LET'S TOOT OUR HORN
A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

A "Horn" will be presented to each club qualifying to be pinned to their club banner, with bars to be added for each completed year. A year will be January 1 through December 31 with the "Horn" or bars being mailed to each club completing requirements specified in guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS:

- At least 6 items in local media (newspaper, radio, billboard, etc.)

Complete a minimum of 6 items from the following:

- At least 5 articles, ads or listings in the Doin's.
- 100% Doin's Club
- Philanthropic activity (i.e. benefit dance, fund raiser for needy persons or organization, scholarship, food pantry collection, adopt-a-family for a holiday, bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at a District dance
- A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4th celebration, fall festival, etc.)
- 100% Booster Club – State Festival
- ½ or full page ad in Festival Book
- Have a National Caller dance
- Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- Have a current District officer from club membership
- Have a current State officer from club membership
- Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- Visit at another district's dance – one square (8 dancers) minimum

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A listing of all clubs that will receive the HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the Doin's.





2010 SQUARE DANCERS OF THE YEAR



John and Eleanor Stover Ozark Whirlers Central District

John and Eleanor Stover began square dancing in the Kansas City area in the 1950's and belonged to the Do-Si-Do Square Dance Club before moving to Lake of the Ozarks.

They joined the Ozark Whirlers Square Dance Club of Eldon, MO in 1998. In 2001, they were elected presidents of the club and have served in that capacity since then with the exception of 2006. They are great leaders and have continuously been the backbone of the Ozark Whirlers for the past 12 years. They served as State Delegates for the Central District from 2000-2006. They were State 2nd Vice Presidents in 2007, and 1st Vice Presidents in 2008. They were Presidents of the State Federation in 2009. They continue to serve at the state level as chairman and members of several committees. Today they are Presidents of their club and District Vice Presidents.

Their dedication to square and round dancing has continuously led to their active participation at local, district and state levels. They demonstrate exemplary leadership, citizenship, sportsmanship and express a high level of integrity, honesty and ethics that become good square dancers. They introduced the "Pledge of Allegiance" ceremony to all of their dances and functions. They have been the motivators in leading their club members to visiting other clubs and districts on a regular basis. They have worked with many other clubs to promote and maintain square dancing in many communities. Their dedication has led them to hold almost every office in their club, as district delegates to the State Federation and offices in the State Federation including presidents. They purchased sound equipment for use during demonstrations and other events sponsored by their club. They are very active in promoting square dancing by initiating demonstrations, fund raisers and supporting their club and communities in many other ways, often traveling in excess of one hundred miles to fulfill obligations. They were also instrumental in the acquisition of the building they use, the continued maintenance of the building, and oversee the rental of the building to outside organizations reducing their club's financial obligations. They regularly attend all local district dances, district dances held by other districts, Missouri state festivals, national conventions, and encourage participation of other club members. They always set the example in being model square and round dancers in attitude, skill and dress.

John and Eleanor have actively square and round danced for over fifty years. They exemplify leadership by being great mentors to others and by encouraging leadership in others. They are always positive, encouraging, enthusiastic and quick to volunteer for whatever job that may present itself.

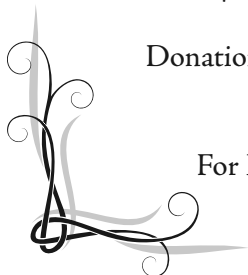

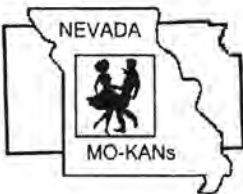

DO YOU KNOW



Becoming more active means finding an activity you really enjoy doing. That makes a lot of sense especially when most of us remember the negative aspects of exercising, such as being the last one chosen for a team; feeling clumsy in front of friends; the torture experienced while running, etc. I don't recall the last time I witnessed a jogger laughing, and having fun written upon his/her face.

Exercising should be fun, motivational, healthful, and so enjoyable that we want to do it again and again. That is definitely Square Dancing. As a form of exercising, square dancing provides the same benefits as other aerobic activities and we burn a similar amount of calories. Square dancing works because it doesn't feel like exercising. Instead, it reminds us of good music, good times and good friends.

The more vigorously we dance the better our cardiovascular conditioning becomes, lowering blood pressure, slowing the heart rate and lowering our cholesterol thereby improving our heart and blood vessel health. According to studies conducted by the Mayo Clinic and other health and medical organizations, we burn between 200 and 400 calories during every half-hour of dancing. While dancing may not provide all the conditioning we need, it does tone our muscles while relieving built up stress and tension that can lead to depression, strokes, and heart attacks.

The Alzheimer Association and other organizations dealing with dementia type illnesses tell us that our minds (brains) need exercise too, and recognizes square dancing as a major activity that helps reduce the occurrence or helps slow dementia type illnesses. Our brains get exercise while processing the moves being called and then making our bodies to do what is being called. We might say that square dancing provides us with a total workout that invigorates or rejuvenates us in total.

Think about this - we have an almost perfect, fun, entertaining and motivational experience that can be had by anyone. It is good for our minds and body and keeps us fit for a longer and more enjoyable life. Don't you wish everyone were a square dancer?

Expenses paid were \$279.78. The checking account balance as of September 30, 2010 was \$20,386.75. In addition there are two CD's totaling \$7,000. Total funds on hand equal \$27,386.75. The report was filed for audit.

Member and Club Longevity: At present, there are 90 clubs with dues paid and 3,099 members of the Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs. Carl asked that district officers send rosters of all clubs with dues for the coming year, so he can make an accurate list of statewide membership.

Correspondence: A get-well card was sent to Tom Miller.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Boundaries and Relations: No Report

Constitution and Bylaws: Eleanor Stover reporting. Several additions to Article 10 Section H "Hall of Fame Selection Committee" of the Standing Rules were recommended by the committee. Both of these items had been previously approved by the Board, but were never entered into the standing rules. The first was "The committee shall keep current longevity of all state callers and cuers, present all the awards to district presidents for presentation." The second was "25 and 50-year plaques, certificates for callers/cuers beginning with 30 years, in 5 year increments thereafter." This was approved by the Board.

Also recommended by the committee was the addition of the words "All reimbursements are subject to funding" as #6 in Article 10, Section J "Member Services Committee." This was approved by the Board.

Eleanor also stated that the committee would try to have complete corrected copies of the entire Constitution and By-Laws, and Standing Rules by the February Board meeting.

Publication: Sharon White reporting. The Federation received roughly \$495.00 from donations for the Doin's Dance. Fifty-nine puzzles have been sold, but 200 orders are needed. They are still working on the logo search for the *Doin's* magazine.

DOIN'S Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. November 25th (Thanksgiving) is the deadline for the January/February issue. All clubs' 2011 dance schedules are due, and if your club has a new location, please submit it. Please be early.

DOIN'S Circulation: Carol Morris reporting. The *DOIN'S* now has 29 free and 483 paid subscriptions. Financial report: Balance from August 15, 2010, was \$100.00. Total income for August 15 to October 17, 2010, was \$555.00, total expenses were \$39.00. A disbursement was made to Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs for \$516.00. Balance as of Oct.17, 2010, was \$100.00.

DOIN'S Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting: Balance as of August 15, 2010, was \$100.00. From August 15 through October 15, 2010, total revenue was \$746.00, expenses were \$4.90, and total disbursement to Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs was \$641.10. Balance as of Oct. 15, 2010, was \$100.00. Dave needs a schedule of callers for the clubs that have ¼ or ½ page ads. Again we were reminded that more puzzle orders are needed to reach the required minimum of 200 orders. Dave has responded to the request from the National Convention in Detroit for information about the Missouri Showcase of Ideas.

Promotion & Recruiting: Marty Altman reporting. There were 3 panelists and over 40 attendees at the Recruiting Workshop held Saturday, Oct. 16th. Overall, it was successful.

State Festival Site Screening: No report.

Insurance Coordinator: Dave Turner reporting. Balance as of August 1, 2010, was \$204.44. Income from August 1, 2010, through September 30, 2010, was \$9.00. Expenses were \$17.50. Balance as of September 30, 2010, was \$195.94. Insurance packages will be in the mail by the end of October.

Member Services: No report.

Travel Missouri: Ed Schofield reporting. We have 4 new members in the Travel Missouri Program and a total of 2,044 dangles for visitations have been given out.

Blue Bird Coordinator: Connie Hobbs reporting. Beginning balance as of August 15, 2010, was \$169.46. Two sets of Bluebirds and 1 set of braids have been sold for \$15.00, making the current balance \$184.46.

Historian: No report.

License Plate: J.W. England reporting. There were no renewals and no applications in the last two months, leaving a balance as of September 30, 2010, of \$51.20.

USDA: : Edythe Weber reporting. The application deadline for the \$1000 USDA Youth Scholarship is February 1, 2011. Information can be found online at <http://www.usda.org/youth>. The application form must be signed by the Missouri Federation President.

ARTS: Jim Weber reporting. A successful ARTS seminar was held Saturday, October 16th, with 23 people attending. This attendance qualified the Missouri Federation for a \$200.00 grant for this year's State Festival. Also, Arts presented information about the web site You2candance.com at the recruiting workshop. The web site is another tool to help us get new members. All Missouri square dance clubs are listed under "Find a Club" on You2candance.com. Please check your listing to make sure it is correct.

Ad Hoc State Festival Guidelines: Bob Turner reporting. A report containing conclusions from the surveys completed by Missouri Square Dancers and Committee Recommendations has been prepared and will be sent to all Board members.

Ad Hoc – Youth and Children Dance: Sharon Crisel reporting. Saturday, November 13, 2010, at the MOAHPERD Convention at the Lodge of the Four Seasons, Gene Wilson will present a workshop on square dancing to Missouri physical education instructors and recreation leaders. Written curriculum guides and other information about square dancing will be put into the convention packets of about 1,000 attendees.

District Presidents' Meeting Report: Vicki Wittman reporting. Discussion centered around this year's State Festival, the problem of clubs folding, and raiding and retrieving rules.

2010 State Festival: Vicki Wittman reporting for the St. Louis District. Attendance at this year's State Festival was 533 dancers plus 75 callers/cuers and partners, for a total of 608. Approximately \$12,101.00 was taken in for registration fees. There were a few minor problems, but overall the Festival was very successful.

Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame Committee: Eleanor Stover reporting. Stan Brooke was awarded the Caller of the Year Saturday night at the Festival.

2010 Square Dancer of the Year: Edythe Weber reporting. John and Eleanor Stover were awarded Square Dancer of the Year for 2010.

Caller/Cuer for State Festival 2014: Bob Turner reporting. The Board voted to extend contracts to Dean Dederman (caller) and John & Karen Herr (cuer) for the 2014 State Festival.

Bettyrae Fluke extended her thanks to all dancers who have treated her so kindly over the past year.

2011 State Festival Committee: Bob Turner reporting. The slogan for the 2011 State Festival is "Strut Your Stuff in Poplar Bluff." The caller will be Lottie Ainsworth, and the cuer Jim Couey. Shirts are now available. One hundred five registrations have been received so far.

NEW BUSINESS

The possibility of the Missouri Federation, along with the Heart of America Federation, hosting the 2015 National Square Dance Convention in Kansas City was discussed. Representatives of the Heart of America Federation were in attendance, as well as Karen Fleher, a member of the National Square Dance Executive Committee. Karen described the bidding process that would have to take place to sponsor a national convention. The majority of those attending the meeting agreed that co-sponsorship of a national convention is feasible and they would like to pursue the co-sponsorship of a convention. It was agreed that each district president would approach the clubs in their district to solicit support for a National Square Dance Convention in Missouri. Then by November 6, 2010, or earlier, the district presidents are to report their findings to JoAnn Miller, President of the Missouri Federation.

Recognition of Hosts: St. Louis District hosts recognized and thanked for a great festival.

Next Meeting: The next meeting will be Sunday, December 12, 2010, in Moberly, Missouri, at the Moberly Area Tech Center, at 12 noon.

Meeting adjourned at 3:30 pm.

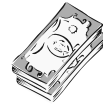
