

TRAVEL MISSOURI

TRAVEL MISSOURI is a statewide visitation program of the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs.

It has been approved by the Council of District Presidents as an enjoyable method to enhance the dancing experience by expanding to include different dancers, clubs, callers and areas of our great state.

Participants if they so desire, may let people know what they have done by displaying the TRAVEL MISSOURI Bar and District Dangles identifying where they have danced.

BASIC RULES

- 1. The TRAVEL MISSOURI is available to any dancer within the Missouri Federation.
- 2. The TRAVEL MISSOURI traveling program includes visitation to the seven districts and the Missouri Federation Annual Festival.
- 3. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.
- 4. Participation in the TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant may at their discretion obtain the Travel Missouri Bar and earn dangles from the Program Manager. To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI Card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents or Club Presidents). Each time a participant that has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.



Instructions to acquire your MISSOURI FEDERATION OF SQUARE AND ROUND DANCE CLUBS EMBLEM USE AUTHORIZATION STATEMENT

Every application for a organization license plate must be accompanied by an "Emblem Use Authorization Statement" which may be obtained from the Missouri Federations License Plate Coordinator for a minimum donation of \$25 annual registration. - O 100% Booster Club State Festival
- O ½ or full page ad in Festival Book
- O Have a National Caller dance
- O Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

For the past few years we have all heard that interest in square dancing is declining. Various reasons have been laid to blame such as, too many calls, too many programs, classes too long, and of course, interest in square dancing by the citizenry has declined because...... All of these reasons have existed even during the boom years of square dancing. Right now, we are in a decline of dancers, student dancers, and clubs, but we are up in the number of festivals and conventions that we can attend. Much of the time, the reason a club folds is because they are not really interested in actively recruiting new dancers. Each club has built a legacy, and it is a tribute and honor to the memories of the many former hard working members that current members of a club should do everything possible to keep their club active and well.

Today, we are competing with a lot of activities that were not around during the square dance boom years, but do we have to stand by and let these new activities whittle away at our numbers, our clubs and our federations? I don't think so. We just need to work harder to recruit new dancers of all ages. This means too that we need to keep our current dancers interested, invigorated and active not only in dancing, but in participating as ambassadors spreading the word of how great square dancing is. As you read this, remember, what is successful in one club is not always successful in another. Be resourceful and imaginative in how you recruit new dancers. Be sure to have parents include their children in lessons. Families are more apt to attend if they can include their children. It's cheaper than sending their children to a movie.

Recruiting new dancers is a never-ending task. This means don't wait until a week or two before lessons are scheduled to start to recruit new dancers. And, we can't expect to get new dancers by contacting the same people who say no, year after year. Club members need to recruit every day from the many people they meet each day. Members of our club are encouraged to spread the word every day of the year. They talk to people while in stores, standing in lines, and anyone else they meet. If a person is interested in square dancing, that person's name and phone number is taken and added to the club's master list of potential students. Seven days prior to the start of lessons, each person on the list is called and invited (reminded) to attend our "Fun Night." This is done again the night before "Fun Night" and on both occasions we are always enthusiastic and tell them how much we are looking forward to meeting them. Personal contact is and always has been the best way to enlist new dancers. Occasionally, we will have a student or two come to "Fun Night" because they saw one of our many posters, heard our lessons announced on the local radio station, or read about the lessons in the local paper, but once again personal contact wins out.

To gain personal contact with people in clubs, churches or other organizations, we get our caller invited to one of their activities without square dancer participation. The caller then gets these people up to show that square dancing is fun, easy to learn and something they can do with their friends and their families. Involving spectators at demonstrations, or benefits hosted by the club is very beneficial in giving people a taste of the fun and excitement they will experience as dancers.

To be successful in recruiting new dancers, the club members need to know class dates and schedules, length of the class sessions, class fees, where lessons will take place, who the caller instructor will be, attire for lessons, student interaction with the club activities and club members. Educate the club members by developing an information sheet that provides them with the information and answers they will need to know when recruiting new dancers.
