To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents, or Club Presidents or by visiting www.squaredancemissouri.com). Each time a participant who has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district, he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.

Insurance Chairman Notes

The 2017 initial enrollment packets will be mailed in September to each club. For things to go smoothly and your club to receive the packet in a timely manner, I need to know who to send it to. Please email your club name, insurance contact name, complete postal mailing address, and phone number to moinsurance@kc.rr. com by Saturday, September 10, 2016.

Make sure to pay State dues by November 1st and make sure to have your initial insurance enrollment turned in by November 1st to be eligible for the \$35 reimbursement. This is a great benefit to clubs, so make sure you don't miss out.

Remember to submit new members as they join your club using the additional enrollment form. This can be found in your packet or on the web at www. insurance.squaredancemissouri.com

A reminder to all clubs holding lessons. For your class members to be insured during your lessons you must submit a club class roster before they can be covered. There is no cost to cover new dancers in lessons. However they are only insured at and during lessons. Once your new dancer's graduate they are no longer insured until they join a club and pay the insurance premium and the club submits an additional enrollment form.

Remember to complete an accident report form for ALL accidents that occur at your dance, even if they appear minor at the time. It is hard to remember who, what, when, where and how weeks later; documentation at the time is best. Keep them on file and submit as needed.



As the world's largest square dance association, the Executive Committee of the United Square Dancers of America (USDA) is proud to provide a "Centennial Award" program for this group of dancers.

The qualified recipients will be given a nice framed "Certificate of Recognition and Appreciation" signed by the President of the United Square Dancers of America and the Vice President of their Region. They will also receive a "United Square Dancers of America Centennial Award" lapel pin. This award will be presented to them by a member of the Executive Committee at a dance attended by the recipient when possible. Should the recipient be able to attend the annual Board of Directors meeting the day prior to the National Convention, USDA will pay their Convention Registration.

Finally, we will honor them in a special "Feature Article" in the USDA NEWS. If available we also include pictures of the award presentation when possible.

Qualifications:

The most difficult part is reaching the age of 100. That is the number one criteria on the list of qualifications. Once you have met the age requirement you are well on your way.

Requirement number two is that you are still active in the square dance community. This does not require that you still dance, but you must still attend dances on a regular basis and be involved in the club in some way. This may be sitting at the front table and welcoming dancers as they come in.

Requirement number three is that you must have a minimum of five years membership in your club.

Once you have qualified for the Centennial Award, you must complete the "QUALIFICATION FORM" available on the USDA website and send to Larry Dunkel, Editor USDA NEWS, 2748 Cunningham Rd., Knoxville, TN 37918-9518





IN MEMORY OF OLLIE LOEHR

JANUARY 19, 1928

MAY 13, 2016

On May 13 the St. Louis Round Dance Community lost an icon with the passing of Ollie Loehr. As I told him many times, he was the smoothest of them all. His cues were always spot on and seemed to flow effortlessly. He always had a twinkle in his eye, like he was up to something. He will be sorely missed.

After serving in the Marines he went to work for his uncle as a glazier. He wanted to be a caller but couldn't sing. When he learned to Round Dance in 1973 there were about 10 choreographed songs with recorded cues, but you could not hear the cues very well. Most dancers had to memorize the choreography. When he was dancing with his wife Donna, he began to shout out the cues to help other struggling dances. Donna said "You better get up on the stage with a microphone so they can hear you better." The rest was history.

He retired from cueing as the club cuer for West County Spinners over 10 years ago. He also cued for Rafter Rockers, Melody Squares, Boots & Slippers, Spanish Lake Quadrilles, Boxinettes, and others. He taught the Tevlins to round dance and later mentored them as they began cueing.

At his peak in 1988 he was cueing 19 out-of-town weekend events and had only one Wednesday a month free from cueing and teaching. He cued at the Lake of the Ozarks, Mt. Vernon, Chicago and two years at the Tennessee State Square Dance Convention.

Ollie is best known for his choreography of "Gateway Foxtrot". He wrote it for the 1993 National Square Dance Convention held in St. Louis where he served as Assistant Vice Chairman of Rounds. On their 50th wedding anniversary he choreographed "More and More" for his wife Donna.

Ollie was a charter member and served as an officer of the St. Louis Area Round Dance Council, was a board member and officer in the Missouri Round Dance Council, and was a board member of the St. Louis Folk and Square Dance Federation. At his passing he served with Jean Barry as Secretary-Treasurer of River City Rounds.

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN

A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.



Revenue since last meeting was \$1,245.26 minus Expenses of \$6,196.83 for an ending balance as of May 31, 2016 of \$9,703.12.

There was no revenue listed in the Doin's account for the February Southwest District Doin's Dance. That check was given to the Doin's and will be reflected in their report this month.

We received interest on our Guaranty Bank CD in May. That bank adds interest to the value of the CD, so the value of that CD has increased by \$26.16 since the last report.

Membership and Club Longevity: Ruth Ann Reynolds read the report provided by Rosa Davis who was absent.

There are no changes for club membership, and we have 57 clubs at the present time.

One club received a Longevity Award – the West County Spinners in the St. Louis District for 35 years.

Publications: Carol Morris – Absent - No report.

DOIN's Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. She reported there is a "Help Wanted" in the Doin's to find a replacement for Dave and Dee Shafer in a position of Advertising Manager. Please mention this opening at your district and club meetings and refer them to Dave or Jim for the details about the responsibilities of this important volunteer job.

The next deadline for the DOIN's is July 25. Please send in early. For any information that is sent in, remember to put the club name first in the subject line. All the forms for sending items for the Doin's are available on the web at www. squaredancemissouri.com/Missouri. You can type in and send from the web page or you can print the forms, fill them in, and mail them. If you want the forms sent to you electronically to save to your computer, please send an email to doins@kc.rr. com and we will send them to you.

DOIN's Circulation: Jim Weber reporting. At the current time we have 326 subscriptions, 2 exchange and 13 others for staff, historian and post office for a total July/August mailing of 340. Remember to introduce the Doin's to new club members.

The Profit and Loss statement for April 11 through June 11, shows Income of \$570 total subscriptions plus a donation from the SW District Doin's Dance of \$435 for a total income of \$1,005.00. Expenses of funds transfer to Missouri Federation was \$992.42 plus \$12.58 for stamps bringing an ending balance on April 11, of \$100.00.

Doin's Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. The balance brought forward as of April 10, 2016 was \$100.00. Revenue collected from Doin's subscriptions, puzzle sales, ads, and directory listings amounted to \$732.00. Total expenses amounted to \$6.45 for mailing ads to publisher. A check was made payable to the Missouri Federation in the amount of \$625.55. Balance carried forward as of June 12, 2016 was \$100.00.

Puzzles: We sold two puzzles that gives us a total income of \$4, 179 from the puzzles sales, and a \$1,075 profit at this point. We still have 93 puzzles left.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. Dancers insured through Missouri at the present time are 1,422. We have 390 dancers insured through other organizations or federations for total Missouri dancers of 1,812. We have 57 clubs at the present time. A reminder to all clubs holding lessons, you must submit a club sponsored class form and new dancers are insured at and during lessons at your lessons location only. In discussion with the USDA coordinator, she has made a determination that new dancers in a class can attend other dances if they are on your dance lesson dates to attend and they will be covered. This is a new change.

As new members join your club, make sure you send in an additional enrollment form. They are not insured until the national insurance coordinator receives the enrollment form. The 2016 premium is \$4.75 per dancer.

Remember to complete an accident report form for all accidents that occur at your dance and turn it in so it is on file.

Profit and Loss beginning balance as of April 10 through June 11 was \$499.96. Total income insurance payments from clubs amounted to \$33.25 with Expense of USDA insurance payment of \$102.30. The ending balance as of June 11 was \$430.91.

As Missouri Federation representatives, they will present to the Youth Committee of USDA a donation of \$300 for the Youth Scholarship and challenge each affiliate to make some kind of contribution to the Youth Scholarship Fund and/or Handicapable Funds. Everyone is welcome to attend.

ARTS: Edythe Weber reporting. The arts meeting will be held on Sunday, June 26 at 9:00 a.m. in the Iowa Events Center, Mezzanine Level, Boardroom 2. Seminars will also be presented during the convention on the reimaging project and what the ARTS is doing.

Vicki also requested and received approval from the delegates regarding donation fees for the 2017 dance in order to use the same fee schedule used for 2016. All Events \$25 per person, Friday only \$16 per person, Saturday and Sunday \$16 per person and festival program will be free with that plus approval of \$1 for the ARTS.
