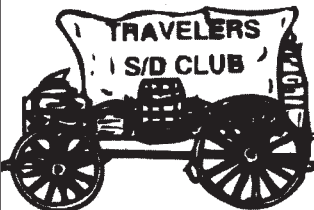

In Memory of Jim Harlan

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN

A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

1. Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
2. Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
3. Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.

Introduction and Welcome of Guests: Edythe Weber introduced Floyd and Judy Engelhardt from Le Sueur, Minnesota, as the new USDA Vice Presidents, Plains Region, and Dave and Penny Byers, Peppy Promenaders, from Chillicothe.

Minutes of August 16 Meeting: Corrections were made on Pages 5 and 8. Vice President Roth acknowledged those corrections and asked for any additional changes. A motion was made by Jim Weber and seconded to approve the minutes with corrections. Motion carried. The minutes with corrections were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Rosa Davis reporting. As of 8/13/15 the beginning checking account balance was \$9,504.11 with Revenue of \$1,339.67 and Expenses totaling \$4,448.17. The ending checking account balance as of October 6, 2015 was \$6,395.11. One CD matured in September and Carl found a 36-month fund with 1.1% rate of interest to reinvest. We have a total of four CD's amounting to \$40,146.25. Total funds on hand \$46,541.86.

Membership and Club Longevity: Rosa Davis reporting – We have a total of 61 clubs and I have received dues for 38 clubs to date. There is one Longevity Award to be given out. Tony Ahart did some research on our clubs and came up with the Tanglefooters, Southwest District, founded in November, 1975. He will deliver the 40-year badge to them.

Vice President Roth reported that \$118 was collected during the meeting, as a memorial to Wilma Boone, Carl's Boone's mother, who passed away this past week.

Boundaries and Relations: Ray and Vicki Wittman – No report.

Constitution and Bylaws: George and Cleva Roth – No report.

Publications: George stated that we are still looking for volunteers for that committee. No report.

DOIN's Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. She stated a very important date was coming up on November 25.

DOIN's Circulation: Carol Morris reporting. The bi-monthly report for the Northeast District will be given at the December state meeting and the report will also include the weekend activity and subscriptions.

The balance carried forward as of August 15 was \$100 with Income from 34 subscriptions for a total of \$525 and Expenses of postmaster \$14, and a \$3 bank service charge for total expenses of \$17. Disbursement of \$508 to the Missouri Federation leaves a total amount of \$100 carried forward.

DOIN's Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. Balance brought forward was \$100 as of August 16, 2015. There was no new revenue from subscriptions, however, revenue was collected from eight puzzle sales for a total of \$120 Revenue collected for Doin's ads and Caller/Cuer directory listings and puzzles amounted to \$926 for total revenue of \$1,146 and one check for \$5.75 to the postmaster under Expenses. Disbursement in the amount of \$1,040.25 was made to the Missouri Federation and a balance carried forward as of October 18, 2015 is \$100.

We have added two new annual subscribers this year and welcome Beaux and Belles who have subscribed to a half page ad for a year and Silver Dollar Squares who have subscribed to a quarter page ad for a year.

Puzzle report: Eight puzzles amounting to \$120 have been sold since the last meeting. That gives us \$965 profit to the Federation. Our Total income balance to date is \$4,139. We have 93 or 94 puzzles left.

Promotions and Recruiting: Jack and Becky Rockaway – No report.

State Festival Site Screening: George and Cleva Roth – No report.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. Jim stated there were 1,556 dancers insured through Missouri and Missouri dancers insured through other federations of 490. As of October 18, 2015, the total number of Missouri dancers is 2,046 with 61 Missouri clubs at this time. Since April the Federation has added nine new dancers. As a reminder to all clubs holding lessons, you must submit a club sponsored class form. There is no cost to cover new dancers at lessons. Once the dancers graduate they are no longer insured until they join a club and pay the insurance premium, and the club submits an

additional enrollment form. If your lessons continue into 2016, you must submit a new club roster form for 2016. You insurance for your club class drops on December 31. I must have a new roster for 2016.

Remember to complete accident forms for all accidents that occur at your dance and keep them on file as needed.

The insurance packets were mailed in September 18. The 2016 premium has increased from \$4.50 to \$4.75 per dancer. This is the first increase in five years.

For your club to receive the \$35.00 club rebate your 2016 dues must be paid and received by Rosa and your 2016 insurance packet must be received by me by November 1, 2015.

Financial Report: The beginning balance as of August 16 was \$458.28. Income from clubs was \$2,026 . Payments to USDA - \$1,979.40, Mailing and Supplies - \$171.09, for total Expenses of \$2,150.49. The ending balance as of October 16, amounted to \$333.79.

I have received only 21 clubs' insurance to date for 2016.

Number of dangles given out per district as of October 15, 2015, dangles passed out were 412.

For October, Income was \$6.00 for one new row. There were no expenses. Total money in the account is \$48.18.

Blue Bird Coordinator: Connie and Kenny Hobbs – No report. Connie stated that she does have Blue birds and braid for anyone needing these items.

George Roth reminded everyone there is a new redesign on the bluebirds.

Webmaster: Dan Wheeler reporting. He reported that, on the Missouri Federation website there is district letterhead stationery for all districts. One has the Missouri map on it and one with the Arts logo on it.

When you make or change forms, please date them. I prefer a date in the lower right corner. When you send me forms, I prefer them in MS Word or MS Excel. I can convert these files to PDF format which I can then reduce file size by 80%. This changes the space used on our website server and also takes less time to download the form.

Please use MS Word for written documents. Most people are now using MS Word and when you use one of the other programs other people may not be able to open them if you send a document to them. Save your files in MS Word format so everyone can use

them and if you don't know how, contact me and I will help you.

I talked last meeting about the security codes on the "on line" forms. The new security codes by "Google" appear to be working well. I haven't noticed any robotic spam with them. All the update forms have been updated to the new system. Please remind your clubs to use them. When you use these forms, there are blanks to fill in with all the information that the Doin's or I need. I am happy to accept information by regular email but it is very easy to leave something important out. The new forms for Doin's Chatter automatically puts your club name in the "Subject" line of the email - something that Edythe has been requesting for a very long time.

For the record, the new system requires that you click in a box to verify that you are not a robot. If you send too many of the forms in one day (3 – 6) the form makes you jump through one more hoop. You will be shown 9 pictures of something. Then you will be asked to click on all the same type picture. There are several more options that the system may use, none as difficult as the old numbers and letters. Usually the check box is all you have to do.

Remind your clubs to send me their 2016 schedules and also check their club web pages to be sure information is current. If the club officers need to be added to their web pages, please let me know.

Last month, the Missouri Federation web site had over 1100 hits. As of Wednesday, the Missouri Festival web site had over 300 hits. The Missouri Festival information for 2016 is already on the web site.

Historian: Dan and Jean Wheeler – No report.

License Plate: Sharon White – No report.

USDA: Edythe Weber reporting. Edythe stated that the Executive Committee will hold their winter meeting in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, on January 23 and 24, 2016. She also reported that USDA Youth Scholarship applications are due February 1, 2016. If you have a senior in high school or freshman in college, please have them apply.

There is also a new Centennial Award being sponsored by the USDA for any square dancer 100 years or older. If your club has a dancer 100 years or older please get in touch with either Jim or me so we can fill out an application and get that award applied for.

Edythe introduced Floyd and Judy Engelhardt who are the new USDA Vice Presidents for the Plains Region.

Judy Engelhardt stated they were on their way home from an Arkansas meeting and stopped in to visit us. They have danced in all 50 states once and are on their second round, already at 48, and going strong. Judy and Floyd are looking forward to their work and position with the USDA, Plains Region.

ARTS – Edythe Weber reporting. Edythe reminded everyone to use the new logo on flyers and anywhere you would like. Information is available on the Live Lively Square Dance site. For logos go to www.arts-dance.org – Reimaging Project. They do have a program involving a workshop or presentation at your festival or will set one up for an educational weekend and will assist you with \$200 for doing that.

District Presidents' Report: Annette Thornhill reporting. Annette reported that the District Presidents met and discussed the following:

Dance Promotions Grant Update: No report.

Square Dancers of the Year: Annette Thornhill reporting. She stated the winners of the Square Dancers of the Year 2015 award went to Mark and Rosalee Mortensen. There will be a new chairman for next year's event announced at the February meeting. She

encouraged every district who submitted a name for the award this year, to resubmit for the coming year. There are new forms for this nomination on the web site.

Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame: Sharon Crisel reporting. Sharon announced the Caller of the Year was Kenton Sullivan. The District Presidents should check requirements for this award and begin thinking toward 2016 and the deadline date that nominations have to be in. The chairmen for this Committee will be Carl and Cindy Boone.

NEW BUSINESS

Election of 2016 Officers: Sharon Crisel reporting. Sharon announced the slate of officers nominated for 2016 as follows:

George Roth asked for nominations from the floor three times for each position. With no further nominations, a motion was made by Jim Weber and seconded by Liz Rooks that nominations cease.

Dave Shafer made a motion by acclamation to accept nominations and it was seconded by Jim Weber. Motion passed.

67th National Square Dance Convention: Jim Weber reporting: Jim encouraged early registration and at this time we have 502 registered. There are approximately 2,000 dancers in Missouri. We need to show the National Convention folks that we are going to have a spectacular dance.

Dave Shafer reported on the Housing and Registration. Plans are progressing well and on track. We had a meeting with NEC (National Executive Committee members) several weeks ago and reviewed all the plans so far. Everything is on track and they are pleased with everything we have done at this point. There is still a need for people to help with various committees. If you have a particular skill or knowledge that would help, please let us know. Early registration is important. There are 502 registered at this date but only 109 from Missouri. It is important that we register as many as we can from Missouri. Talk about it at your dances and encourage everyone to sign up and promote this event. Wear your ribbons when you receive them. The registration fee is \$50 per individual and allows you to attend the pre-convention dance at no cost in 2017. After March 18, 2017, the registration fee will jump to \$60 per person. Work at the club level to get the word out.

Standard Registration Form – Callers/Cuers: Jim Weber reporting. Jim stated that the Caller/Cuer registration form is now finalized. This form registers the Caller/Cuers for the convention or festival, and the caller and their spouse or partner will be admitted

free. The second part is the Caller/Cuer profile as per Section 5 of our working rules. The only changes to the sheet would be the new name and date of the function and cancellation date. The callers will sign the bottom of it indicating the assigned time slot to call. If the callers don't cancel by September 1 and they are assigned a time slot to call, they will be unable to call at the next year's festival.

George Roth stated that, according to the Standing Rules, this new form will be on the web site

Article XIX – Marvin and Bettyrae Fluke Memorial Dance Off: George Roth reporting. George recommended that the last sentence under Section D of Article XIX be struck from the Proposed Standing Rules Addition – October 18, 2015.

(The MFSRDC will reimburse the host district up to \$60.00 for cost of badges or ribbons).

Jim Weber recommended that the proposed Standing Rule Article XIX be passed as amended. In order to count the votes accurately, George asked for a standing vote. A vote was taken with 17 for and 11 against. The motion carried by majority vote.

George Roth requested a vote to add Article X1, Section 12 - Marvin and Bettyrae Fluke Memorial Dance-Off Committee. A voice vote was taken and approved with one opposed.

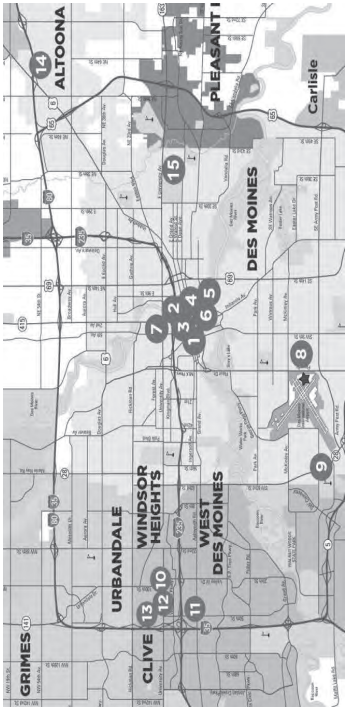
