Participants may let people know what they have done by displaying the TRAVEL MISSOURI Bar with the District dangles identifying where they have danced. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.

Participation in TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant(s) may at their discretion obtain the Travel Missouri Bar and earn dangles from the Program Manager. To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents, or Club Presidents or by visiting www.squaredancemissouri.com). Each time a participant who has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district, he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.



CHARLEY WORTHINGTON 1931-2015

Charles (Charley as he was known) Worthington, 83, died peacefully in his Shawnee, Kansas home on February 26, 2015. He was born in Bucyrus on Dec. 6, 1931, raised in Louisburg, Kansas, and graduated high school there in 1950. He served as artillery gunner in the National Guard for 9 years. Charley enjoyed working as a union plumber his entire career. He is buried next to his son, Terry, in the Louisburg cemetery.

Charley Worthington began square dancing in 1962. He belonged to the same club, Swingin' singles for 53 years, while also supporting numerous other clubs with visitations. Charley was easily recognized by his suspenders, sitting with his cane, and smiling as he watched the dancers on the floor.

Charley was one of the most well-known dancers in the Kansas/Missouri area because of his devotion to square dancing. He is always promoting and trying to enlist people into square dancing, making flyers to advertise beginning lessons and posting them on walls or bulletin boards all over town trying to get people into his beloved activity.

In his earlier years you would always see Charley on the dance floor joking and playing tricks on the caller or other dancers. In wasn't unusual for Charley to load up his van to take others dancing; and how many years have we seen Charley hauling that huge shop fan to dances, any club's dances, so everyone could be cooler?

Even though in the last few years Charley has not been able to dance much, he continues to support square dancing, rarely missing a dance or visitation, and just always "being there."

Charley started working on his first Century Book in 1983. He finished his eighth book in 2009. If you don't know what a Century Book is, it's a book with 100 pages in it that you get signed each time you dance to a new caller. You turn it in to CALLERLAB when you have it filled. That's 800 different callers in 26 years.

Charley has danced in all 50 states, Austria and Canada. He danced in 5 states in one day, beginning in Kansas, then Oklahoma, Texas, New Mexico, and ending in Colorado. Charley has attended 15 National Square Dance Conventions.

Charley was presented with the Missouri Federation Square Dancer of the Year award in October 2013, what he called one of his proudest moments.

Charley, your smile will be missed.

We would like to extend our thanks to all who made us a visitation choice this season! Your presence was appreciated, and made our dances a whole lot more fun!

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN

A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.





President Carl Boone called the meeting to order at 12:00 noon at the Friendship Hall, 1st United Methodist Church Celebration Center, Sedalia, Missouri.

Invocation: George Roth

Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag: Jim Weber

Roll Call: Ruth Ann Reynolds. Twenty voting positions present. Full Quorum achieved.

Introduction of Guests: Carl Boone welcomed the guests and new Officers and Delegates.

Minutes of December 14, 2014 meeting: Dave Shafer made a motion to approve the minutes. Motion was approved. Carl Boone stated the minutes are approved as read and modified.

Treasurer's Report: Carl Boone reporting. I am going to finish up my last report for 2014 with the multipage sheets you have on your tables. December activities included reimbursements: Carol Morris, Missouri State corporate registration fee. Three clubs were each refunded 10.00 dues, as they did not obtain insurance - GB Rounds, Ridge Rockers, and Merry Roundes

In December we paid out to the Districts, the Dues and Insurance Incentive funds as follows:

- \$140 Southeast
- \$210 West Central
- \$490 Southwest
- \$175 Central
- \$175 Northeast
- \$560 Northwest
- \$245 St Louis District

We have had good feedback from the clubs we have attended thanking us for that money back and felt this was a successful promotion. Central District received 10% of the net proceeds for state festival of \$883.83 and Kountry Kuzins, \$200 for meeting hosts, and we approved the paying out of 2015 bid funds to the 67th National committee of \$335.84

There was an ending checking account balance of \$25,922.85, with \$30,094.12

in CDs for a total on hand, end of year, of \$56,016.97 for the year 2014. Comparison to actual budget of last year was \$2,000 more than what we had budgeted and expenses, about \$1,700 less.

The budgeted amount of net revenue was \$7,495 and we came in at \$10,917.06. If there are no further questions this is ready for audit. Our new treasurer, Rosa, will present the 2015 year so far.

Rosa Davis reporting. Balance forward for the new year, January 1, is \$25,922.85. In January we had two payments – one to BMI and one to Pittman Printing. Dues from two more clubs - \$20 for total revenue from January to February 9 of \$20. Total Expenses paid were \$2,535.94. As of February 9, checking account balance is \$23,406.91. CDs total \$30,094.41 for total funds on hand February 9 of \$53,501.03. Carl did all of this and passed the books on Thursday. I have a checking account ready to set up on Tuesday.

Membership: Carl Boone reporting. At the end of the year we have 58 clubs paid. We have since received dues from the Wheeler Dealers, Kelly's Classics and Razzle Dazzle. Kelly's classics have paid their insurance so we have actually had two new clubs since the first of the year.

Club Longevity: Rosa Davis reporting. Seven clubs are presently eligible for longevity awards this year and we have three today – 30 years, Trenton T Squares; Wheelers and Dealers, 35 years; and as of January we have a club with 60 years, the Ozark Whirlers. Four more clubs will receive their awards later on this year.

Correspondence: Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. We have a quorum. No correspondence has been received; however, three get well cards are being passed around for Mickey Lee, Carol Morris and Larry Anslinger.

Boundaries and Relations: Ray and Vicki Wittman have agreed to be the new Chairman for this committee. No report.

Constitution and By-laws: George and Cleva Roth have agreed to be the new Chairman for this committee. No report.

Publications: Position is open. No report

DOIN's Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. March 25 is the deadline for the April DOIN's. This is very important because Jim and I and Dave and Dee will be traveling to Des Moines, Iowa for the National Pre-convention dance March 23 to March 28 and upon returning home we hope to get the DOIN's

information to the publisher in a timely manner. No reminder emails or calls will be made.

As a reminder for the new writers, make sure you put the CLUB NAME in the subject line of an email. If you do not receive a confirmation on the article you sent, please let me know. All the forms for sending items on the DOIN's are available on the web site at www.squaredancemissouri.com/Missouri. Click on Federation information, then Show-Me DOIN's. You can type in and send from the web page or you can print the forms and mail them in.

DOIN's Circulation: Carol Morris, chairman was unable to attend. No report, however, Jim Weber stated that 408 issues of the March / April Doin's will be sent out.

DOIN's Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. December 14 thru February 15 we had a balance of \$100. Since December we have collected revenue for six puzzles amounting to \$90, ads and listings, \$686 for a total revenue of \$876.00. We had a check of \$5.75 for postage to mail ad information to the publisher in January and gave a check to the treasurer for \$770.25 that left a balance of \$100 in the account.

Once again, we are going to Iowa for the Pre-Convention from March 23 to the 29th so if you have ads to put in the DOIN's get them in early. We will work on them the day we get back.

We now have a \$690 profit off of those puzzles. We don't owe the Federation anything at this point. There are 90 some puzzles left to sell. You can give as gifts or door prizes or resell. Help us out.

Promotion & Recruiting: Carl Boone reporting. Jack and Becky Rockaway are the new chairmen of this committee. Jack stated he just received his information so he has no report at this time.

We do have some Toot Your Horn applications and will be processing those.

State Festival Site Screening. Carl Boone reporting. The Northeast district reported that the Lebanon site has already been done. Northwest is the one following that and they do not have a site selected as of now.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. Since the December Federation meeting we have added 70 new dancers and one new club. I also have 8 new dancers in the mail from Mo-Kan Squares, so we are growing slowly. A reminder to all clubs holding lessons, you must submit a new class club sponsored place form. Your dancers are not insured until I receive the list with

the names of the people taking lessons, so get them in as quickly as you can - within the first three lessons at least. There is no cost but they are insured at and during lessons at that specific place, but only after Jim receives the list.

Remember to complete an accident report if anyone is injured at your dance, even if it appears minor. Documentation at the time of an accident is best and keep it in your files for further reference. Forms are all on the web site, (www. squaredancemissouri.com).

At the last meeting, balance forward was \$382.76. Total revenue was \$320.00, expenses were 307.73 with an ending balance as of 2/15/15 is 395.03.

We have 1,449 dancers insured through Missouri and dancers insured through another federation is 463 with a total of 1,912 Missouri dancers. There are eight clubs that insure through Heart of America. I haven't got their new club numbers yet. They are insured, but I will be getting that information shortly. We now have 60 clubs total, and 70 new dancers added since last report.

Square Dancing: From the Outside Looking In

Two native New England callers are featured at this year's keynote address. Paul Cote (now of Texas) and Ted Lizotte (of New Hampshire), will try and take a step out of the box and take a look at our activity from "outside the dance hall".

Paul and Ted began calling together in 1988 as "The Duo!" Despite some resistance by "the establishment" they quickly became New England favorites, known for their singing calls and harmonies as well as their on stage chemistry.

In the 26+ years as Ted and Paul have been calling, many things within the dance hall have remained the same – things outside the activity have not. During their Keynote Presentation they hope to shine a light on some of these items, to hopefully spark conversation and ideas about how to embrace change rather than resist it. They hope you'll join them at 1:00 pm Friday in the MassMutual Center Arena.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. We will be driving to the convention. We need to know where to park our car where it will be safe as we attend the convention. We want the most economical means available. We are not familiar with the area.

Answer: Springfield is growing and parking lots are being taken out of service for construction of a casino. Parking is at a premium. If you are housed at any hotels listed with Convention Registration & Housing, you may leave your car parked at your hotel, buy a bus pass (\$50 per person) and do all your travel on a bus to and from the Convention Center. We have created four bus routes for hotel transportation to reduce the length of time on the bus. From the hotels outside the routed area, park your car at the Eastern States Exposition / Big E gated lot. There is bus transportation exclusively for the parking and camping. A bus pass at \$50 per person is required to be transported back to your car (no parking fee). The Big E is 1.5 miles from the Convention Center.

2. Is there a shuttle to and from the airport and Amtrak?

Answer: Yes, for Bradley International Airport, contact Valet Park of America 1-800-599-8916. For you on Amtrak, take a taxi waiting outside the station.

3. Can we buy a bus pass after we get to the Convention?

Answer: Yes, we offer two different bus passes. For contracted hotels through our Convention Registration & Housing, you can purchase a bus pass when you pick up your packet for \$60 (\$50 prior to Convention). For non-contracted hotels, we strongly urge you to buy the Park & Ride Shuttle Pass for \$50 per person (this includes the parking fee and issues you the auto admission tag for your mirror). Originating at the Eastern States Exposition / Big E / Convention Campground this is a secure parking area for your personal vehicle parking. The parking lot at the Big E is 1.5 miles from the Convention Center supplied by an exclusive bus route. Your hotel reservation will verify your ability to purchase this Big E pass.

4. Is there any dancing earlier in the week?

Answer: Yes, starting Sun, Mon, & Tues there will be round dancing at the Sheraton Hotel with Roundalab. At the MassMutual Center, starting on Tues there is square dancing with Tony Oxendine and Grand Squares, Inc national callers. On Wed night The Ghost Riders with Tony Oxendine square dance after the dinner & show and two other Trail-In dances take place that night at the MMC. Check the website for Trail Thru dances prior to convention and dancing schedules in Springfield the week of convention.
