

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

A "Horn" will be presented to each club qualifying to be pinned to their club banner, with bars to be added for each completed year. A year will be January 1 through December 31 with the "Horn" or bars being mailed to each club completing requirements specified in guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS:

• At least 6 items in local media (newspaper, radio, billboard, etc.)

Complete a minimum of 6 items from the following:

- O At least 5 articles, ads or listings in the Doin's.
- O 100% Doin's Club
- O Philanthropic activity (i.e. benefit dance, fund raiser for needy persons or organization, scholarship, food pantry collection, adopt-a-family for a holiday, bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at a District dance
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- O Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4th celebration, fall festival, etc.)
- O 100% Booster Club State Festival
- O ¹/₂ or full page ad in Festival Book
- O Have a National Caller dance
- O Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

<u>Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.</u>

A listing of all clubs that will receive the HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the Doin's.

If you want to furnish a telephone number, make sure it is a number that will be answered during dance time, not your home phone which will not be answered while you are at the dance. If everything is okay, you do not need to do anything. If something needs changed or a new location needs added, please fill out the form and send it to us. Deadline is November 25th.

To date we have 180 dancers Registered for the dance. REMEMBER you have to be Pre-registered to win the huge prize. Pre-registering will also prevent you from standing in the registration line at the dance. Simply wear the ribbon, which will be mailed to you when you pre-register, and walk on in! Don't forget to pick up a schedule at the door.

We have 35 callers who have volunteered their time, 7 round dance cuers, and 3 line dance cuers. There will be rooms available for mainstream, plus, and advanced square dancing, round dancing, and line dancing all evening Friday, Saturday morning, and Saturday evening. 


We will have only one dance in October due to the State Dance. On Oct. 3rd we have Mike Corns coming in to call for us.







Saturdays were special days to our forefathers. Most of them worked all week including Saturdays, but it meant the end of the week. Sunday was a day of rest and a time to honor and respect God. Besides going to town to sell their goods or shop for needed items, Saturday was a time when many celebrated by taking their weekly bath, combing their hair, shaving their faces, and donning their socializing "duds".

On Saturday nights, those who played musical instruments grabbed them up and headed for the nearest store, barn, hall, or meeting house to play music and sing songs. The fiddles would whine, the banjos would twang, flat top boxes would strum, accordions or concertinas would sing, and the harmonicas would hum. One or more would sing the songs of work and play, adding lyrics telling local lore or idolizing heros and heroines of their day or days' past. The music, songs, reels, contra, waltzes and square dancing lightened the hearts of many as the night wore on.

Those who watched couldn't help but join in to sing songs, or jump out to the area cleared for the night to dance and jig. Since many of the songs had dance steps associated with them, those who recalled the moves called the moves while the dancers flitted around the floor. The caller didn't necessarily have to call all of the dances. Those attending could take their turn singing and calling their favorite song and dance.

Stories were told and retold with a new twist here and there.
