

REQUIREMENTS:

O At least 6 items in local media (newspaper, radio, billboard, etc.)

Complete a minimum of 6 items from the following:

- O At least 5 articles, ads or listings in the Doin's.
- 100% Doin's Club
- O Philanthropic activity (i.e. benefit dance, fund raiser for needy persons or organization, scholarship, food pantry collection, adopt-a-family for a holiday, bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at a District dance
- A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4th celebration, fall festival, etc.)
- \circ 100% Booster Club - State Festival
- ½ or full page ad in Festival Book
- Have a National Caller dance
- Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting \circ
- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A listing of all clubs that will receive the HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the Doin's.

To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents, or Club Presidents or by visiting www.squaredancemissouri.com). Each time a participant who has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district, he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.





The meeting was called to order by President Tom Miller at 12:02 pm at the Moberly Technical Center, Moberly, MO.

Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag: Loretta Marron Pledge of Allegiance to the Missouri flag: Loretta Marron

Roll Call: Ron Selfors, 28 voting positions present, full quorum achieved.

Introduction and Welcoming of Visitors and Guests: Tom Miller welcomed visitors and guests.

Minutes of February 20, 2011 meeting: Minutes were approved with corrections.

Treasurer's Report: Carl Boone reporting. The beginning checking account balance as of Jan 1, 2011 was \$30,472.68. Revenue received in Jan, Feb and Mar was \$4,551.09. Expenses paid were \$24,724.29. Expenses included transferring \$20,000.00 to two CDs. The checking account balance as of Mar 31, 2011 was \$10,299.48. In addition, there are two older CD's totaling \$7,000 and the two new CDs totaling \$20,000. Total funds on hand equal \$37,299.48. The report was filed for audit.

Membership and Club Longevity: Carl Boone reporting. Dues have been received from 75 of 86 clubs on the rolls. 2,709 members are reported.

Clubs receiving longevity awards were Duck-N-Dive (Central District) – 55 years, Swingin' Singles (Northwest District) – 45 years, and Tanglefoot Squares (Northeast District) – 35 years.

Correspondence: Ron Selfors reporting. No correspondence was received. A get-well card was signed at the meeting for Dave Turner.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Boundaries and Relations: No report

Constitution and Bylaws: Sharon White reporting. Sharon provided the first reading of a proposed change to Article IV of the Constitution and By-Laws concerning addition of the webmaster as a voting member of the federation board of directors. The proposed change (add) is underlined:

Article IV Board of Directors

Section 1. The board of directors is the governing body of the Missouri Federation with all powers which are allowed by the laws of the State of Missouri.

Section 2. The board of directors shall consist of the members of the executive committee, all members of the past president's committee, three delegates from each member district (one of which must be the district president or vice president), insurance coordinator, webmaster, and the staff of the Federation's official publication, The DOIN'S (The DOIN'S staff being: DOIN'S editor, circulation manager and advertising manager). A member of this board shall consist of a couple/single entitled to one vote only. If a couple or individual fills more than one position, they or he/she may have only one vote.

A new edition of the Standing Rules, dated February 2011, were distributed to all board members.

Publications: Sharon White reporting. The winner of the Mar/Apr DOINs logo contest

was David Phillips, Lebanon, member of the Travelers, St. Robert.

DOIN'S Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. The procedure by which student free copies are provided is changing. The club with student dancers needs to call Carol Morris and let her know how many copies are needed. She will mail the copies to the club president along with a letter to each student asking them to subscribe. Final procedure revision will be sent to district presidents and federation officers.

Everything is going smoothly. She asked that reporters please keep their articles to 150 words or less and be on time. Try to discuss future, not past dances. If you must be late, please call Edythe or Jim and explain the situation. Sometimes late items can be accepted.

DOIN'S Circulation: Carol Morris reporting. Financial report: Balance as of Feb 20, 2011, was \$100.00. Total income for Feb 20, to Apr 17, 2011, was \$1,125.00; total expenses were \$69.10. A disbursement was made to Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs for \$1,055.90. Balance as of Apr 17, 2011, was \$100.00. Carol asked that everyone please help to get circulation numbers up.

DOIN'S Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. Balance as of Feb 20, 2011, was \$50.00. From Feb 20 through Apr 17, 2011, total revenue was \$4,079.00, expenses were \$3,169.78, and total disbursement to Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs was \$809.22. Balance as of Apr 17, 2011, was \$100.00. 350 puzzles have been ordered. 92 have been sold as of Apr 17.

Promotion & Recruiting: Marty Altman reporting. 32 clubs participated in Toot-Our-Horn in 2010. Nine clubs received badge or dangles (as compared to 16 clubs in 2009 and 19 clubs in 2008).

On Thursday morning, we were given a complete tour of the Spokane Convention Center. This included a breakdown of how each room or area is to be used. Thursday afternoon, I attended the Legal Breakout session and the Computer Coordinator Breakout session, while Dee attended the Secretary Breakout session. On Friday morning, we enjoyed a half-day city tour. Friday afternoon was reserved for NEC meetings with the 62 and 63 NSDC committees. These were closed sessions. On Saturday, we attended the general session of the NEC. Dee and I attended the Program Breakout session, and the Services Breakout sessions. Carl and Cindy attended the Business Breakout session and the Registration and Housing Breakout session. During the four luncheons and dinners we attended, Karen Flaher introduced us to each of the NEC members so they could see us and get to know us a little. I think this went well for all four of us. The Saturday evening dance was a success with nearly 900 dancers in attendance. We came back with lots of notes, handouts and materials that will assist us and our committees once we receive the bid.

On April 8th about twenty dancers and caller, Al Block, met with Becky Addleman from the Kansas City Convention and Visitors Association to video tape dancers dancing in several locations in and around the convention center. I understand that this went really well. That evening, Dee and I met Becky at the Lottawana Sailors dance in Blue Ridge to video tape the dance. Several clubs had made a point to support the video taping and filled the hall almost to capacity. Becky got some really good footage of the dance from both above and on the floor.

At this time, we are putting together our presentation for the bid session in Detroit. The bid session will be Friday at 9am at the Detroit National Square Dance Convention. All are encouraged to be there.

2010 State Festival ARTS Contribution. Carolyn McKeone stated that \$80.00 was collected at the 2010 State Festival for contribution to the Alliance of Rounds, Traditional and Square Dancing (ARTS). The funds have not been passed to them. Marty Altman made a motion that the funds be forwarded to the ARTS. The motion was seconded and adopted.

Competition Dancing. Vicki Wittman stated that she had found the 59th National Square Dance Convention rules for competition dancing, approved by the National Executive Committee (NEC) and passed them to Bob Turner, Chair for the 2011 State Festival.

Square Dance-Off Event. Jim Weber made a motion that the Federation (1) establish an annual Marvin Fluke Memorial Square Dance-Off Event at the state festival, (2) accept Bettyrae Fluke's offer to donate funds for prizes to be given at the event, and (3) designate the prize as a badge bar given to each member of the last square standing. The motion was seconded and adopted.

2011 State Festival Trail-In Dance. Bob Turner moved that a Trail-In Dance be held on Thursday before the festival. Motion was adopted.

Bob Turner moved that donations collected at the Trail-In Dance be donated to St Jude's Children's Hospital. Motion was adopted.

New Business

2012 State Festival. Joann Miller requested that Southwest District be given its \$2,500 in start-up funds. She stated that the colors will be teal and burgundy, and the theme will be Cruising Square and Round Dancing, a 50s/60s theme. The festival will be held at the Cowan Civic Center in Lebanon. The fee will be \$25 for the whole festival; \$10, for Friday night only; and \$20, for Saturday only. The DOINs dance on Sunday will be free, donation accepted.

Bob Turner made a motion to give the start-up funds to Southwest District. The motion was seconded and adopted.

The 2012 State Festival Committee moved that:

The District be allowed to have a large screen television as the raffle grand prize with cash second and third prizes. The motion was adopted.

The District be allowed to have 50/50 pots on both Friday and Saturday nights. The motion was adopted.

USDA Annual Meeting. Tom Miller asked for volunteers to be Missouri delegates to the United Square Dancers of America (USDA) annual meeting on Wednesday during the National Square Dance Convention week. The delegates will be Bill and Carol Morris, Tom

and Pat miller, Larry and Sharon Crisel, and Ron and Marie Selfors. The alternates will be Don and Joann Miller.

Showcase of Ideas. The federation will pay the registration fee for one couple that transports the Showcase of Ideas to Detroit. Tom Miller appointed Dave and Dee Shafer to transport the Missouri exhibit.

USDA Secretary Position. Jim Weber stated that the USDA would like to have Edythe and him nominated as secretary of the USDA. Dave Shafer made a motion to nominate Jim and Edythe Weber as secretary of the USDA board of directors. Motion was seconded and adopted.
