

To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.

Eleanor A. Stover

Eleanor A. Stover, 81, of Climax Springs, MO passed away April 22, 2013 at Lake Regional Health Systems in Osage Beach. She was born on February 18, 1932 in Eldon, MO, the daughter of the late Fred & Nellie Lawbaugh. She moved to Kansas City, MO in 1948 and attended Manual High School. She was united in marriage in 1951 with John Stover who survives her.



Eleanor was employed with the Children's Mercy Hospital in the Print Shop and worked part-time for many years at the American Royal, retiring from the Kansas City Royals in 1993 when they retired to the Lake of the Ozarks area.

Eleanor and John started dancing with the Do Si Doer's in the 1950's, starting a dancing career of over sixty (60) years. Square dancing became a passion of Eleanor's. She became an Ozark Whirler in 1998 and shared the responsibilities as club president with John since 2001 with the exception of 2006. Everything she did in square dancing was shared with John. She served as State Delegate for the Central District from 2000 to 2006. She was a driving force as 2nd Vice President in 2007, and 1st Vice President in 2008. She became President of the Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs, Inc. in 2009. Eleanor continued to serve as chairman and members of several state committees. Eleanor and John were selected Square Dancers of the year in 2010.

Eleanor was dedicated to square and round dancing and continuously participated at local, district and state levels in whatever capacity she needed in order to promote square and round dancing. She demonstrated a high level of leadership, citizenship, sportsmanship, and held a high level of integrity, honesty and ethics. She introduced the "Pledge of Allegiance" before all of their dances and functions. She was a motivator leading the Ozark Whirlers to many great accomplishments. She worked hard to promote and maintain square dancing in their community as well as throughout Missouri. She was instrumental in purchasing sound equipment for the club to use during demonstrations and other club/community functions. She was instrumental in the acquisition of the building they use, the continued maintenance of the building and the rental of the hall to outside organizations thereby reducing their clubs financial obligations. Eleanor attended all local conventions and encouraged other dancers to attend also.

Eleanor touched the lives of everyone she met and will be sorely missed by everyone in the square and round dancing world. God Bless You Eleanor for bringing so much joy and happiness to the many people you met and knew.

NEW CRITERIA BEGINNING JANUARY 2013

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.

DOIN'S Circulation: Carol Morris reporting. Balance as of Feb 10, 2013, was \$100.00. From Feb 10 through Apr 13, 2013, total revenue was \$1,020.00, expenses were \$14.75, and

total disbursement to Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs was \$1,005.25. Balance as of Apr 13, 2013, was \$100.00. For the May/Jun 2013 issue, there are 431 paid subscriptions.

DOIN'S Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. Balance as of Feb 17, 2013, was \$100.00. They also discussed the fact that federation members who dance at nonfederation clubs will not be covered by federation dance insurance.

Youth and Children Dance: No report.

Eleanor also requested permission to open a checking account for the 2014 Festival. The Treasurer for the Festival, who will have signature authority for the checking account, is Jan Vaughn. The motion was approved.

Arkansas Pre-Convention: Carl and Cindy Boone reporting. They and a number of other Missouri dancers participated in the pre-convention meetings and dance in Little Rock. Cindy felt that the convention planners got passing marks for their effort to date and the dance was good.

Blue Bird Braid Price Increase. Connie Hobbs, Blue Bird Coordinator, moved from committee that the price of the braid be increased to \$8.00. The motion was approved.


