



In Memory of Delores Shafer



Delores Ellen Shafer, was born on June 29, 1941 in Indianapolis, Indiana where she grew up and graduated from Southport High School.

Dee worked for three years with the Post Quartermaster Laundry Dry Cleaning and then transferred to the Adjutant General's Office of Records as a lead records clerk for 17 years where she met Dave. Dave and Dee were married at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri on October 11, 1986.

She was an avid square dancer. She was a member of the Travelers Square Dance Club for more than 31 years, holding all of the offices of the club. She was Square Dancer of the Year for Missouri

in 2008 and served as president of the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs in 2006. She enjoyed all of the square dance activities, and the many Yellowrocks she received. She was recently the Assistant General Chairman for the 2018 National Dance. Through dancing, she became friends of hundreds, if not thousands of dancers and others around the world. She enjoyed sewing her own skirts and dresses that she wore to the dances. She was always one of the very first to step up to help others when a need arose. Her wonderful smile was infectious and widely known. She enjoyed traveling with Dave and treasured spending time with her family. Dee was always very devoted to her family and would cancel trips and other events if a family affair were to take place: recitals, graduations, birthdays, etc. She never hesitated to drive friends to doctor appointments, shopping, or taking care of others.

Delores was a member of American Legion Auxiliary Unit 0331 for 30 years. She was their secretary and membership chairman for 25 years. She became a strong supporter of the Girls State program, collecting thousands of "Best Choice" UPC's in order to send girls to the Girls State program each year. This project will go on in her name.

Delores passed away on August 23, 2016 in the University of Missouri Columbia Hospital at the age of 75 years. She will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those who knew and loved her. Many people didn't think she was really as ill as she was, but this was all a very strong and brave front on her part.

Delores leaves to cherish her memory, her husband, David, four children, eleven grandchildren and four nephews and other relatives and friends. She was preceded in death by her parents, two brothers, and three sisters.

Funeral services were held on Thursday, September 1, 2016 in the Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville/St. Robert with Pastor Christopher Hendrix officiating. The songs "Amazing Grace", "Family Bible", "Peace in the Valley", "May I Have This Dance" and "I Will Always Love You" were played. Serving as escorts were Bruce Gilder, Pat Foster, Michael Foster, Jack Foster, Ron Selfors, and Carl Boone. Serving as honorary escorts were Chet Saladin, Dan Bruemmer and John Stover. Burial followed in the Missouri Veterans Cemetery of Waynesville, Missouri.

Dee will be greatly missed by the many dancers, friends and relatives. She was a very special lady.

LET'S TOOT OUR HORN

A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.







Approval of April Minutes: President Roth asked that the minutes of the April meeting be approved as corrected at the prior meeting. Motion made, seconded and passed that the minutes be approved. (Action required due to lack of quorum at June meeting.)

Approval of June Minutes: President Roth asked for corrections or additions to the June minutes. No changes were noted and a motion was made, seconded and passed to approve the minutes.

Treasurer's Report: Rosa Davis reported a beginning check account balance as of May 31, 2016 of \$9,703.12 with Revenue of \$1,699.55 and Expenses of \$2,059.43. The ending account balance as of July 31, 2016 was \$9,343.24. CDs plus interest amounted to \$40,225.68 for a total funds balance of \$49,568.92.

Membership and Club Longevity: Rosa Davis reported that since the last meeting the Hi Hashers club has been reinstated for a total today of 58 clubs. There are two clubs eligible for Longevity awards. Awards were given to The Capital City Squares, Northeast District with 45 years and the Santa Fe Trailers, Northwest District, 50 years.

Correspondence. Ruth Ann Reynolds – No report.

Boundaries and Relations: Ray and Vicki Wittman – No report.

Constitution and Bylaws: Dan Reedy – No report.

Publications: Carol Morris reporting. She reported that a survey will be given out at the Festival to subscribers as well as non-subscribers as to whether they take the DOIN's and why. We hope this will give us insight on future issues.

DOIN's Editor: Edythe Weber has sent out an urgent plea to find a replacement for Dave Shafer wants to retire as the DOIN's Advertising Manager. Check with your club at your District meetings to recruit someone for this opening. Dave or Jim will discuss in detail what the responsibilities are.

The deadline for the next issue is September 25. Work should be done on all 2017 schedules. The following deadline, November 25, is the final date for all location changes/additions and club directory updates. Any new dancers that graduate will

receive a free copy of the DOIN's and the request form is on the website, www. squaredancemissouri.com/Missouri for subscription information.

DOIN's Circulation: Jim Weber reporting. He reported that for July and August mailing we had 325 subscriptions and 14 miscellaneous for a total mailing of 339. There were 36 renewals received, eight new subscriptions, and 23 expiring DOIN's post cards mailed. The financial report has a beginning balance as of June 12 through August 20 of \$100 with total subscriptions of \$585. A Funds transfer to the Missouri Federation of \$574.12 and Expenses of \$10.88 amounted to an ending balance of \$100.

DOIN's Advertising: Dave Shafer – No report.

Promotions and Recruiting: Jack Rockaway reporting. Jack requested a grant for \$500 to help with lessons for Starlite Twirlers Family Square Dance Club from the Northwest District. They are predicting total expenses of \$1,000 out of pocket. The grant would help with caller travel, hall rental, and miscellaneous.

State Festival Site Screening: Dan Reedy – No report.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. He stated that as of today, there are 1,441 dancers insured through Missouri Federation. Dancers insured through other federations are 390 for a total of 1,831 Missouri dancers. The number of Missouri clubs is 58. As a reminder, all new dancers are only insured at and during lessons at lessons location only. As new members they are not insured until the national insurance coordinator receives the enrollment form. The 2016 premium is still \$4.75 per dancer. In order for any club to receive a reimbursement of \$35, all dues must be paid and 2017 insurance forms received by November 1, 2016.

District Presidents, remember the state purchases insurance for your district. All district officers should have a list of what club they are insuring through.

The financial report brought a beginning balance of \$430.91 with income from clubs of \$130.50 and expenses of USDA insurance payment \$128.70 for an ending balance of \$432.71.

Since the last report we have added 14 new dancers and one new club.

As of 2017 starting with the new dance year, the dancers will be insured in lessons at other dance places.

- Must be a beginning dancer starting in a basic new class.
- Club to turn in class roster for students to be covered by insurance with a beginning and ending date submitted on roster form.
- Coverage until graduation but not to exceed 9 months.
- Student dancers would be covered by insurance at any sanctioned dance they attended if roster has been submitted we are not limiting coverage to student dances.

License Plate: Sharon White reporting. The beginning balance as of February 14 was \$65. We had eight 1-year renewals, one 1-year new and 10 2-year renewals for a total income of \$724 and total rebates of \$299.40. A check was given to the Missouri Federation for \$425.60 and the new balance as of August 21 is \$65.00.

USDA: Edythe Weber reporting. 
