





The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

Introduction and Welcome of Guests: Sharon Crisel introduced guests, Tom and Betty Schalk and Curt and Donna Condray from the Puxico Country Squares.

Minutes of October 18 meeting: The corrections of the minutes were noted and President Boone asked for a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was made by Jim Weber and seconded to approve the minutes with corrections. Motion carried and minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Rosa Davis reporting. As of October 6, beginning checking account balance was \$6,395.61 with Revenue of \$2,140.65 and Expenses of \$2,233.94. The ending checking account balance as of December 15, 2015 was \$6,302.32 Total CDs amount to \$40,172.85 and Total funds on hand are \$46,475.17.

Membership and Club Longevity: Rosa Davis reporting. We have 57 clubs that have sent us dues for 2016. There are two clubs to be recognized for their longevity. Twirl-A-Rounds, Southwest District, celebrated 30 years in May. The other club is Ozark Zigzags, Central District, with 25 years as of December.

Correspondence: Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. Carl Boone thanked everyone for the sympathy cards received on the passing of his mother. He noted that more than half of them were from square dancers.

Boundaries and Relations: Ray and Vicki Wittman – No report.

Constitution and Bylaws: George and Cleva Roth – No report.

Publications: President Boone stated we are looking for a volunteer for that committee. No report.

DOIN's Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. Carol Morris will be the new Publications Committee chairman next year. Jim and Edythe Weber will take over the Subscription role in the interim. Appreciation was acknowledged for all the dedication and work that Carol has done with the Doin's magazine over the past six years and Edythe presented her with a gift in recognition.

The next deadline for the magazine is January 25. Edythe noted the following:

- Complete your club's year schedule for 2016 and send in, if you haven't already.
- Check your club contact in the Club Directory for accuracy and their cell phone number in case it is needed during the dance.

• Make sure that your club information is up-to-date and also on the web site.

All forms for sending items for the Doin's are available at www.squaredancemis-souri.com/Missouri.

Under Federation Information, then Show-Me Doin's you can type in and send from the web page or you can print out the forms, fill and send in.

DOIN's Circulation: Carol Morris reporting. This is part of the by-monthly report for October for the November-December issue which you have already received. We had a mail list to the printer of 367 with total paid subscriptions of 346. There were 21 extra copies for advertisers and Doin's staff. Renewals from 8/16 through 10/16/15 were 57. We had 7 new subscriptions and out of 38 renewal postcards mailed, we received 25 renewals.

The report for the January-February issue is a mail list to Pittman Printing of 391 with total paid subscriptions of 370, and 21 extra copies for advertisers and staff. There were 39 renewals from 10/19 through 12/13/15 with three new subscriptions and 38 renewal post cards mailed with 25 renewals received. Balance carried forward as of October 16 was \$100 and income from subscriptions and Doin's dance donations totaled \$1,847.44. Total expenses were \$30. A check was given to the Missouri Federation in the amount of \$1,817.44 with a balance carried forward of \$100.

DOIN's Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. The Doin's had a carryover from last report of \$100. We had zero subscriptions but sold two puzzles for \$30. Revenue collected for ads and caller/cuer directory listings \$270, for a total of \$400 revenue. Expense was a postage check for \$5.75. A check made payable to the Missouri Federation amounted to \$294.25 leaving us with a balance carried forward as of December 13, 2015 of \$100.

Puzzles. We have a total income for the Federation of \$995.00 as of December 13 and we have 101 puzzles left. We will be selling the remainder of the puzzles for \$15 each or 2 for \$20.

Promotions and Recruiting: Jack Rockaway reporting. We have a total of two checks that will be given out recruiting new dancers. One check goes to the Bluff City Twirlers youth dancers for \$400 and the other goes to Country Western Squares in Potosi for \$300. They have seven students and we hope they continue. Please take information back to your clubs and let them know there is money available through promotions to start new dancers.

State Festival Site Screening: George Roth – No report.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. Jim stated the beginning balance of Missouri Federation Insurance as of October 17, 2015 was \$333.79. Income from clubs was \$4,189.2, with expense of USDA Insurance payment, \$4,081.20 and postage of \$21.94 for a Total Expense of \$4,103.14. Ending balance as of December 11, 2015 was \$419.90.

The check registry shows an income of \$86.11 together with \$333.79 for a total income of \$419.90. Dancers for 2015 insured thru the Missouri Federation total 1,528; dancers insured through other federations are 490 for a total number of Missouri dancers of 2,018 as of 12/11/15 and 60 clubs.

For 2016, we have 57 clubs that are insured through Missouri with 1,292 dancers, 403 insured through other federations for a total of Missouri dancers of 1,695. I am starting to receive additional enrollments and I understand singles and doubles have 40 or 50 new dancers that have paid their insurance and dues to the club. The initial enrollment was in and on time to USDA and we have several certificates back already.

Rebates: For those interested in rebates, Rosa reported that 57 clubs paid. Of those 57 clubs, 49 will receive a rebate. Eight clubs will not. They are the Northwest District, Santa Fe Trailers, and Shooting Stars; St. Louis District, Wheelers and Dealers; Southwest District, Alton Flutterwheels, Lost Creek Promenaders, Traditional Dance & Music Society of the Ozarks, and Trail Blazers; West Central District, River City Squares. The two Northwest clubs and one West Central club had insurance through the Heart of America Federation. As I did last year, those clubs insured by Heart of America were notified by mail that to receive their rebate, I must have a letter or an email of who they were insured through and a club roster. Those three clubs did not respond back. The others did. They were insured on time but through another federation that did not comply with our rules.

Travel Missouri: Jim Marron reporting: As of December 11, 2015 total dangles passed out to Missouri dancers was 414.

Central – 375 St. Louis – 332 Southwest - 368 Northeast – 350 Southeast – 322 West Central – 352

Northwest - 327

Total dangles per all districts were 2,840. There was no income or expenses for December, so we still have \$48.18 in the account.

Click on the update internet button located on the lower left hand corner and that will bring up a menu of forms to fill out anything they need to do. With weather changes coming up, remind your people to let me know of dance cancellations. I am receiving a lot of 2016 dance schedules and I appreciate that.

USDA: Edythe Weber reporting: As reported last month, the USDA Youth Scholarship deadline is February 1 for the \$1,000 scholarship. The form is on the web – www. usda.org and will need the President's signature, so allow for mail delivery time.

Turn in to Jim Weber the district meeting places and date of the meeting even though they are already insured by the club that is hosting them.

Youth and Children Dance: Sharon Crisel reporting. We presented our dance Friday, November 13 at the MOAHPERD Convention. We had two squares with the help of angels and Gene Wilson did a super job.

Bill Morris Memorial Scholarship: Bob Turner reported that the scholarship is on the web and applications are available there. It is open to your children or grandchildren. We had five applications last year and the national scholarship had about that same number. They are due to me by March 1.

2015 State Festival: Mary Sue Darwent reporting. Mary Sue submitted a check for \$2500 to the Federation for reimbursement of start up funds. She reported a total registration of 506 dancers with 60 non-pay, which included 39 callers/cuers with partners, 8 past presidents, and 13 invited guests with approximately 100 walk-ins.

Income: There were 297 shirts sold with 11 left over to be donated to the National. 50-50: income of \$179 to the Federation - \$67 on Friday and \$288 on Saturday. Raffle tickets totaled \$925 which included \$182.50 turned in prior to the dance, \$454.50 at the door on Friday and \$288 on Saturday. The silent auction brought in \$869.75. The Total Income amounted to \$11,809.52, repayment to the Federation of \$2,500, NE District (10%) \$930.95 for an ending balance of \$8,378.57.

Carl Boone commented that the quality of the items on the silent auction table were exceptional this year.

2016 State Festival: Fred and Carolyn Goucher – Absent.

Jack Rockaway gave the report in the absence of Fred and Carolyn Goucher. He

reported that Jim Weber had applications and ribbons for the 2016 dance, T-shirts and polos are available for sale and we are selling raffle tickets on a beautiful T-shirt quilt made by Jean Weber and Loretta Marron and quilted by Bonnie Milligan. The dance will be at the Truman High School, in Independence, Missouri, just three blocks north of I-70 on Noland Road.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Dance Promotions Grant Update: Carl Boone reported we had \$2,000 allocated and \$700 was presented today along with some given out earlier in the year. We are just short of \$1,000 left.

He stated there has been no budget prepared for next year due to too many unknowns at the time and how much the state festival brought in. A budget will be prepared for George to look at and approve at the next meeting.

The Federation can acquire liability insurance for \$45 which we did last year for the officers, delegates and directors. Carl recommended that we do that again. It covers all meetings that the State Federation has for next year. A motion was made by Dave Shafer and seconded to approve the recommendation. Motion was approved.

NEW BUSINESS

67th National Square Dance Convention: Carl and Cindy Boone reporting. Cindy reported on the National sampler quilt that is being worked on for the raffle. It will feature 39 quilt block designs being done by paper piecing and designed by Wanda and Art Kruse, St. Louis District. The designs will have a name associated with square dancing, the State of Missouri or the State of Kansas. Kansas is being brought in because we are Kansas City, Missouri and Kansas City, Kansas. The quilt is being worked on by different members whose names will be placed on the quilt back. There will also be a book to go along with the quilt that explains the blocks and gives a little history about each one. Photographs of the finished quilt along with tickets will be made available for distribution. Raffle tickets are \$1 per ticket or 6 for \$5.

We have begun planning for our pre-convention and meeting which will be about 15 months out to show the National Committee what Kansas City has to offer and what we plan to do at our convention. You may bring anyone that is interested for all of the upcoming conventions coming into our site which is Kansas City Bartle Hall. We expect between 300 to 500 people.

The cook book has gone to print. We had 350 recipes submitted from Missouri square dancers. It should be ready within the next 60 days. We have a final design on the belt buckle which is being done by Dave Shafer's daughter, a graphic designer, that is also ready to go to a manufacturer very shortly.

Carl discussed registrations coming in and noted we have less than 10% of Missouri dancers registered. We need the support from our Missouri dancers and the easiest way to do that is to register for our dance.

We do have t-shirts for the staff that are already signed up and you may have your name printed on them. We want you to try one on to get your exact size. We are buying a ladies cut on both polos.

Standard Registration Form for Callers and Cuers. Jim Weber reported on a new

standard registration form to go with Standing Rule #5. The Northwest District will be using this form next year for their festival. It is a standard type form for the clubs to use with the date and location left blank and where to send the completed form. It was recommended that we put this on the web site for anyone to print out and submit. Dan Wheeler requested that a date be placed in the lower right corner so he can keep it updated. A motion was made by Jack Rockaway and seconded to approve the form. Motion was approved. The form will be put in the Standing Rules.

Carl Boone appointed Jan and J.W. England to be Chairmen of the Audit Committee for the upcoming year. Please have your books finalized for the February meeting and Cindy and Carl will make sure they are transported to Jan and J.W.

Carl stressed concern for the dwindling number of dancers and ways that need to be found to continue square dancing. He stated that we all need to be planning on how to attract young people and families into dancing instead of reacting to the problem.

Carl announced the release of the officers and committees for 2015 and recognized George Roth as President for 2016. He thanked the members for their support and work done during the year.

George Roth stated that he and Cleva looked forward to being Presidents next year and felt they were following a good president for this year. They will try to promote some of Carl's ideas and do appreciate those who have volunteered for committees.

George thanked the Southeast District for hosting a great dance and lunch for everyone.
