



TRAVEL MISSOURI

TRAVEL MISSOURI is a statewide visitation program of the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs.

It has been approved by the Council of District Presidents as an enjoyable method to enhance the dancing experience by expanding to include different dancers, clubs, callers and areas of our great state.

Participants if they so desire, may let people know what they have done by displaying the TRAVEL MISSOURI Bar and District Dangles identifying where they have danced.

BASIC RULES

- 1. The TRAVEL MISSOURI is available to any dancer within the Missouri Federation.
- 2. The TRAVEL MISSOURI traveling program includes visitation to the seven districts and the Missouri Federation Annual Festival.
- 3. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.
- 4. Participation in the TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant may at their discretion obtain the Travel Missouri Bar and earn dangles from the Program Manager. To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI Card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents or Club Presidents). Each time a participant that has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.

Things start off a little slow in July as our first Sunday dance on July 5th is cancelled due to Independence Day. Have a bang up time on the 4th!!


The action picks up on July 19 with Jay Wright, one of our best Missouri callers.

- 1. Dancers: we know you are coming because a lot of hotel rooms have been booked, but we might not have your registration form yet! Don't forget to register by October 1st or the price goes UP!
- Callers & Cuers if you have not responded to Al and Alberta Block, our caller/cuer coordinator, then please let them know you are coming! They will soon begin the hard task of scheduling callers and cuers into the time slots available.
- 3. We are encouraging ALL clubs to purchase an ad in the festival program book. Ad forms were distributed in the club packets that should have already been distributed to clubs by your district president. If you do not have one, contact them right away! These forms are also available on the website. Deadline for the ads is August 25th.
- 4. And speaking of the festival program book the cost of the festival program book is INCLUDED in the FULL registration price. If you only register for one day, then you must pay the \$5 for the book. We will be printing program books for those who order them, plus a very few more to sell during the festival. However during the festival the cost will be \$10, not \$5. So order NOW!
- 5. We are going to have several sewing clinics times and subjects are being discussed and will be posted later.
- 6. There will be a seminar on ARTS. What's ARTS you say? You've heard the acronym but don't know what it really is? Well come find out more!

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

A "Horn" will be presented to each club qualifying to be pinned to their club banner, with bars to be added for each completed year. A year will be January 1 through December 31 with the "Horn" or bars being mailed to each club completing requirements specified in guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS:

O At least 6 items in local media (newspaper, radio, billboard, etc.)

Complete a minimum of 6 items from the following:

- O At least 5 articles, ads or listings in the Doin's.
- O 100% Doin's Club
- O Philanthropic activity (i.e. benefit dance, fund raiser for needy persons or organization, scholarship, food pantry collection, adopt-a-family for a holiday, bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at a District dance
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- O Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4th celebration, fall festival, etc.)
- O 100% Booster Club State Festival
- O ¹/₂ or full page ad in Festival Book
- O Have a National Caller dance
- O Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A listing of all clubs that will receive the HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the Doin's.

DO YOU KNOW by Dave Shafer

The Missouri Federation recognizes clubs that have 100% of their members subscribing to the Doin's. These clubs are announced and recognized at the Doin's Dance on Sunday morning of the State Festival weekend and a list of these clubs is also printed in the Doin's.

Currently, there are three clubs that qualify as 100% Doin's Clubs for 2009. Clubs submitting for the 100% Doin's Club award have until the end of August to provide their club roster to the Doin's Circulation Manager who will check the roster against the subscription list to verify that the club qualifies. If there is a discrepancy, there is time to check it out.

How does your club become qualified for the 100% award? By submitting their club roster and having all members in their club subscribe to the Doin's, simple as that. It does not matter if the club pays for the subscription or if each individual member pays for their own. The qualifier is that ALL members subscribe.

Some clubs include the cost of the Doin's subscription in their annual club dues. The club treasurer then sends one check and a copy of the club roster to the subscription manager. As new dancers join the club, the club treasurer sends their money and the individual's information to the subscription manager.

With about 100 clubs in the Missouri Federation, why aren't more clubs qualifying for the prestigious 100% Club Award? Considering the vast amount of information in each issue of the Doin's, it makes one wonder why more dancers don't subscribe. There is a calendar of events, club contacts, club newsletters, word search, information about beneficial Missouri Federation programs, State and National Festival information, minutes of Federation meetings, advertisements, district dances, informative articles and much more. Some dancers make the excuse that they don't travel or they only travel to dances they are told to go to. But as you can see above, there is more to the Doin's than a dance calendar. A lot can be learned by reading the Doin's. We realize this article is being read only by those who subscribe, so if you know somebody in your club that is not a subscriber, ask them why not. Maybe you should share this article with them. If your club is financially solvent, maybe it could help defray the cost of the subscription price by paying half of the subscription fee for each dancer wishing to subscribe but cannot afford to due to some type of financial hardship. It might be that your club could pay for the first year subscription for new graduating dancers.
