Influenced by the folk dances and music of many immigrants, it morphed into Modern Western Square Dance, an American tradition with its distinctive attire, recognized internationally and is the official dance of 19 states.

Thanks to Lloyd Shaw, the standardization of calls means we can dance the same moves whether called by Monty Hackler who will be at the Millstones September 15th for our anniversary dance (31 years) or Joe Goins who calls October 6th or Larry Dudgeon who calls October 20th, and in all states and countries! 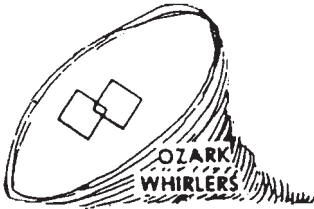

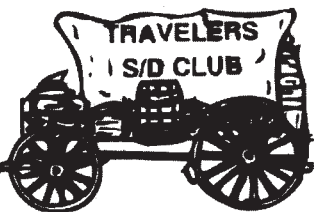

In Memory of Albert T. Holt

JANUARY 15, 1924 – JUNE 1, 2013



Albert T. Holt, son of John S. Holt and Clara Terrill Holt was born in Raymondville, Missouri on January 15, 1924 and departed this life on June 1, 2013. He graduated from Rolla High School in 1941 and in October 1942 enlisted in the Navy. He received his gold wings and commission in December 1944. He was married on February 27, 1945 to Anna Jean Hollis of St. Louis, Missouri, who survives. They celebrated 68 happy years together. To this union three children were born, Linda (Harold) Meyer of St. Charles, Mo., John H. Holt, deceased (2008) and Catherine Wagner of Mesa, Calif. He was a loving and proud grandfather to Jennifer (Randy) Wyatt, Steve (Heather) Meyer and Katie (Jason) Heisel, and also a great grandpa to seven and great great grandpa to two.

Al, Jean and their family traveled extensively during his 27 years in the U.S. Navy. He served in WWII, in Korea on the USS Valley Forge and in VQ-1 during Vietnam. They spent three years in Hawaii while it was still a territory. In 1963 he was sent to Japan where he and his family spent almost four years. It was the highlight of his Navy career as he was Executive Officer and then Commanding Officer of a large Reconnaissance Squadron. He retired from the Navy in 1969 at the rank of Commander at which time the family settled in Phelps County on the Big Piney River, started raising cattle and building a new house to settle in permanently.

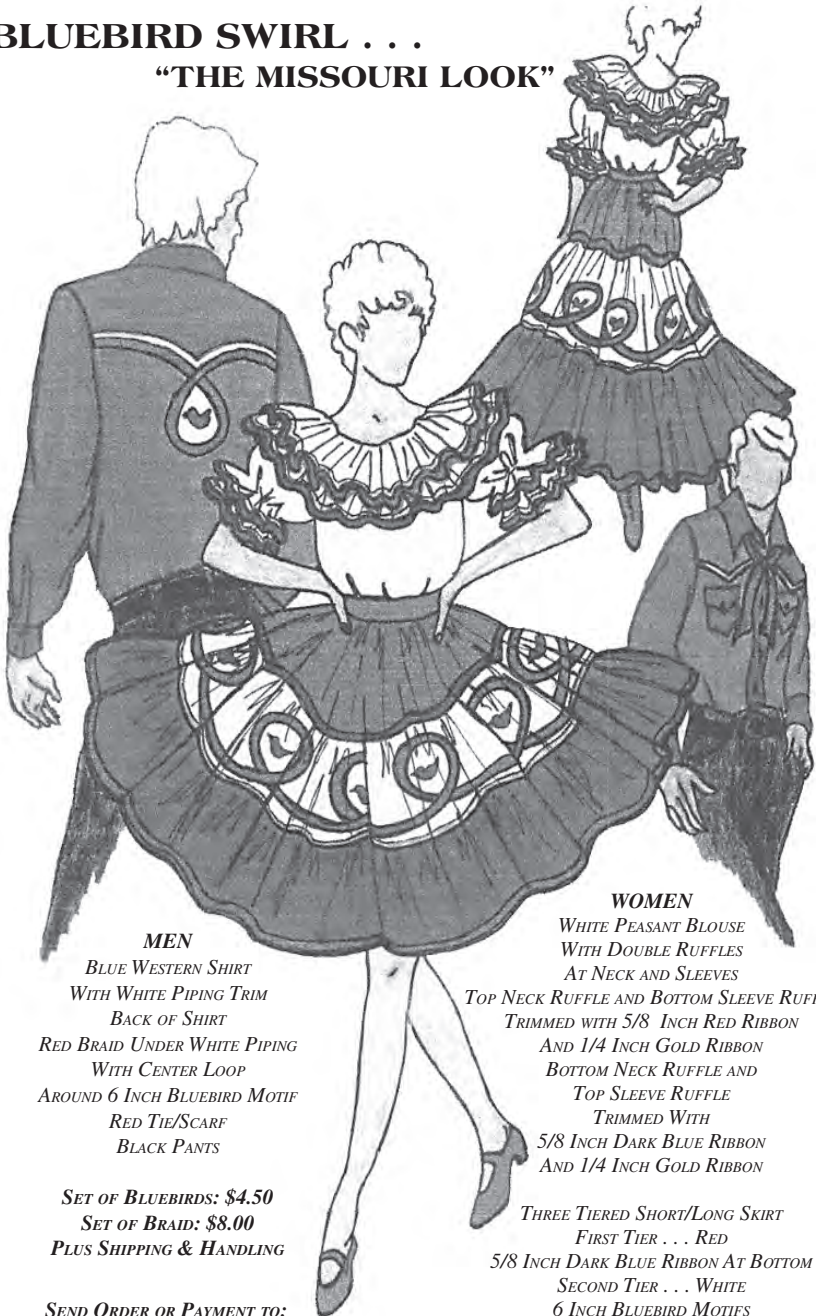
Al and Jean began square dancing lessons in 1981 and joined Travelers Square Dance Club where he was an active member until very recently when his health prevented that activity. As a Traveler, he and Jean held all of the club offices more than once. He was a delegate to the Central District and the State Federation. He was an inspiration to all square dancers as a leader in developing new activities, promoting square dance classes, and participating in every activity the club was involved in. He was instrumental in starting the annual hay ride and conducted it on his farm for several years. He loved to talk to the callers, dancers and told numerous jokes and stories at the microphone. Being an angel to the new dancers was one of his great loves. He never missed a lesson, unless he had a good reason. If he were here, he would say, "this is my 32nd year of lessons, and someday, someone will let me graduate."

For many years, he and Jean spent their winters as "Snow-Birds" in Mission, Texas. He always came back with more than one story depicting their dancing, travels and other activities while down there. He was a natural rock hound as he always came back with polished rocks made into jewelry of all types, bolo ties, earrings, rings, necklaces and belt buckles. He loved polishing the stones and giving the fruit of his labors away to his many friends.

Al was an active member of the Rolla Lions Club, working with the hearing impaired and promoting the program through his stories, raffles and more. He was also an avid American Legion Member of Rolla Post 270.

He will be greatly missed by all square dancers, his family and all others who ever came in contact with him. He was truly one of the "White Hat" guys, a hero in the eyes of many.

NEW CRITERIA BEGINNING JANUARY 2013

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

1. Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
2. Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
3. Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.

7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.

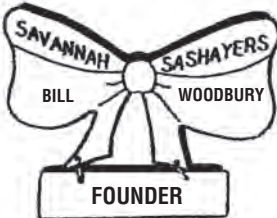

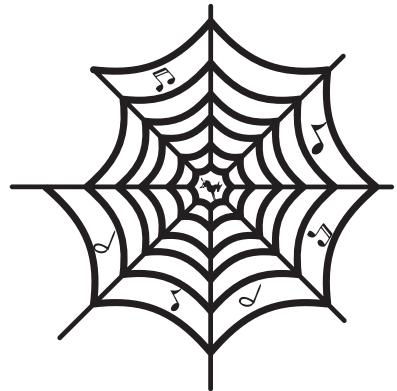

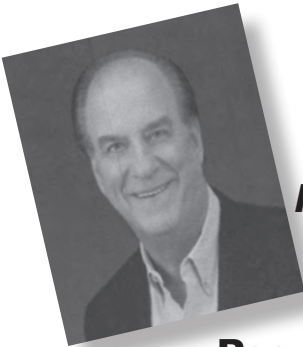

Webmaster: Dan Wheeler reporting.

When you get an E-Mail, whether it is from someone you know or not, whether it has a subject or not, if all there is in the message is a web address, no other words or explanation, DO NOT OPEN IT.

It is possible for anyone to send an E-Mail and make it appear to come from anyone else's E-Mail address. If I chose, I could send an E-Mail and make it look like it came from your E-Mail address. It does not mean that I have gotten into your E-Mail. It means that it looks like I got into your E-Mail.

Also, I never open an E-Mail is the subject line is "Hi" or "Hey" or anything like that.

The dance database currently has about 2,500 dances in it.

It is time to start sending **2014 Schedules** to me. Several of your clubs already have 2014 dances scheduled. Remind your clubs to send dances as they schedule them. I would bet that a number of clubs already have New Year's Eve dances scheduled. They do not have to wait until their 2014 schedule is complete.

Remind them also to send updates and cancellations. This last winter was the first winter that there was a Notices & Cancellations page on the Missouri & St. Louis websites. I would like to thank the clubs that sent me cancellation information. There were quite a few of them from all over the state, not just from St. Louis. They traditionally do an excellent job of keeping up to date. St. Louis should thank Billie Toeniskoetter for the excellent job that she does.

Please remind your clubs that when they send me flyers, it is better to send me a copy of the original file. I can use scanned copies if that is all they have, but it is easier to make nice looking on line flyers from the original file

Please remind your clubs that on the lower left of the Missouri Federation & St. Louis Metro home pages is a button called "Update Information". This button will take you to almost all update information that you need to send the webmaster. I am happy to accept information using regular E-Mail, but these forms prompt people as to what information is required for a particular situation. People sending information for some particular event often leave out pertinent information — like starting time, or club name. These forms remind people to include these things.

When you send me forms and flyers. Please send them in common formats. If you send your form or flyer in a program I don't have, I won't be able to open it. I am able to open most common programs. Do not reinvent the wheel. Check the forms page before you make a new form. You may not have to do any more than add a new date and a new mailing address. Send the forms and flyers in a form that allow me to convert them to PDF format. If you send them in PDF format, they are difficult for me to revise or update, and my PDF program will usually make smaller PDF files. Often when you make your own PDF files from your program, it will insert extra blank pages. Date all flyers and forms. A small date in the lower right corner is unobtrusive and makes it possible to tell new revised forms from older forms.

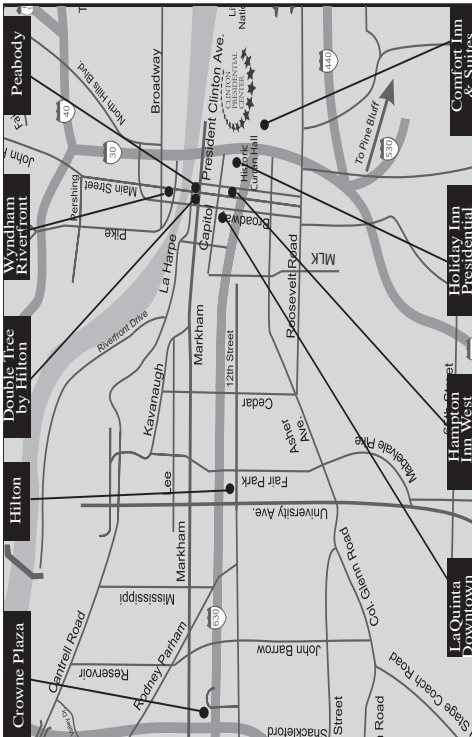
