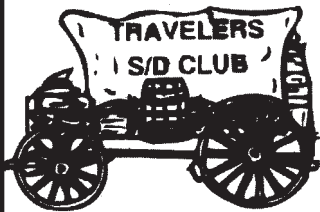

DO YOU KNOW



Have you ever watched *Wagon Train*, *How the West Was Won* or any other old westerns and seen ten to twenty seconds of dancing? Did you notice the Do Sa Do's, Allemande Left's and Right and Left Grand's? Movie makers always kept the dancing simple and short, yet the dancers were usually square dancing.

What the Hollywood movies don't tell us is that most of the time, members of wagon trains were too tired or too busy to dance each night. Most of the time the settlers were up before the "crack of dawn" and moving out with first daylight. The laden wagons were hard on the draft animals, so most of the settlers walked beside of their wagons. On a good day, they could travel about ten to fifteen miles, but the average was less than that. These were not easy miles. On other days, because of terrain or other misfortune, they might make a hundred yards, one-quarter of a mile, or if it was raining they usually couldn't move because the wheels of the laden wagons would sink deeply into the mud or the rivers and streams were too deep or swift for safe crossing.

One thing that the movie makers did get right is that dancing did migrate across our nation with the settlers. Square dancing evolved from many different nationalities giving the people a common dance that everyone could do. Because most dances were done in some sort of a sequence, many dancers couldn't remember what move followed what move. Fortunately, there was usually at least one merry-maker who remembered all of the moves and would prompt the dancers. Over time, this person became known as a "Caller."

Callers of yesteryear called local dances and made up their own routines and patter. Many became very ingenious by adding colorful sayings, such as Piute Pete's: "All jump up and never come down, swing your honey around and around. Swing her here, swing her there, swing her all around the square." These colorful words filled the gaps between moves and kept the dancers on their toes. "Swing her high, Swing her low, Swing her till she's off her toes."

Dave proposed either using a picture album with proclamations and citations, or to continue with the old foldout by adding the newest recipient and removing the oldest each year. A motion was made by Jim Weber to continue with the workbook album, to purchase the proposed plaque, and to discontinue the foldout. The motion was seconded and carried.

President. The motion was seconded and carried.

A lifetime membership card from the Missouri Federation was also presented to J.W. and Jan England.

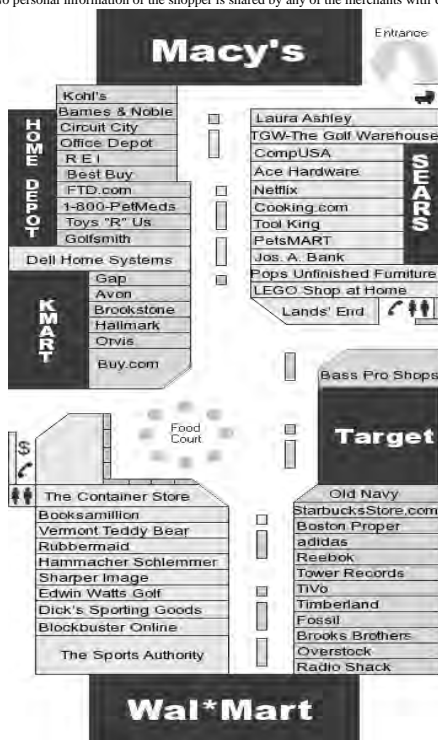

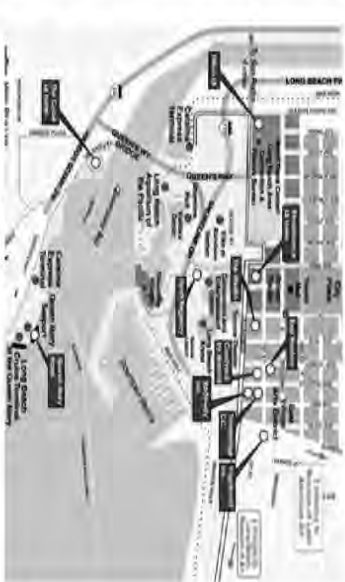

7. Check the date boxes for each night a room is required. If you request housing in Hotel Codes 1-5, you must have four nights of lodging.
8. **Room Sharing:** The 88th NSDC Housing Committee does not find or assign roommates. To avoid double booking, only ONE couple or individual should request the room.
9. These wishing "Same Hotel as" *must* submit their Registration Form together in same envelope.
10. Enclose completed Registration Forms for all persons in a group; if the group wishes rooms in the same hotel, and forward not later than January 2, 2009. Include name and telephone number of group leader.

Fax and mailed acknowledgments will be sent within 10-14 days. You will not receive your acknowledgment until the time frame, please contact the 88th NSDC Housing Committee via E-mail: registration@88sd.org. You will not receive a confirmation slip from the hotel.
14. **Hotel Changes:** Any requests for changes/cancellations must be made through the 88th NSDC Housing Committee via E-mail: registration@88sd.org (a) Fax: 760-335-6140; (b) Mail: 88th NSDC Housing Committee, P.O. Box 460389, Escondido, CA 92046 through **May 31, 2009**. After this date you may contact your confirmed hotel directly for changes.
15. **Housing Cancellations:** The 88th NSDC Housing Committee must receive all cancellations on or prior to **May 31, 2009**, at the E-mail, Fax or Mail address in #14 above, to avoid a penalty. Any cancellations received after **May 31, 2009** will be assessed a \$25.00 per person cancellation fee. A one night room/tax charge will be assessed by your confirmed hotel for cancellations received less than 72 hours prior to arrival.
