- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

Occasionally, someone will ask "What is Square Dancing?" One could say it is where 8 people form a square with a couple on each side. These 8 people work as a team performing movements as directed by a person referred to as a caller.

Learning to square dance is not too unlike learning choreographically arranged steps in a chorus line, play or movie. But, chorus line dancers or dancers in plays and movies memorize entire dance routines and much of this memorization is accomplished through grueling rehearsals. Think about this a moment. Square dancers memorize individual movements during lessons, a few movements at a time, and the caller puts them all together into routines that are fun and relaxing. In most cases, the more a dancer gets out to square dance, the better dancer he/she becomes. Getting out to the dances is practice and this practice (especially the yellow rocks) is fun.

Unlike the dance routines we see on stage or in the movies, square dancing is easy to learn by most people. Many dances such as the waltz, tango, mambo, etc. have specific foot placements, just like learning to walk all over again. Foot movement in square dancing is not a real concern. Square dancers learn to walk from place to place for specific distances and learn to work as a team. Square dancing is a continuation of what we naturally do all day long, walk. The hardest part of square dancing is learning left from your right, and learning to listen, but this doesn't take long.

According to medical organizations, square dancing is one of the most low stress activities we can do, and it is good for us. Square dancing actually reduces stress and relieves tension because it is fun, not a stressful workout. Square dancing is entertainment, socializing, relaxing, challenging, mentally stimulating, physical fitness, friendship and fun. Is it any wonder that many medical organizations recommend square dancing as one of their top activities for increasing physical and mental health, reducing stress, reducing the risk of diabetes, heart disease, respiratory disease and more.

One more note. Most people don't realize that once a square dancer has learned the movements, they can go anywhere in the world and dance regardless of language. Square dance calls are a universal language of its own, just as signing is a universal language for those who have lost their hearing.
