- O 100% Booster Club State Festival
- O ½ or full page ad in Festival Book
- O Have a National Caller dance
- O Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum



#### TRAVEL MISSOURI

TRAVEL MISSOURI is a statewide visitation program of the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs.

It has been approved by the Council of District Presidents as an enjoyable method to enhance the dancing experience by expanding to include different dancers, clubs, callers and areas of our great state.

Participants if they so desire, may let people know what they have done by displaying the TRAVEL MISSOURI Bar and District Dangles identifying where they have danced.

#### **BASIC RULES**

- 1. The TRAVEL MISSOURI is available to any dancer within the Missouri Federation.
- 2. The TRAVEL MISSOURI traveling program includes visitation to the seven districts and the Missouri Federation Annual Festival.
- 3. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.
- 4. Participation in the TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant may at their discretion obtain the Travel Missouri Bar and earn dangles from the Program Manager. To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI Card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents or Club Presidents). Each time a participant that has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.

Communication is an ongoing problem for every organization egardless of their size, complexity, individual concerns, and purpose. Square dance organizations and clubs are no different. The Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs, Inc., uses this publication, *The Show-Me DOIN'S*, as its means of communicating with the square and round dancers across Missouri. This communication provides you, the reader, with information about festivals (State and National), official minutes of the state meetings, club newsletters, programs sponsored by the State Federation, recreational reading and puzzles, advertisements, club contacts, caller and cuer directories, a calendar of events, and much, much more. In other words, it informs, announces, reminds, advises, instructs, advertises, communicates and entertains you. All the things a newsletter is designed to do.

This is the Federation's way of communicating with you what is available to you as a dancer that might be of interest to you. Communicating the square and round dance news to our membership is of utmost importance. With communication, you are better equipped and knowledgeable about what is taking place, what has and will be happening in your area, and what dances and events you would like to participate in.

But, communication is not limited to the state organization. Each district and club can and should communicate their important news about dances, fund raisers, community involvement, and news brought back from state and district meetings, and other events with their members. Members feel a sense of importance and of being wanted when they are included by communication. Think about it, it is likely that the only reason you are dancing is because someone communicated with you. It may have given you butterflies at your first lesson, but communication got you there. Now it is important to keep informed.

Newsletters are used to communicate with club members (active, inactive and absent). It insures all members are aware of club events, plans and actions so they can plan to participate too. A club officer or designated club editor should prepare the newsletter. Regardless, the newsletter preparer must have access to all that is happening in the club.

Newsletters, just like the *DOIN'S*, should be informative, attractive and easy to read. Remember, this is the way a club disseminates information to the members and you want to get their attention. The newsletter should be written in a newsy way making absentee dancers wish they had not missed a dance or event. Contents should be short, factual, accurate, impartial, provide a calendar of scheduled dances and events, and inform members of dancers who are experiencing illnesses or injuries, etc. Newsletters should never be used to criticize other dancers, club events, or the club itself.

I will provide further information about how to use and prepare a newsletter in the January/February issue of *The Show-Me DOIN'S*.


