Insurance Procedures

A club obtaining USDA Dancer Insurance through the Missouri Federation must complete the following:

- Federation/Association Club listing form, <u>Missouri Club Enrollment Form</u>, listing club information and <u>all</u> facilities you will be using during the year. You will receive a Certificate for each facility listed. (You do not need to fill out the Request for Certificate Form if the facility is listed on this form.)
- Complete a Club Roster Form, listing all dancers being insured through your club on this form. Dancers must be listed in alphabetical order, one dancer per line. (Do not send your club roster.) Only the Club Roster Form will be accepted.
- 3. If you have dancers that pay USDA insurance through another club, you must also complete a **Club Roster of Dancers Insured Through Another Club Form**. Dancers must be listed in alphabetical order, one dancer per line.
- 4. Remember 100% of your club members must be insured.
- 5. Send check with forms, \$4.50 per dancer insured through your club.
- 6. When you have new dancers join your club you must complete the Additional Dancer Enrollment Form listing additional dancers being insured through your club. Dancers must be listed in alphabetical order, one dancer per line. Send check with forms, \$4.50 per additional dancer being insured through your club.
- 7. Club Sponsored Classes: When your club has a new dancer class, you must complete 2 forms. 1st a Club Sponsored Class Form; each new dancers must be listed in alphabetical order, one dancer per line. You must also have a beginning and ending date for your class. These new dancers are insured at no cost during your class. At the end of your class or graduation their insurance expires. They then must enroll through your club or another club. 2nd if your class location is different than the ones you submitted on the Club Enrollment Form you must complete an Event Notification Form, and if you need a certificate of insurance you must also complete a Request For Certificate Form.
- 8. When any dancer is involved in an accident, the club must complete an Accident Report Form and send completed form to Missouri Insurance Chairman within 48 hours of the accident. See Club Accident Procedures.

All these forms are available on the Missouri Federation website as fillable forms you can save to your computer. **www.SquareDanceMissouri.com** and click on Insurance.

February brings somewhat of a special dance with two young callers putting us "old folks" through our paces! Jammer Cochran and David


McKinnon will be joining us to call our February 1st dance. Our second dance will bring one of our club callers, Doug Mallory, in to call for us! This dance will be February 15th.

NEW CRITERIA BEGINNING JANUARY 2013

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund
 raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a
 food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army,
 etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.



Webmaster: Dan Wheeler reporting. Here are some suggestions to make computers and internet more friendly.:

Old Website. I was recently told of someone who did a search for Square Dancing in Missouri and found an old Google website dated Nov 2000. This website was put up by a former member. It has the Missouri Federation letterhead at the top. He copied my web pages at the time and left my name at the bottom of the pages. The information, of course, is 12 years old and quite out of date. Since I didn't put the website up, I don't have the user name and password to take it down, or Auto forward it to our current site.

This brings up the important point. Maintaining a website takes a lot of time. Once a website is set up, especially a free site, it stays there, virtually forever. An out of date site is worse than no site at all. If you decide to put up a website for your club, or for anything for that matter, be sure that someone is committed to maintaining it. In addition, be sure that someone reliable has the user name and password.

Transferring Pictures and Other Files. I have recently made an "FTP" site specifically for sending pictures to me, but it can also be used for other things. If any of you are having trouble sending files to each other attached to E-Mail, I would suggest this as an alternative. Since this is something that I expect very few of you have ever done, I will probably have to walk you through the process if you want to try it. Let me know if any of you have any interest.

Updating Website Info. Please remind your clubs that to update your information anywhere on the Missouri Federation website, please use the "Update Forms". You can find them by clicking on the "Update Information" button on the lower left of the

home page. I can't tell you how often I get an e-mail saying please change our caller, and nowhere on the e-mail is the name of the club. The forms prompt you to give me the information I need.

New Project. All dances in Missouri and NE Kansas are being put in a database. All web pages with dance listings will get their information from that database. That means that the dance listing for your club's dances attached to your club's web page will have gotten its information from that database. If the information there is wrong or missing, it is probably also wrong or missing in the DOINs.

Travel Missouri: Jim Marron reporting. As of Oct 18, 2012, 1,162 dancers have received 2,530 sets. 46 dancers have their eighth set, 24 dancers have their ninth set, and 19 dancers are beginning their tenth set.
