TRAVEL MISSOURI

TRAVEL MISSOURI is a statewide visitation program of the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs.

It has been approved by the Council of District Presidents as an enjoyable method to enhance the dancing experience by expanding to include different dancers, clubs, callers and areas of our great state.

Participants if they so desire, may let people know what they have done by displaying the TRAVEL MISSOURI Bar and District Dangles identifying where they have danced.

BASIC RULES

- 1. The TRAVEL MISSOURI is available to any dancer within the Missouri Federation.
- 2. The TRAVEL MISSOURI traveling program includes visitation to the seven districts and the Missouri Federation Annual Festival.
- 3. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.
- 4. Participation in the TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant may at their discretion obtain the Travel Missouri Bar and earn dangles from the Program Manager. To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI Card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents or Club Presidents). Each time a participant that has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.





So you want to live longer and have fun doing it. Regardless of how old we are, we can be smarter, and more energetic so we have a longer and healthier life. There are many studies that prove this. Convincing ourselves (especially our bodies) and others that what we are doing is right can be hard sometimes. For instance, square dancing is recommended as one of the top six activities for increasing our healthiness and longevity by several medical associations. In fact, it is said we can add ten years to our lives by square dancing. Square dancing is a form of exercise in more than one way, physically, mentally and socially. We aren't running along the side of a road putting our lives in jeopardy while contorting our faces into a mask of pain and agony. Square dancing is challenging and fun while reaping the many rewards it provides.

According to the magazine "Vim and Vigor," "...square dancing is a top-level activity for your brain, according to Elizabeth Edgerly, Ph.D., spokeswoman for the Alzheimer's Association's Maintain Your Brain program. It has three aspects—social, physical and mental—that are especially good for the brain." Other activities recommended are playing games that stimulate the mental processes. Crossword puzzles are good, but if they are easy to do, get crossword puzzles that are more challenging. That is one reason square dancing is really good for us in more than one way. Square dancing is challenging to our brains. We have to think about what we are about to do and make our bodies do what we are commanding it to do. To do this, we must learn to listen to what the caller calls, learn our left from our right, learn the moves and get our bodies to where they need to be when each call is called. This is supported by studies conducted by the John Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, who has "concluded that cognitive training interventions can promote good health outcomes and delay or prevent the onset of Alzheimer's and other dementias."

According to a 1994 May Clinic Health Letter, exercising doesn't have to be a bore. Dancing burns calories, conditions the cardiovascular system, builds strong bones, provides socializing and is a good form of rehabilitation when recovering from heart or knee surgery. The American Heart Association also recommends square dancing as a source of exercise that stimulates and strengthens the heart and increases your respiratory and circulation systems. Physical and mental exercise is the key to happiness, healthfulness, well being, friendships and longevity.

Stress is another ailment that is high on the list of medical associations. Square dancing is one of the very top activities recommended for relieving stress. When we square dance, we are concentrating on one thing, and one thing only, square dancing and having fun. Our stressful issues of the day are forgotten because there is no room or time for those issues. Even a short stressless interval is good for our hearts, brains and bodies. Our being stress free is also good for everyone around us.

As we promote Square Dancing, consider the following: It improves our quality of life; Is affordable no matter where we are; Closer than we think; Helps us bond with family and friends; Introduces us to new friends from every walk of life; Reduces Stress; Is engaging and rewarding; Good physical and mental exercise; Easy to learn and IT IS FUN!



Larry Liebig 2008 Caller Hall of Fame Inductee

This year's recipient began his career in square dancing in 1968 when he learned to dance. Then, in 1980, after attending Cal Golden Calling School in Arkansas, he began calling. In 1985, he initiated lessons for five couples and, upon completion, the Trenton T-Squares dance club was formed. After 23 years there are still 28 members enjoying square dancing.

Larry calls and gives lessons for: Trenton T-Squares, Maysville Wranglers, Winter Ranch RV Park, Alamo, Texas, and Hoot-N-Hollers, Harrisonville, MO. He guest calls for numerous other clubs in Missouri, Iowa, and Nebraska on a regular basis. He has had the opportunity to call for dancers in 12 states, from Alaska to south Texas, and has also called at the Iowa and Alaska state dances. This year marks the 21st consecutive year of calling for the state festival.

A tireless promoter of square dancing, the honoree calls in nursing homes, churches, children's camps, senior centers, and shopping centers. He carries extra equipment to be used or loaned to fellow callers when break-downs occur.

Charitable organizations benefitting from his time and talent include Relay for Life, Asthma Foundation, Camp Quality, YMCA counselors camp, and a heart transplant fund raiser in Iowa. He has also participated in re-building homes in Louisiana and Mississippi after Hurricane Katrina inflicted damage and destruction.

Larry is currently a member of American Callers Association and Mid-Missouri Callers Association, and was a member of Kansas City Callers Association.



The meeting was called to order by President, Bob Turner, at 12:30 PM in the cafeteria of Helias High School, 1305 Swifts Highway, Jefferson City, Missouri.

Roll Call: Chuck Evans reported there were 36 members present, and a quorum was achieved.

Bob Turner read a listing of past presidents to determine how many were still active in square dancing.

Introduction and Welcome of Visitors and Guests: Bob Turner

Minutes of the August 17, 2008 meeting: A motion was made by Mark Mortensen to approve the August 17, 2008 minutes. The motion was seconded and carried.

Treasurer's Report: Winnie Weitkamp reported. The opening balance in the checking account was \$5031.58. The receipts were \$2567.47 and the expenses were \$2,500.61, leaving a closing balance of \$5,098.44 as of September 30, 2008, plus two Certificates of Deposit totaling \$7,000. The report was filed for audit. Bob Turner reviewed the 2008 budget.

Membership: Winnie Weitkamp reported 99 clubs in the Missouri Federation with 3,700 club members. Winnie also announced that 2009 membership dues were due now at \$10.00 per club.

Club Longevity: Winnie Weitkamp reported that the clubs, Eagle Picher Squares and Jasper Eagle Squares, both of the Southwest District, will receive their 25-year pins and accompanying letters of congratulation and recognition from the Federation for club longevity.

Correspondence: No Report

REPORTS:

Audit: Ed Schofield reported that all financial statements and audits are now done and are okay.

Boundaries and Relations: No Report

Constitution and Bylaws: This report was held for reporting during "Unfinished Business" since it required a vote on a proposed Constitution change.

Publications: Carol Morris congratulated the Northeast District for the great dance this weekend and reported that the raffle held that morning netted \$69.00.

Doin's Editor: Edythe Weber reported. She asked that all finalized club schedules be sent to the editor as soon as possible. Club presidents should check the club directory to be sure the name listed is correct. The January/ February 2009 issue will include the location listings. Clubs are asked to check the 2008 listing for your club to see if it is

correct and the directions to the dance sites are accurate. Please include all sites, even those only used once, and include an address or highway junction for those using GPS. If a phone number is included, be sure it is a number that will be answered during the dance.

The deadline for all articles and advertisements is still the 25th of each odd-numbered month. Articles received after the 25th will not be printed. Every effort will be made to include all dance dates if a prelist has been sent in.

Clubs not paying Federation dues by the 25th of November 2008 will not be eligible to have articles printed until dues are paid. All forms for articles and lessons are available on the website at http://www.squaredancemissouri.com/Missouri/index.htm. Click on the tab for Federation information and the Show-Me Doin's.

Doin's Circulation: Annette Thornhill reported. For the November/December 2008 issue of The Doin's, there were 525 copies mailed, of which 501 were paid subscriptions, and 24 were free (6 to advertisers, 4 to exchanges, and 14 to others). Annette reported a beginning balance of \$100.00, receipts of \$687.00, and expenses of \$2.68, for a total of \$784.32. A check was issued to the Federation for \$684.32, leaving a balance carried forward of \$100 as of October 19, 2008.

The DOIN'S Dance was attended by 240 dancers and 21 callers netting \$704, with 45 renewed subscriptions and 9 new subscriptions.

Doin's Advertising: Dave Shafer reported the balance brought forward as of August 17, 2008, was \$100.00. The income was \$770.00 and expenses were \$64.80. A check was issued to the Federation for \$705.20, leaving a balance carried forward of \$100.00 as of October 19, 2008.

Promotional: No report

State Festival Site Screening: Eleanor Stover reported that Finnegans and the Raymore-Peculiar High School had been site-screened. She also reported that the Raymore-Peculiar site had been selected for 2009.

State Festival Caller/Cuer for 2012: Dave Shafer reported that the committee had selected Tom Manning to be the featured caller for 2012 and recommended that the selection be approved. (No action was taken at this time, but would be brought up under "New Business.") The committee selected no cuer.

Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame: J.W. England reported that Larry Liebig was this year's honored caller and thanked everyone for their submissions. He further encouraged more nominees to be submitted for 2009.

Square Dancer of the Year: Jan Anslinger congratulated Dave and Dee Shafer as the 2008 Square Dancers of the Year. She requested everyone to assist in next year's selection by submitting names for 2009.

Insurance Coordinator: Dave Turner reported that the beginning balance as of August 1, 2008, was \$453.17. The income for August was \$17.00 and the expenses were \$16.00. The income for September was \$4.25 and the expenses were \$4.00, leaving a balance of \$454.42 as of September 30, 2008.

Member Services: No Report

Travel Missouri: Ed Schofield reported there are 191 dancers participating in this

program. There were 1745 total dangles handed out, of which 54 are in the 1st set, 35 are in the 2nd set, 20 are in the 3rd set, 10 are in the 4th set, and 8 are in the 5th set. Distribution of dangles from each district and the Missouri Festival was as follows: Central District 247, Northeast District 193, Northwest District 186, St. Louis District 197, Southeast District 190, Southwest District 237, West Central District 225, and the Missouri Festival 230.

Blue Bird: Connie Hobbs reported the balance on hand as of August 17, 2008, was \$176.46 with income of \$43.00 for a total of \$219.46. A check was issued to the Missouri Federation for \$100.00, leaving a balance on hand of \$119.46 as of October 19, 2008.

Historian: Linda Collins asked for more pictures of dancers at club dances.

License Plate: J. W. England reported. The balance brought forward as of August 17, 2008, was \$21.20. September income was \$50.00, with September expenses of \$20.00, leaving a balance of \$51.20 on hand as of October 18, 2008.

USDA: Edythe Weber reported that applications for the USDA Youth Scholarship (\$1,000.00) are due before February 1, 2009. This is for seniors in high school and freshmen in college. Information is on the USDA web site at usda.org. Click on the youth tab. Edythe also reminded everyone to distribute the information about the discount prescription card, long-term care, and the on-line shopping mall.

ARTS: Edythe Weber reported. The dancer's travel website is receiving bookings almost on a daily basis. Thanks to those who are using it. For those who have not tried it yet, please check it out at www.arts-dancetravel.com.

New business during the June 29th meeting was the proposal to create an editable video that can be used by anyone to market square dancing. This project would be costly, but could be used nationwide. More details will be released as the investigation continues.

The first grant funds were approved for a New Jersey organization that holds a weekend education workshop for square dance leaders. The \$200 grant is given if you hold an education event and discuss ARTS and get more people involved and informed about the ARTS. We are seriously thinking about doing this for the 50th Missouri Federation Festival.

The Missouri Federation was thanked for its support of the ARTS, and it was reported that a check for \$37.00 was received today from the 2008 Festival from the add-a-buck program.

State Festival 2008: Annette Thornhill introduced Rodney Comstock, treasurer for the 2008 Festival. He reported that the silent auction had 44 items and income of \$1,315. Tee shirt sales were \$1,492. Pre-registration was \$5,125. At the door registrations were \$2,247 (518 to 520 dancers). Raffle tickets were \$1,142.78. Quilt raffle was \$444. Mr. Comstock reported a profit of \$6,600 at this time. The separation of the square and round dance halls, along with the discrepancies involving the charges by the Super 8 Motel were discussed.

State Festival 2009: Robert Bradford reported that we need to get more information from each preceding festival administrator to assist the present ones. The 2009 Festival will be in the Raymore-Peculiar High School Complex on the south side of Kansas City. He also encouraged people to get a written contract with lodging providers. Robert encouraged everyone to plan to come a day early and stay an extra day to visit

the various attractions in the Kansas City area and read a list of places of interest. He reported the cost of the venue for the 2009 Festival is \$5,000.

Nominating committee for 2009 officers: Dave Shafer reported the slate of officers presented for 2009 is as follows: President--John and Eleanor Stover, Central District; 1st Vice President--Don and Joann Miller, Southwest District; 2nd Vice President--Tom and Pat Miller, Northwest District; 3rd Vice President--Larry and Jan Anslinger, West Central District; Secretary--Chuck and Linda Evans, St. Louis District; and Treasurer--Winnie Weitkamp/Darrell Gerster, West Central District. Nominations will be accepted from the floor at the December meeting.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Vote on Proposed Constitution Change to Article IV: Eleanor Stover submitted in writing and presented the second reading of a proposed change to the Constitution and Bylaws, Article IV Board of Directors, Section 2, to insert new B, move B to C, and C becomes D, as follows:

Article IV Board of Directors

Section 1. The board of directors is the governing body of the Missouri Federation with all powers which are allowed by the laws of the State of Missouri.

Section 2. The board of directors shall consist of the members of the executive committee, all members of the past president's committee, three delegates from each member district (one of which must be the district president or vice president), insurance coordinator, and the staff of the Federation's official publication, The DOIN'S, (The DOIN'S staff being: DOIN'S editor, circulation manager and advertising manager). A member of this board shall consist of a couple/single entitled to one vote only. If a couple or individual fills more than one position they or he/she may have only one vote.

- A. All members of the board of directors must be members of a dues-paying club in the district which they represent.
- B. All past presidents who have come off the past presidents committee are not a part of the established Board of Directors quorum needed for conducting meetings, but their votes count during any balloting. They may attend meetings and retain their lifetime voting privileges at meetings of the Missouri Federation of Square n' Round Dance Clubs, Inc. as long as they are dues paying members of a Missouri Federation club. These past Presidents are counted as an addendum to the quorum.
- C. The names of all delegates and alternates must be recorded with the secretary by January 31 of each year, in order for those delegates or alternates to be eligible to cast a vote at any meeting. Additionally, any change of delegates or alternates shall be recorded with the secretary not later than three weeks before the next scheduled meeting, in order for those delegates or alternates to be eligible to cast a vote at any meeting. In an emergency, alternates may serve if notice is given to the president and/or secretary prior to a regular meeting of the board of directors at which the alternates will serve. An emergency alternate must have the spoken or written approval of the district president.

- D. No couple shall serve in more than one federation office or directorship, except that an office holder or director may also serve as a presidential appointee identified in Article VII, Committees.
- Section 3. A vacancy created on the board of directors by the election of a delegate to the executive committee or by resignation shall be filled by the district affected by the vacancy.

The tabled motion from committee for the proposed change to the Constitution and Bylaws, Article IV Board of Directors from the August 17, 2008 meeting was brought to the floor for a vote. The motion was voted on in two parts, the first being Article IV, Section 1, Section 2, and Section 2.A and Section 2.B. The vote by a show of hands was 33 "yes" and 0 "no" recorded. The motion carried. The second part of the motion to be voted on was Article IV, Section 2.C and 2.D and Section 3 was brought up for a vote. The vote by a show of hands was 34 "yes" and "1" "no" recorded. The motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

State Festival Callers and Cuers for 2012: Dave Shafer with motion from committee proposed that Tom Manning from Burlington, IA. be the featured caller for the 2012 State Festival at a cost of \$500 plus lodging for one night. The motion carried. A motion was made from the committee to contact in-state cuers for the 2012 State Festival. The motion carried.

Bob Turner appointed Tom Miller to chair a committee along with Jim Marron and Jim Weber to make recommendations on Federation badge and bar purchases.

Bob Turner announced the USDA dues of \$100 were due and would be paid today, October 19, 2008.

Barb Turner was asked to write a letter for the Federation to the Surgeon General, asking him to make a recommendation that square dancing is a healthy activity.

CALENDAR OF EVENTS:

The next state board meeting will be in the Northwest District on December 14, 2008, at the Health Services Pavilion in North Kansas City Hospital, Prairie View Room.

The St. Louis Area Benefit Dance will be held on Sunday (October 26th). There will be a silent auction and quilt raffle.

The Ozark Whirlers Benefit Dance will be November 1st to benefit the Ozark Whirlers. Bob Huff will be the caller.

Little Dixie Squares will hold the "Dallas Wheeler Memorial" scholarship dance to benefit new callers on November 1st.

REGOGNITION OF HOSTS: The Northeast District and 2008 Festival Committee were congratulated on a great festival and were thanked for hosting the event.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mark Mortensen. The motion was seconded and carried. The meeting adjourned at 2:30 pm.

Every square dance organization needs General Liability and Accident Medical Expense coverage while conducting and sponsoring dance activities. As closely as safety rules are followed, accidents can and will happen. This insurance program, especially designed for USDA dance groups, provides Accident Medical insurance, which helps protect club members from financial loss due to a covered accidental bodily injury, and Liability insurance, which protects the club and its members and association officials from financial loss due to unforeseen incidents which may develop into litigation against members and dance organizations.

LIABILITY INSURANCE

Limits of protection: \$1,000,000 combined single limit of liability for bodily injury and property damage per occurrence (subject to a \$100 property damage deductible per claim) while participating in scheduled and sponsored dancing activities. \$100,000 limit for damage to premises rented to you.

Who is covered: The club and its members while participating in club or organization sponsored and supervised dancing activities. Liability coverage applies in the U.S., its territories or possessions, and Canada.

ACCIDENT AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

Limits of Coverage

\$10,000 Usual and Customary Accident Medical Expense, including Dental \$10,000 Accidental Death Benefit \$10,000 Accidental Dismemberment Benefit (loss of both hands, both feet, sight of both eyes, or any combination thereof) \$5,000 Accidental Dismemberment Benefit (loss of one hand, one foot, sight of one eye)

Note: Coverage is excess to any other valid and collectible medical insurance covering the same accident. Coverage provided for covered medical expenses incurred within 52 weeks of the accident up to \$10,000 for all eligible expenses as stated in the Policy.

Who is covered: Club members will be insured while participating in any regularly scheduled and sponsored dancing activity worldwide, including group travel (10 or more club members) in a vehicle commercially licensed for transportation of passengers and operated by a person holding a valid operators license for such vehicle, while being transported to or from a covered dancing activity.

What is covered: Accidental bodily injury sustained by an insured person while participating in dancing activities sponsored and supervised by a recognized club or organization.

Period of Coverage: The insurance year is January 1 through December 31. Coverage becomes effective for individual clubs under the policy on the day the application and premium for insurance is received by the USDA National Insurance Coordinator. There is no pro-rate provision. This is necessary due to the large administrative expense of maintaining different policy dates.
