
miss it. As I said, our April 15th dance is canceled due to the HASSDA Festival at the Cowan Center in Lebanon starting that night.

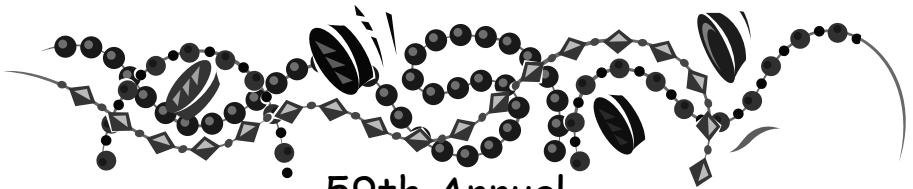

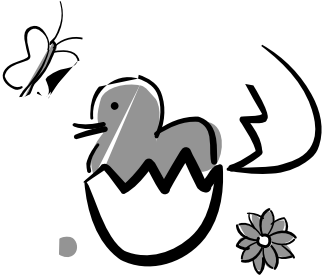

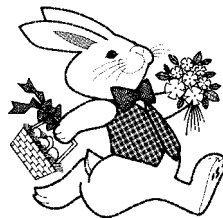

1. **FEATURED CALLER AND FEATURED CUER:** The Federation Board should continue to hire a well-known national caller and well-known national cuer for each annual festival.
2. **FESTIVAL DATE:** The Federation's constitution already designates the best time of the year to hold the annual festival.
3. **FESTIVAL SCHEDULE:** The present Friday night, Saturday, and Sunday morning format for the festival works well.
4. **FESTIVAL SITE:** The present policy of allowing the hosting district, after the Site Committee's approval, to select the festival site subject to the Federation Board's approval should be continued, as the site has normally been divided somewhat equally during the seven-year cycle between a central location and a rotation in cities around the State.
5. **FESTIVAL HOSTS:** Each district should continue to volunteer to host the

festival; however, the district must obtain the approval of the Federation Board for all the district's recommendations prior to implementing them.

6. **FESTIVAL BOOKLET:** The issue of providing a festival booklet was evenly divided in the surveys between the following three options: complete booklet with advertising, small booklet with no advertising, and no booklet at all.

7. **FESTIVAL ATTIRE:** The issue of attire for the State Festival was varied. The best compromise seems to be to allow casual dress for morning and afternoon activities on Saturday and Sunday, and request or require, square dance attire for the evening dances on Friday and Saturday.

Bob Turner moved to reaffirm that the Missouri Federation Board of Directors shall have the final decision in all matters concerning the Federation Festival. Motion passed.

Bob Turner moved that survey conclusions #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7 above be passed on to the Constitution Committee. The Constitution Committee will then prepare the changes to the Constitution and By Laws and/or Standing Rules where necessary to reflect the above conclusions. Motion passed. (Any such changes will then be presented by the Constitution and By Laws Committee as a new motion to be voted on by the Board of Directors.)

Bob Turner moved that the proposed change that, at a minimum, a small souvenir festival booklet must be provided for each festival, be sent to the Constitution Committee. The Constitution Committee will then prepare the changes to the Constitution and By Laws and/or Standing Rules where necessary. Motion passed. (Any such changes will then be presented by the Constitution and By Laws Committee as a new motion to be voted on by the Board of Directors.)

Bob Turner moved that the Constitution Committee write changes to the Constitution and By Laws and/or Standing Rules so that the "Timeline for Submitting Festival Activities" (below) is incorporated into the Constitution and By Laws and/or Standing Rules. Motion passed. (Any such changes will then be presented by the Constitution and By Laws Committee as a new motion to be voted on by the Board of Directors.)

TIMELINE FOR SUBMITTING FESTIVAL ACTIVITIES

36 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE FESTIVAL DATE:

- The Federation Board should select the featured national caller and featured national cuer. The Federation Board should select the district to host the festival.

20 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE FESTIVAL DATE:

- The hosting district should start giving festival updates to the Federation Board.

18 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE FESTIVAL DATE:

- The hosting district should request \$2500 start-up funds from the Federation Board.
- The hosting district should recommend a theme and colors for the Federation Board's approval.
- The hosting district should recommend admission prices to the festival for the Federation Board's approval.

16 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE FESTIVAL DATE:

- The hosting district should recommend the festival site for the Federation Board's approval.

14 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE FESTIVAL DATE:

- The hosting district should recommend any additions to the festival booklet to the Federation Board for its approval.

12 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE FESTIVAL DATE:

- After 9:00 PM Saturday of the current festival, the next hosting district may begin promotion of their upcoming festival.

6 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE FESTIVAL DATE:

- The hosting district should assemble festival packets for each club and each district president with information about the upcoming festival and distribute the packets to each district president for dissemination to the clubs in their district.

4 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE FESTIVAL DATE:

- No changes shall be made in the festival unless an emergency issue arises and the Federation Board or Federation Executive Committee approves of the change.

Bob Turner moved the Constitution Committee write changes to the Constitution and By Laws and/or Standing Rules to reflect that the hosting district shall keep 10% of the profit. Motion passed. (Any such changes will then be presented by the Constitution and By Laws Committee as a new motion to be voted on by the Board of Directors.)

Having no nominations from the floor, Jim Weber moved to accept the above slate by acclamation. Motion passed.

Jo Ann and Don Miller thanked everyone for their support and released their committees.

The new officers were recognized and the gavel was turned over to President Tom Miller.

Jim Weber moved that the Ad Hoc Committee for Youth and Children Dance be added to the Standing Rules as a permanent committee. Motion passed.

Bob Turner announced that we have received signed contracts from Dean Dederman (caller) and John and Karen Herr (cuer) for the 2014 State Festival.

The hosts for the 2011 Federation Board Meetings are as follows: February – Central Dist., April – Northeast Dist., June – West Central Dist., August – Southwest Dist., October – Southeast Dist., and December – Northwest Dist.

Northeast District Hosts were recognized.

The next meeting will be held at noon Sunday, February 20, 2011, at the Fairground Building, 8th and Maple, in Eldon, MO.

The meeting was adjourned 2:48 PM.
