LET'S TOOT OUR HORN A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

T his award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

A "Horn" will be presented to each club qualifying to be pinned to their club banner, with bars to be added for each completed year. A year will be January 1 through December 31 with the "Horn" or bars being mailed to each club completing requirements specified in guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS:

O At least 6 items in local media (newspaper, radio, billboard, etc.)

Complete a minimum of 6 items from the following:

- O At least 5 articles, ads or listings in the Doin's.
- O 100% Doin's Club
- O Philanthropic activity (i.e. benefit dance, fund raiser for needy persons or organization, scholarship, food pantry collection, adopt-a-family for a holiday, bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at a District dance
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- O Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4th celebration, fall festival, etc.)
- O 100% Booster Club State Festival
- O ½ or full page ad in Festival Book
- O Have a National Caller dance
- O Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A listing of all clubs that will receive the HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the Doin's.

DANCING UNINSURED - WHAT IT MEANS TO YOU

t is unfortunate, but each year several dancers become injured while at a square dance or while traveling to or from an authorized dance/event. So who pays for the medical expenses, property damages and other expenses associated with the incident? Your club? You? The individual(s)? Read on.

Is your square or round dance club conducting dances or sponsoring dance activities without General Liability and Accident Medical Expense coverage? Do you know that if your club is not insured and someone is hurt while attending your club activity, every member in your club may become financially responsible for paying all medical and damage costs associated with the bodily injury if a law suit is brought against your club due to negligence by your club or someone attending your function? Without insurance, you and your fellow club members may also assume the liability for any property damages to the dance hall that may occur during your scheduled and sponsored dancing activities due to negligence or willful destruction by someone attending your function.

You and your club can be protected by purchasing General Liability and Accident Medical Expense insurance for as little as \$4.50 per person. Your club receives \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit of liability for bodily injury and property damage per occurrence (with a \$100.00 deductible per claim) while participating in scheduled and sponsored dancing activities. The club and the members are covered while participating. This insurance is offered through the United Square Dancers of America. It is so simple to purchase and the protection benefits are so beneficial to every member.

Dancers also receive Accidental Medical Insurance in the amount of \$10,000. This includes Accident Medical/Dental Accident expenses; Accidental Death; Dismemberment Benefit for loss of both hands, arms, eyes, and \$5,000.00 Dismemberment Benefit for loss of one hand, arm, eye.

Club members are covered while participating in any regularly scheduled and sponsored activity, worldwide, including group travel (10 or more members) in a commercially licensed carrier vehicle operated by a person holding a valid operator's license for such vehicle, while being transported to or from a covered dancing activity which is a minimum of 25 miles from point of origin to destination (one way).

While some clubs purchase the insurance for their membership, others include the annual \$4.50 premium in their club's annual membership dues. Then all the club's insurance coordinator has to do is complete the request for dance location certificates, include a copy of the club roster and send the completed packet with a check to the State Insurance Chairman. To purchase this insurance requires that every member in the club be enrolled. The minimum fee per club is \$45.00 regardless of how small a club membership is. Can YOU and YOUR club afford not to be insured?





YOUTH CURRICULUM INTRODUCED

The annual Missouri Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance (MOAPHERD) convention for physical education teachers took place on November 13th at Lodge of the Four Seasons. This is the fourth year that the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs, Inc. has presented a program of instruction that encourages teachers to teach square



dancing in Missouri schools. During our first presentation, a hand-full of teachers attended, but each year since the number of participants has increased.

When Sharon Crisel, Gene and Martha Wilson, and Dee and I arrived, we had no idea as to how many teachers would attend our session. We are happy to say that more than five squares attended, including several children. That includes

one male teacher who was lost and came in by accident. We nabbed him before he could turn around at the door and leave, much to his enjoyment.

In the past, callers who graciously donated their time would be introduced and proceed to teach the basics of square dancing. The teachers always had a great time dancing, but they weren't really learning to instruct square dancing. At the end of these sessions, hand-outs were given to the teachers, e.g. "Courtesy in Square Dancing," "History of Square Dancing," etc. We also passed out a copy of the USDA's DVD pertaining to learning to square dance.

This year was a little different because we now have a draft Youth Square Dancing Curriculum Guide. Sharon Crisel used some of the \$500 grant money received from the Alliance of Rounds, Traditional and Square Dance (ARTS) to make 40 copies of the curriculum guide to pass out at the convention. Gene Wilson did an outstanding job showing teachers how easy it is to teach square dancing using some of the curriculum material. We thank Gene profusely. The teachers had questions that were answered. And, they were excited to find that they were to receive a copy of the draft curriculum guide to take with them. With the guide, we provided a list of Missouri callers so teachers may contact them. Many expressed a high interest in using our curriculum to reintroduce square dancing in their schools. They were all excited to know that the final draft curriculum guide is almost completed and are looking forward to receiving a copy of the final product. According to the course evaluations initially turned in, we were well received by everyone.

Keeping your membership aware of and up to date on matters is extremely important. Here, I will attempt to provide you with a few guidelines on getting the most out of your newsletters. There are hundreds of ideas on the internet.

Newsletters are used to keep club members up-to-date with information and news that may be of interest or use to them. To be effective, newsletters should be informative about up-coming activities/programs, and contain recent news or information about your club or member(s). News is news only if it is current, otherwise it is history. Newsletters should contain information about what is taking place in the district and state federation, such as current dancer issues for programs such as state license plates, Toot Our Horns, Travel Missouri, club insurance, etc.

Remember, what may not be news or of interest to you, may be of great interest to others. Newsletters are for educating and informing readers about events and programs at the local, district, state and national levels. Include a calendar of events that list club, district and state functions. Distribute the newsletter in a timely manner so that everyone has an opportunity to participate in upcoming activities.

Newsletters may be one page or more. Keep your stories short, simple, clean and to the point. Good writing commands attention, even if your newsletter lacks creativity or good design. Keep the appearance of the newsletter neat and legible. If you want to be professional in your writing, there are several style books that can be used, e.g. The Associated Press Style Book, The Washington Post Desk Book on Styles, and many more. When you have completed the newsletter, have someone check your articles for grammar, spelling, punctuation, syntax, and clarity of the information before running copies for distribution. Avoid expressions such as "a good time was had by all," or "it goes without saying," or "needless to say." Be newsy, but keep to the point.

If possible, include photographs and art work in your newsletter. This technique adds life to what is being read. But, don't get fancy with colored ink for text, newsletters look best and read best in either black or dark blue ink. If using color, use it sparingly for screen tints, large drop caps at the beginning of an article, page numbers and graphics that are repeated throughout the newsletter. Too much color is actually distracting. Many computers with programs such as Microsoft Word, Publisher or WordPerfect contain Newsletter templates. They can be very helpful.
