Check your club contact in the Club Directory. Please make sure that person listed in the magazine is a current dancer and knows what's going on in your club. Also, it might be best if this number is a cell phone. If somebody calls while you are at the dance, they can't reach you on a land-line.

You can type in and send from the webpage or you can print the forms, fill them in, and mail them. Each time a participant who has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district, he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.





A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square
 dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any
 announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in
 grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund
 raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a
 food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army,
 etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.



He requested that a handbook from each district be sent to him, preferably in MS Word. If using Open Office to send a copy of a text file to someone, convert it to an MS Word file. Click on "Save as". When the menu opens, click on the down arrow at the right of "Save as type", click on "Word Document.doc" and then save.

He reminded everyone to make sure that all the forms that belong to their section are current.

Historian: Dan Wheeler reporting. The Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame information is now on the history section of the Missouri Federation web site and also 2015 Square

Dancers of the Year. He has added more past minutes of meetings as far back as 2010. From 2000 to 2010, there are still some minutes yet to be found and put on file.

License Plate: Sharon White reporting. Since the last report of August 14, 2015, License Plate Income lists one 1-year renewal, one 1-year new and three 2-year new people for a total income of \$200. License Plate Expenses were rebates of two 1-year rebates and three 2-year rebates for a total of \$80 which leaves \$120 to go to the Missouri Federation. New balance as of February 14 is \$60.

USDA: Edythe Weber reporting. The Executive Committee held their winter meeting in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, January 22-23. Everyone on the committee had the same report – square dancing is down, what can we do to help. Some new publications are being produced that might be of use in marketing square dancing and retaining dancers. Publications should be ready for distribution at the National in Des Moines.

USDA Executive Committee members are assisting or presenting in six educational panels or seminars. We will have the titles later, but please support the Leadership Certification Program (LCP). Check it out on the Des Moines web site.

Also, check out the Showcase of Ideas. There is good information about what other areas of the country are doing and USDA always has the most tables of educational materials there.

The Youth Scholarship Fund is dwindling and soon will disappear without the help of affiliates. The scholarship fund and the fund to assist handicapped dancers to attend the Nationals were funded by a credit card program that gave USDA a subsidy for each card held and each transaction made. That program ended about eight years ago. Without more contributions to the youth scholarship fund, the program is in jeopardy.

ARTS: Edythe Weber reporting. ARTS is doing two seminars at the National in Des Moines on the Live Lively Square Dance Reimaging campaign and new logo and slogan. The meeting will be held on Sunday, June 26 possibly at the Iowa Events Center. We will confirm the location at a later date.

Jim has the reimaging logo stickers for sale. Place in the back window of your car. They are \$1.00.

District Presidents' Report: Sharon White reporting. There were five districts represented at the President's meeting. Southeast and St. Louis could not attend. Mary Sue Darwent, President of the Northeast District, will chair the Square Dancer of the Year Committee.

Discussion was held on ways to attract new dancers. One recommendation was family friendly dances. There will be a youth hall at the state dance this year. This may help bring some of the youth throughout the state together in one place Once again, we do need a new advertising chairman.

Youth and Children Dance: Sharon and Larry Crisel – Absent, no report.

Bill Morris Memorial Scholarship: Bob and Shirley Turner reporting – Absent, no report. George Roth stated he had received an email from Bob with the reminder that scholarships have to be postmarked by March 1 in order to qualify for the scholarship.

2015 State Festival: Annette Thornhill reporting. Annette thanked everyone for all the help and participation the members gave in making a very successful festival last year. We made a total of \$11,825.52 which included the \$2,500 lent to us from the

State. After that deduction, she presented a check for \$9,325.52 to the Federation and the books are ready for audit.

2016 State Festival: Fred Goucher reporting. He reported everything is going well. So far, 103 registrations have been sold and they are working with the hotels and motels in the area for that date. You can register on line and pay by credit card.

Before moving to Unfinished Business, President Roth stated that Dave Shafer, who has been in charge of the Showcase of Ideas will be unable to do that this year. He made a request for volunteers to step forward and assume this responsibility going forward. The Federation budgets \$100 towards travel expenses for anyone assuming this role.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

2016 Budget: Carl Boone reporting. Carl reviewed the proposed budget for 2016 with the estimation that we can maintain around 60 clubs. Total Revenue for General Fund will be around \$21,850. Total General Fund Expenses amount to approximately \$12,500. The DOIN's Fund Revenue is estimated at \$7,625 with Expenses at \$11,550. The Combined Summary of Total Revenue is \$29,475 with Total Expenses at \$24,050 for a Total Net Revenue projected for 2016 of \$5,425.

A motion was made by Dan Reedy and seconded to approve the 2016 budget. The motion was approved.

NEW BUSINESS

President Roth presented a plaque and gavel for 2015 to Carl and Cindy Boone for their dedication and outstanding leadership in serving the Missouri Federation Square and Round Dance Clubs. He gave them an honorary Lifetime membership card that gives them free admission to various activities in the Federation.

National Convention: Carl and Cindy Boone reporting. He introduced Dave and Penny Byers, Peppy Promenaders from Chillicothe, who were responsible for putting together the cookbook for the National in 2018. It is at the printers being proof-read and he stated they have done a wonderful job working on the National Committee. They are also new delegates for the West Central District.

Carl passed around the final design for the belt buckle. Dave Shafer's daughter did the graphics. It is a copyrighted artwork with royalty rights and designed for the 67th National. It features the blue bird, wagon and oxen team, Missouri mule, jazz music and the Dogwood. The buckles will be available in pewter or brass. The cookbooks and belt buckles should be ready for sale within the next several months.

Carl also recognized Jack and Becky Rockaway for the excellent job they have done on the Ways and Means Committee.

Cindy reported that they will travel to Cincinnati for the Ohio pre-convention dance the first part of March. The following year, 2017, will be our turn to showcase the Missouri dancers. She encouraged everyone to register for the dance and also volunteer to work on one of the committees. Work with your clubs to get involved because it is all about Missouri.

Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame Committee: Carl Boone reporting. One of the duties of the Past President is to be the Chairman of the Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame Selection Committee. It is made up of six members. Cindy and Carl (as Past President) four (each from a different district) elected by the Federation body and the last recipient

of the award, which would be Kenton Sullivan, member-at-large. Cindy and Carl represented the Northwest district. He asked for nominations or volunteers to be on the committee. Volunteers included: Annette Thornhill, Northeast; Liz Rooks, West Central; Sharon White, Southwest; Ron Selfors, Central; Dan Reedy, Southeast. Voting was done by secret ballot.

Carl Boone announced the members of the Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame Committee for 2016. They are Liz Rooks, Annette and Terry Thornhill, Sharon White, Ron and Marie Selfors. A motion was made and seconded to destroy the ballots. Motion carried.

Liz Rooks asked about plans to place an advertising ad in the State Fair brochure for the August State Fair Dance. The amount of the ad last year was \$550. There will also be an ad in the DOIN's . A motion was made by Dave Shafer and seconded that Liz come back with a proposal to advertise in the State Fair as a matter of business for our next meeting. Motion was approved.

Jim Weber brought up discussion regarding Missouri support of the USDA \$1,000 scholarship. Dave Shafer made a motion, seconded by Fred Goucher, to approve \$300 for the USDA scholarship fund. After discussion, a vote was taken and motion was approved. Jim Weber recommended that the USDA delegate going to the Des Moines National present the check at that time.

President Roth thanked the Southwest District for hosting the great luncheon and the DOIN's afternoon dance.



Badge Making – most badges will be made ahead of time, but there will be some walk-in registrations, plus visitors need name badges.

<u>First Aid</u> – you would help with the record-keeping, no medical background is needed; we will have certified EMTs on staff.

<u>Lost & Found</u> – helping complete forms, placing the labeled item on shelf and return to rightful owner.
