
On May 5 David McKinnon will call and on May 19 Robin Ragan will call for our club.




In Memorium Edward (Ed) Raney







- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

He filled all of the offices in his club and district, and served as Southwest District President for two years. Bob and Loretta were the Southwest District Ambassadors of the year and received several distinctive honors. They were named Missouri State Square Dancers of the year in 2004.

He worked hard as the Advertising Chairman and Editor for the "Show-Me Doin's." For several years, Bob and Loretta were put in charge of the transporting and setting up the Missouri "Showcase of Ideas" at the Nationals. His "Showcases" were always unique, educational and drew a crowd. He made friends from around the world. He would trade pins with anyone who had a pin to trade. Bob and Loretta were the Missouri Federation Treasurers, and 3rd, 2nd, and 1st Vice Presidents before Bob was diagnosed with cancer.

Bob will be greatly missed by everyone, but at the same time he will always be remembered in our hearts as a most fun-loving, generous and caring individual. Rest in Peace, and God Bless you Bob.



ORGANIZATIONS ROUND TABLE

If you have ever wondered how square dancing in your state was started, and has continued over the years, come check out the Round Table discussion and Power Point presentation on Washington State's Heritage Center. It will be presented by members of the Washington State Heritage Center Committee, and will include instruction on how to start and maintain your own state Heritage Center. The discussion will be in room 201B at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday.

SHOWCASE OF IDEAS

The Showcase of Ideas will have many fascinating display tables from various clubs throughout the USA, and from around the world. The displays will be located near the Exhibit Halls in the east end of the Convention Center.

PUBLICATIONS DISPLAY

The Publications Display will feature recent copies of square and round dance newsletters, magazines and other publications from all corners of the world. Tables and chairs will be available for you to sit down and browse through the publications, and make notes concerning ideas that may be helpful in your organization's publication back home.

A special feature of the Publications Display will be copies of the previous sixty National Square Dance Convention® Program Books. If you have attended previous Conventions, you can look in the books to see if you are in any of them, or if you recognize other dancers. It is interesting to view all of the changes that have taken place over the many years. The display will be located in the DoubleTree Hotel's Evergreen Room just off the Promenade.

EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES ABOUND

The Education Committee has put together a variety of Panels and Seminars that should be of interest to everyone. These are educational opportunities that you as a dancer, club member, or club leader, do not want to miss. Some of the topics will be presented on all three days, while others will be on just one or two days. The Education Rooms are easily accessible, as they are located in the Convention Center near the Ballroom Lobby.

A Panel is an audience listening activity that is conducted in a classroom setting with a moderator, and two or more panelists. The Panel members will make specific topical presentations based on experience, research and opinions followed by discussion. All Panels allow for audience participation through a question and answer session. Audiovisual aids and handouts may be used at the presentations.

A Seminar is also an audience listening activity with one or more persons providing the presentation. There are several to choose from over the three-day period of Convention. Each topic will be presented for 45 minutes, followed by 15 minutes of audience discussion. There will be Seminars presented by representatives from CALLERLAB, ARTS, USDA, ROUNDALAB, CONTRALAB and other leaders of the activity.

The Leadership Certification Program recognizes participation at the various Panels and Seminars. For Certification, attendance is required at no less than four Core topic sessions, and at no less than two of the Elective topics. Those of you that started the Leadership Certification Program at the 60th NSDC in Detroit may continue completing the requirements at the 61st NSDC in Spokane. Those of you that start the Program in Spokane, but are unable to complete it, may continue to completion at the 62nd NSDC in Oklahoma City.

So, while you are at the 61st NSDC, plan to attend as many Panels and Seminars as your schedule allows. You will be a better person for it; you will gain knowledge, and attain or work toward attaining Leadership Certification. Then you can take that knowledge back home and put it to good use.

Youth and Children Dance: No report.

District Presidents' Meeting Report: Marilyn Graham reporting. The committee revised the meeting calendar for the federation. St. Louis and Central have traded months. Revised meeting dates and districts responsible are Feb 19, Northeast; Apr 15, Central; June 10, West Central; Aug 19, St. Louis; Oct 21, Southwest; Dec 9, Northwest. Jim and Edythe Weber elected to lead the Square Dancers of the Year Committee.

2012 State Festival Committee: Joann Miller reporting. Planning for the 2012 Festival is going well. The festival will be held in Lebanon, MO at the Cowan Center. The theme is "Cruisin', Square and Round Dancing". The colors are Burgundy and Teal. Tom Manning will be the featured caller.

Two types of raffle tickets will be sold. The white ones will be for 50-50 cash drawing. The colored ones will be for two prizes - a 46" flat screen television set and a water fountain.

SW District moved that the program commercial ad prices change. Full page ad will go from \$70 to \$65. Half page ad will remain at \$40. Business card size ad will go from \$15 to \$20. Motion was approved.

2015 State Caller/Cuer: Tony Ahart reporting. The 2015 Festival Committee has selected Mike Hogan as the State Caller.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was none.

NEW BUSINESS

Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame Committee: Jim Weber commented that the five-year recognition program for callers/cuers seems to be inactive. Tony Ahart said that he would ask the Caller/Curer Hall of Fame Committee to address this issue.

Tom and Pat Miller, as immediate past president, are chairman of the Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame Committee. Tony Ahart directed them to develop a nomination slate for committee members to be considered at next meeting and prepare a ballot.

State Fair Dance: Billie Jean Butler (WC District) asked that the Federation and its clubs support their demonstration dance at the Missouri State Fair (Aug 9-19). Details to follow.

Jim Weber proposed that the DOIN's support with a full page ad at no charge to the district. Motion was seconded and approved.

2012 Budget: Carl Boone reporting. Carl presented a proposed 2012 budget for the Federation. The budget projects \$20,400 in revenue and \$20,430 in expenses. Motion was seconded and approved.

2011 State Festival Committee: Bob Turner reporting. The festival attracted 466 dancers. Profit for the federation from the festival was \$9.192.78.

Bob proposed that, beginning with the 2011 Festival, that the sponsoring district receive 10% of the net profits from the festival. If adopted, the policy will be effective for one full cycle of the festival (all seven districts). The policy will encourage districts to maximize income and reduce expenses. Jim Weber made a motion to table the proposal until the next meeting. Motion was seconded and approved.

Past President Recognition.: Tony Ahart presented a gavel and plaque to Tom and Pat Miller for their outstanding performance as President last year. They were also presented with their life-time membership card.

USDA Nomination: Jim Weber asked that the Federation nominate Jim and Edythe Weber as Plains Region Vice President for USDA. Dave Shafer made the motion, and it was seconded and approved. A letter will be sent to the USDA.

2013 State Festival: Tony Ahart discussed the 2013 festival and the motion that was approved at the last Federation meeting. At the last meeting the location for the 2013 festival was discussed. Two locations were identified: Sedalia State Fair Grounds, and the Hilton Garden Inn and Convention Center in Independence. Jim Weber made a motion for the Federation to not approve Sedalia as the site for the 2013 State festival. Marilyn Graham proposed an amendment to the motion to add that the Federation gives the District permission to reserve the Hilton Garden for the second weekend in October if the District so desires. The amendment was seconded and passed. The amended motion was approved.

Since that time it has become apparent that Sedalia would be the best festival location. Tony asked for a motion to rescind the motion approved at the last meeting. Jim Weber made the motion, and it was seconded and approved.

Club Move to Another District: Edythe Weber, NW District, asked that Federation approve the move of Silver Dollar Squares from WC District to NW District. Larry and Jan Anslinger, WC District, concurred. Dave Shafer made the motion. It was seconded and approved.

National Square Dance Convention Bid: Dave Shafer reporting. Dave stated that the Federation may be interested in biding for future national conventions.

A bid for 2016 would use St. Louis as the convention location. We would be competing against Amarillo, TX, and maybe Des Moines IA. Bid package would need to be in by Mar 22, 2012.

Kansas City may be available to support a 2017 bid. We may be up against South Carolina. Intent to bid would be made at the Spokane convention this summer. We would make the bid without Heart of America.

Jim Weber moved that the Federation announce our intent at Spokane to pursue the 2017 convention and that a bid committee be appointed at a later date. Motion was seconded and approved.

Future Festival Contracts: Tony Ahart will refer to the Constitution Committee the need for better procedures to review and approve future festival contracts.

CLOSE

Tony Ahart recognized the Northeast District hosts and the Tanglefoot Squares that provided a great dance the night before and the hearty lunch at the meeting.

The next meeting will be hosted by Central District and held Sunday, Apr 15, 2012, at 12 noon, at the St. Robert Community Center, St. Robert, MO.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:23 pm.
