LET'S TOOT OUR HORN A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

A "Horn" will be presented to each club qualifying to be pinned to their club banner, with bars to be added for each completed year. A year will be January 1 through December 31 with the "Horn" or bars being mailed to each club completing requirements specified in guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS:

O At least 6 items in local media (newspaper, radio, billboard, etc.)

Complete a minimum of 6 items from the following:

- O At least 5 articles, ads or listings in the Doin's.
- O 100% Doin's Club
- O Philanthropic activity (i.e. benefit dance, fund raiser for needy persons or organization, scholarship, food pantry collection, adopt-a-family for a holiday, bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at a District dance
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- O Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4th celebration, fall festival, etc.)
- O 100% Booster Club State Festival
- O ½ or full page ad in Festival Book
- Have a National Caller dance
- O Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A listing of all clubs that will receive the HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the Doin's.





Each time a participant that has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive your Dangles, the signed card is sent to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you.

YOU by Dave Shafer

Square dancing is probably one of life's most enjoyable things to do. It is fun, invigorating, challenging, and it is a mentally and physically healthy thing to do for our bodies and mind. It is also a great way to meet other people, make friends that can be counted on, maintain a healthy outlook on life and much more. Square dancers are the most friendliest group of people you will ever become acquainted with. Of course, you and I already know all of this. It is too bad more people are not in on our secret.

Besides enjoying all of these great things, we have the ability in many cases to dance as often as we want. In areas where clubs are abundant or closer together, dancers can dance almost every night of each week. In areas where clubs are sparse, it becomes a challenge to dance more than once or twice a week. We have dancers who drive over 100 miles one-way just so they can dance more often. They do this two to three nights each week. By this, we can tell they are definitely dedicated dancers. How can they do this more than once or twice a week?

To do so can become fairly expensive as well as tiring, since some of these people have to get up early for work after getting home after midnight. If there is a dance they want to go to that is not close by, two or more couples get together and car/van/bus pool to the dance. When they get back home, or to the rendezvous point, each couple donates a few dollars to cover part of the fuel cost so the driver is not out all of the expenses. Another way to make traveling to a distant dance affordable is for each couple, who has a vehicle large enough to accommodate the number of dancers traveling, to rotate the driving responsibility. When this is done regularly, no money is donated toward fuel expenses, as each participant is taking a turn at driving their vehicle. Only those who do not share in the driving would then contribute money to help defray fuel expenses.

It is always fun to travel with other dancers. The stories, chitchat and camaraderie developed in these trips is priceless and fun. It is always a lot of fun to visit other clubs and the more clubs visited means that much more fun and friendship to be enjoyed. A benefit for the club being visited is that they are getting to meet you as well as you getting to meet them. Why restrict your dancing fun to once or twice a month? Get some of your dancing friends together and go out to visit another club. You won't know how much fun this is until you try it.
