T his award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

A "Horn" will be presented to each club qualifying to be pinned to their club banner, with bars to be added for each completed year. A year will be January 1 through December 31 with the "Horn" or bars being mailed to each club completing requirements specified in guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS:

O At least 6 items in local media (newspaper, radio, billboard, etc.)

Complete a minimum of 6 items from the following:

- O At least 5 articles, ads or listings in the Doin's.
- O 100% Doin's Club
- O Philanthropic activity (i.e. benefit dance, fund raiser for needy persons or organization, scholarship, food pantry collection, adopt-a-family for a holiday, bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at a District dance
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- O Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4th celebration, fall festival, etc.)
- O 100% Booster Club State Festival
- O ½ or full page ad in Festival Book
- O Have a National Caller dance
- O Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A listing of all clubs that will receive the HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the Doin's.

Each of us have a great time square dancing and yet our clubs have a very hard time recruiting new dancers. We want all non-dancers to join us so they too can enjoy the many benefits we experience, but yet they don't. Why? What scares the potential dancers away? Is it the great socialization and networking? Is it the wonderful health benefits of being in better physical and mental shape? Is it the wonderful food we get to enjoy at the dances? Is it the wonderful fun we have at the dances? Is it that square dancing can be a family affair? Is it the fact that they don't know about square dancing and our lessons?

Or, is it the fact that we all sit back and think these non-dancers are going to join us just because they have seen square dancers, seen a flyer, seen an advertisement in the newspaper, or just because they want to? There are people who will join us for lessons because of these reasons, but they are far and few.

So how do we get non-dancers to join us for lessons? The very best recruiting tool is personal contact. Each and every dancer is a recruiter. We can't sit back and rely on the other members of our clubs to recruit, because they too may be sitting back waiting for their fellow club members to do the recruiting. Recruiting is not hard, but does require a little bit of courage and knowledge about square dancing. The courage to talk and sell (salesmanship) square dancing to people we don't know because we firmly believe in it and want to share the experience. Recruiting is also a club-wide effort, not just the effort of one or two members.

Yes, put up flyers, run advertisements in the newspaper and on the radios, and hand out flyers at local businesses, and get your information out in any other way that is good for your club and community. Always include a phone number interested individuals/families can call for further information. Be sure to invite every person you meet in public to come to lessons. Remember, square dancing is also a family affair. Provide each club member with a few flyers or business size cards with lesson information that can be passed on to people who are interested. On the reverse side of the card/flyer list the many benefits of square dancing and why they should at least try square dancing on "Fun Night." If square dancing isn't for them, at least they tried it. Be sure to get the names and phone numbers of all people who are interested in learning to square dance. A week before lessons, call each number and remind them that they are invited to "Fun Night."

Square dancing and lessons are well kept secrets needing to be leaked to the public for their and our well being. We need new dancers and more clubs in Missouri. Let's do it right this year. Please don't be selective, RECRUIT AND INVITE EVERYONE TO LESSONS. Let everyone in on our secret.

Cross Trailers have been members for 60 years, Rafter Rockers for 55 years, Single Promenaders and Kelly's Klassics for 30 years.

Correspondence: An invitation from the Missouri Veterans Home in Cameron, MO, to a reception honoring volunteers and donors was received.

Get Well cards were sent to Barb Turner, Juanita Boyles, and Sherryl Schofield. Sympathy cards were sent to the families of Harold Hailey and Brenda Halliburton.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Budget Committee: Bob Turner reported that all accounts for 2009 were in order and accurate. He thanked the 2009 Audit Committee for its work.

Boundaries and Relations: No Report

Constitution and Bylaws: Tony Ahart reported that 2 new pages reflecting the changes voted on at the October meeting were available for all delegates to pick up.

Publication: Sharon White reporting. There were not enough responses to the survey about the contents of the Doin's' to make any changes, but most people seemed satisfied with the magazine as it is. Sharon presented a proposal for selling a jigsaw puzzle made from a picture of the Grand March at the State Festival to raise money for the Doin's.

DOIN'S Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. Edythe reminded us that May 25th is the deadline for the July/ August issue of the Doin's. Also all clubs that have a September to August year need to submit their full-year dance schedule by July 25th.

DOIN'S Circulation: Carol Morris reporting. The DOIN'S now has 51 free and

Total income was \$1,311.00, total expenses were \$28.00, total disbursement to Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs was \$1,282.00. Balance as of April 18, 2010 was \$101.00.

DOIN'S Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting: Balance as of February 13, 2010, was \$280.00. From February 13, 2010, to April 18, 2010, total revenue was \$863.50, expenses were \$54.90, and total disbursement to Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs was \$988.60. Balance as of April 18, 2010, was \$100.00.

Promotion & Recruiting: Marty Altman reporting. Thirty two active clubs have participated in the program since its inception in 1999. Twenty one clubs have completed the requirements for a "Let's Toot Our Horn Award" for 2009. Dangles and badges were given to the district presidents for distribution to the recipients in their districts.

Marty presented a Recruiting Manual, designed to help clubs get new members, with a request from the Promotions Committee that it be accepted by the Board of Directors. Since not all Board members have had a chance to see it, it will be reviewed and action will be taken at a later meeting.
