

Jack Gipson 74, of Sedalia, passed away on Thursday November 29, 2012, at the Sylvia G. Thompson Residence Center in Sedalia. He was there only 3 weeks. His loving wife Joanne cared for him up to this time. He was born February 10, 1938 in Carns, Nebraska. He and his wife Joanne Swim were united in marriage on April 30, 1961 in Florence, MO.

After serving his country honorably in the United States Army, Jack and Joanne lived on a farm near Fortuna, MO. until 1981, then moved to Sedalia, MO. He was a delivery and service technician for Culligan Water Conditioning until 1999, when he had to quit because of health problems. In 2007, he was diagnosed with Lewy Body Dementia. He loved to Square Dance and was a member of the "Ozark Whirlers" in Eldon, and the "Diamond B's" in Sedalia. He had to quit Square Dancing in 2006, but continued to go with his wife where he enjoyed the companionship of his fellow dancers.

Besides his wife, he is survived by; three sisters, one brother in law and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents. Memorial graveside services were held at the Missouri State Veterans Cemetery in Higginsville, MO.



IN MEMORY OF WILLIE "LEE" DOUBLIN

Willie Lee Doublin passed away unexpectedly in his sleep on January 27,2013. He left behind his loving wife Fern, two children and their spouses, four grandchildren, and two great grandchildren.



Lee loved his family, square dancing, listening to old time country western music, drinking coffee, fixing anything, listening to others, and his black pick-up truck.

He detested ballroom dancing and declared to Fern, after finishing a set of lessons to keep her mind off chemotherapy that he didn't intend to do that again. Instead, they learned to square dance with Mike Corns, and Lee found a new passion. On the first night of dancing, they met new friends and Lee served as Best Man at their wedding. Lee and Fern became members of the Wheelers and Dealers, Ozark Lakers, and Millstone Wheelers. A very quiet person, he became a strong president several times for the Lakers until their closing, served as treasurer of Central District for several years, and contacted and scheduled callers and cuers for two state dances.

He genuinely believed if clubs opened membership to single women, the male members had an obligation to keep them dancing. He wasn't always the first to ask them, but when Fern's illness kept her away from dances, he would go long enough to see that there were enough men present to keep them dancing. Often he would return home early and say, "They had partners, and I'd rather dance with you".

After a week in the hospital and nearly two weeks in the rehab center, Lee was excited to be going home the next day. We all forgot to ask, "Which home?". He will be missed by all who knew him as a loved one, a square dancer and a friend.



NEW CRITERIA BEGINNING JANUARY 2013

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund
 raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a
 food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army,
 etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.

Boundaries and Relations: No report.

Constitution and Bylaws: Eleanor Stover reporting. Eleanor provided the second reading of a proposed change to the by-laws related to state meeting times. Proposed change to the Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance clubs, Inc. Constitution and Bylaws: Article VI, Meetings, Section 1: Regular, shall be changed to read:

Regular meetings of the board of directors shall be held six times a year, hosted by member clubs. Meetings will be held in the district in which the club is a member. A dance, the

night before the meeting, shall be held if possible. Meetings shall be on the second or third Sunday of February, April and August; the meeting designated as the festival meeting shall be on the Sunday of the annual festival, and the June and December meetings shall be on the first or second Sunday. Within ten days of each state meeting, each board of director member will receive uncorrected minutes of said meeting, either by e-mail to those who have e-mail addresses, or mailed to those members who do not have e-mail addresses. Notices of upcoming meetings with a copy of the previous meeting minutes and agenda of all business known to the executive committee to be brought before the board of directors shall be either e-mailed to those with an e-mail address, or mailed to those members of the board of directors who do not have an e-mail address, postmarked at least 10 days before the meeting. The meeting dates for the coming year shall be adopted at the December meeting.

DOIN'S Circulation: Carol Morris reporting. Balance as of Dec 9, 2012, was \$100.00. The clubs are: Central: Duck N Dive, Millstone Wheelers; Northeast: Beaux & Belles, Capital City Squares, Tanglefoot Squares; Northwest: Swinging Singles; Southeast: Puxico County Squares; Southwest: Mo-Kan Squares, Pommenaders, Rangers; and St. Louis: Missouri Promenaders.

State Festival Site Screening: No report.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. Balance as of Dec 10, 2012 was \$185.45. For the period Dec 10, 2012 - Feb 17, 2013, program income was \$2,785.50, and the program expenses were \$2,752.10. The end balance is \$218.85. Currently, 50 clubs were insured through the Federation; and 12 clubs, through other federations. 1,743 dancers are insured through the Federation. Volunteers were: Tom and Pat Miller, NW; Dave and Dee Shafer, CD; Ray and Vicki Wittman, SL; and George and Cleva Roth, NE. The directors approved the slate.

Larry Anslinger recognized the Northwest District hosts that provided the hearty lunch at the meeting. The next meeting will be hosted by the Central District on Sunday, Apr 14, 2013, at 12 noon, at the St. Robert Community Center in St. Robert, Missouri. The Spring Fling Dance will be held at the same location on Saturday, Apr 13, from 3-7pm. There will be an all-you-can-eat dinner from 5:30-7:00pm. Cost for all is \$7 per person (\$3.50 for 18YO and younger). The meeting was adjourned at 3:00 pm.
