To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents, or Club Presidents or by visiting www.squaredancemissouri.com). Each time a participant who has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district, he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.



A "Horn" will be presented to each club qualifying to be pinned to their club banner, with bars to be added for each completed year. A year will be January 1 through December 31 with the "Horn" or bars being mailed to each club completing requirements specified in guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS:

O At least 6 items in local media (newspaper, radio, billboard, etc.)

Complete a minimum of 6 items from the following:

- O At least 5 articles, ads or listings in the Doin's.
- O 100% Doin's Club
- O Philanthropic activity (i.e. benefit dance, fund raiser for needy persons or organization, scholarship, food pantry collection, adopt-a-family for a holiday, bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at a District dance
- O A minimum of one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- O Participate as a club in a community event (parade, July 4th celebration, fall festival, etc.)
- O 100% Booster Club State Festival
- O ½ or full page ad in Festival Book
- O Have a National Caller dance
- O Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- O Have a current District officer from club membership
- O Have a current State officer from club membership
- O Conduct a complete set of lessons, any level
- O Visit at another district's dance one square (8 dancers) minimum

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A listing of all clubs that will receive the HORN or BAR for the current year will be in the Doin's.



COMMITTEE REPORTS

Audit: Bill Morris reporting. All of the 2011 funds/accounts were audited by Bill or Connie Hobbs, and all income and expenses were accounted for and the funds/accounts were found to be correct and in good order.

Boundaries and Relations: Marilyn Graham reporting. Marilyn stated that there was discussion at the District President Committee concerning clubs that wish to move to other districts due to loss of local clubs and new relationships. The committee will be looking at redrawing district lines.

Constitution and Bylaws: No report.

Publications: Edythe Weber reporting. 73 reminder post cards were sent. There were 66 renewals. The post cards will soon be replaced with e-mails for those who have e-mail addresses. The Wal-Mart cards used to reward logo finders are bought at 50% face value.

DOIN's Editor: Tony Ahart reporting for Edythe Weber. Next publication deadline is July 25. Please be on time or early.

DOIN'S Circulation: Carol Morris reporting. Balance as of Apr 10, 2012, was \$100.00. From Apr 10 through Jun 10, 2012, total revenue was \$825.00, expenses were \$32.69, and total disbursement to Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs was \$792.31. Balance as of Jun 10, 2012, was \$100.00.

DOIN'S Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. Balance as of Apr 15, 2012, was \$100.00. From Apr 15 through Jun 10, 2012, total revenue was \$515.00, expenses were \$5.15, and total disbursement to Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs was \$409.85. 2012 State Festival: Carol Morris reporting. Planning for the 2012 Festival is going well. The festival will be held in Lebanon, MO at the Cowan Center. The theme is "Cruisin' Round the Square". The colors are Burgundy and Teal. Tom Manning will be the featured caller. Need folks to register.

2013 State Festival: Ed Schofield reporting. The 2013 Festival will be hosted by West Central District and will be at the Sedalia State Fair Grounds, 11-13 Oct. The theme will be

"Roaring Ragtime Express." The colors are red, white and black. A highlight of the festival will be dancing on the Katy Trail.

2015 State Caller/Cuer: Tony Ahart reporting. The 2015 Festival Committee has selected Mike Hogan as the State Caller, and the Tuckers from Nebraska as the State Cuers.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Festival Profit Sharing: Bob Turner reporting. A motion was made at the Feb meeting to establish a policy that districts hosting a state festival will be allowed to retain 10 percent of net profits from the festival. The policy would start with 2011 festival and continue for at least seven years so all districts have a chance to profit. Policy will promote maximizing income and reducing expenses. After discussion the motion was approved.

Finance-Related Resolution: Carl Boone reporting. Carl asked that a resolution be passed that would authorize the establishment of a new insurance bank account and the cashing of a maturing certificate of deposit at the Versailles Bank. Carl made the motion, it was seconded and approved.

National Square Dance Conventions: Carl Boone reporting.

Missouri square dancers are heavily involved in the Arkansas convention in 2014. Jim Weber is the education committee chairman and most of the education committee is made up of Missouri dancers. Jim is looking for someone to be chair of the showcase of ideas.

The Federation board approved a motion at Feb meeting to announce our intent at Spokane to pursue the 2017 convention, and that a bid committee be appointed at a later date. However, a suitable convention site for 2017 is not available. Earliest would be 2018 in Kansas City. Intent to bid would be made at the Spokane convention this summer. However, the Kansas City Convention Center has sent a letter to the National Executive Committee (organization that manages the national square dance conventions) stating that (1) the the bid would have to be formally bid in 2013 in Oklahoma City (one year earlier than normal), (2) in the event that another group wants to commit for the convention center in 2018, NEC would have 48 hours to formalize their commitment to Kansas City, and (3) the NEC will have to guarantee that there will be no competition for the convention.

Tony Ahart asked for a member to make a motion to allow Carl and Cindy to announce Missouri's intent to pursue the 2018 convention in Kansas City. Pat Miller made the motion, and it was seconded. The motion was approved.
