**LET'S TOOT OUR HORN**  
**A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE**

**T**his award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

A "Horn" will be presented to each club qualifying to be pinned to their club banner, with bars to be added for each completed year. A year will be January 1 through December 31 with the "Horn" or bars being mailed to each club completing requirements specified in guidelines.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- At least 6 items in local media (newspaper, radio, billboard, etc.)

**Complete a minimum of 6 items from the following:**

- At least 5 articles, ads or listings in the Doin's.
- 100% Doin's Club
- Philanthropic activity (i.e. benefit dance, fund raiser for needy persons or organization, scholarship, food pantry collection, adopt-a-family for a holiday, bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at a District dance
- A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4<sup>th</sup> celebration, fall festival, etc.)
- 100% Booster Club – State Festival
- ½ or full page ad in Festival Book
- Have a National Caller dance
- Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- Have a current District officer from club membership
- Have a current State officer from club membership
- Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- Visit at another district's dance – one square (8 dancers) minimum

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A listing of all clubs that will receive the HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the Doin's.

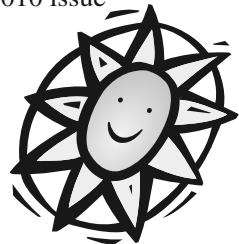

### **Mildred Francis “Milli” (Andrews) Crabtree,**

91, of Lake Ozark, Mo., passed away Dec. 4, 2008 with her family at her side. She was born January 31, 1917, in Puxico, Mo., attended Puxico High School and was Valedictorian of her 1935 graduating class. She and her husband retired to live in Lake Ozark, Missouri where swimming, skiing and fishing became daily life. She married Thomas F. Crabtree on May 25, 1945, in San Antonio, Texas and he preceded her in death in March 2005. Prior to becoming ill, Milli led an extremely active life. She had a special love of her home and family, music, friends and square dancing. As a long-time member of the Ozark Whirlers, she held many local and state offices. Milli and Tom received the first Square Dancer of the Year award in 2001. Milli was an advocate for the Jerry Lewis Muscular Dystrophy Foundation. On her 90th birthday, she was recognized by the team for her devotion to the club. In her quiet hours, she enjoyed playing the piano and listening to “big band” music. 

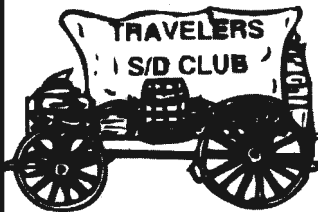

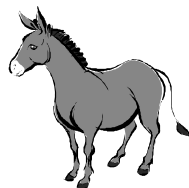

# DO YOU KNOW



by Dave Shafer

Once a year, a really big square dance takes place in Missouri. The purpose of this dance is to have as much fun as your mind and body can stand, and making new friends from across the state as you go. In fact, you will make friends not only with other Missourians, but dancers from neighboring states, and occasionally a foreign country. The state dance is sponsored by the Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs, Inc., and is a dance that you should not miss. Fun and friendship are at the front of all activities at the State Dance..

It all starts on a Friday evening at about 7:00 p.m. and goes until the callers, cuers and dancers call it an evening at about 10:30 p.m. Saturday morning, the festivities start all over at about 9:00 a.m. Each days dancing includes mainstream, plus, advanced, and rounds in their own respective halls. The Saturday festivities, with a dinner break in the afternoon, last all day and late into the night.

At most State Dances, Saturdays are when you can try the next level of dancing in workshops designed to introduce you to plus or advanced dancing. Other workshops often available include sewing clinics for the ladies, Contra dancing, club officer duties, recruiting and keeping new dancers, etc. Other clinics explain many of the programs offered by the Federation, i.e., Travel Missouri, State License Plates, Toot Our Horns, Blue Bird attire, and others. Depending on room availability, not all of these clinics are offered every year.

Before Saturday's opening ceremonies, a fashion show takes place. Individuals, couples, squares and once and a while a full club will participate showing off their fine square dance apparel, club dress, or perform skits and pull fun antics that bring laughter and fun to all.

At about 7:00 p.m. Saturday the opening ceremony begins. Our National Anthem is sung, color guards post the National Colors and important people such as local dignitaries and the Federation President welcome everyone. This is followed by the naming of the Caller/Cuer of the Year, and Square Dancers of the Year and then the big event of the evening takes place, the Grand March. Just about everyone participates in the Grand March knowing the evening of fun is just beginning. Getting to dance the first tip with the feature caller is a must. Spectators are often awed by the number of colorfully dressed dancers crowding onto the floor. After the dance closes for the night, dancers rush to after-parties, full of fun, food, talking, skits, jokes and sometimes dancing until the wee hours.

For those in the market for new square dance clothing, badges, dangles, belts, buckles, or anything else related to square and round dancing, vendors from several other states and Missouri set up shop offering their wares. The vendors open on Friday evening before the dance and are open all day Saturday until about 9:00 p.m. This is an opportunity that few pass by, new dresses, crinolines, pettipants, shirts, trousers, shoes and more.

On Sunday morning, the Show-Me DOIN's Donations dance takes place from 9:00 a.m. until about 11:30 a.m. Dress is casual, and donuts and coffee are provided for as long as they last. While there is a loose caller schedule, many of the callers team up in two's, three's, four's and more to harmonize. The "DOIN's Dance" provides some of the best singing, music and dancing available anywhere in the United States. To go to the Missouri State Square and Round Dance Festival and not attend the DOIN's dance is almost like going fishing and not putting a hook on your line.

We hope to dance with you at the Missouri State Square 'N Round Dance Festival 16, 17 and 18 October of this year. See you there.
