- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum



To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI Card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents or Club Presidents). Each time a participant that has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.



Believe it or not, our "traditional square dance attire" is not really as old as some people would have you believe. It didn't evolve until the days when square dancing became popular after WWII.

There are several reasons that "traditional square dance attire" as we know it today evolved. One of the main reasons is a new-fangled invention, the television. Television brought popular country music shows into homes from Springfield, MO, New York City, and other locations that featured fast-stepping square dancers. The premier dancers were Lloyd "Pappy" Shaw's traveling troupe made up of teenage square dancers. Square dance attire across the nation mirrored the attire worn by these young dancers. At first, the young men wore traditional cowboy garb, while the young ladies wore ankle length dresses or skirts.

To highlight the fast pace of these dancers and to give these performers an identity of their own, costume designers put the young women into short-length multi-layered crinolines covered by a skirt or dress. Much of the time, these dresses, skirts and blouses were of gingham or sported polka-dots with puffy sleeves. Because of the nature of the dance and being on television, the women wore pettipants. The men wore long sleeved western style shirts, dress slacks, a scarf or bolo/string tie. Metal collar tips adorned the shirts while metal boot tips gleamed on the cowboy boots. Western hats were almost always a must for the men dancers.

This dress, first created for performers, became the "traditional" dress for square dancers around the world as square dancing became popular in the early 1950's and 1960's. Everyone in the world who saw square dancing on television immediately identified square dancers because of the dress they wore. Of course, this brought a lot of attention to the square dancers (many square dancers loved this attention) and helped promote square dancing throughout the nation. This so-called traditional square dance attire began to appear at square dances everywhere and it wasn't long before the traditional square dance attire, first worn on television was adopted by local, state and national square dance organizations as the proper attire to be worn to square dances.

Outside of the square dancers who perform professionally and those who put on exhibitions, participants are often expected to wear western-style "traditional square dance attire." Over the past few years, much discussion has been devoted to relaxing the dress code, and this has resulted in the adoption of alternative attire that square dancers may wear while dancing at a sponsored function. Today, most clubs allow the ladies to wear either the "traditional" attire or a long prairie skirt. From what I found, clubs sponsoring a dance are free to select what type of attire to be worn to their dances, and they should advertise the dress code that is expected to be worn to their dances. Clubs have a right to refuse admittance of any dancer not conforming to their dress code. There are many clubs that will not allow casual or alternative dress at their dances. If you plan to attend a dance sponsored by another club or organization, you may want to contact them first to find out what the dress is for the dance.

Many clubs designate casual attire during the summer months and wear the "traditional" attire during the rest of the year. The men should still wear long sleeved shirts. Most clubs wear casual attire during lessons, but may wear "traditional" attire on the nights lessons are conducted on their dance nights. Student dancers almost always wear casual attire until graduation. Some clubs such as youth, gay and challenge clubs may not have a dress code.

If attending a state or national convention, or other large dance, be prepared to wear "traditional square dance attire" or you may not be admitted on the dance floor.


