

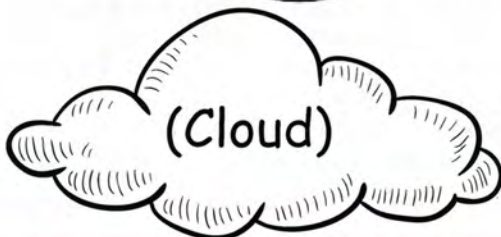

# Insurance Chairman Notes

The 2018 initial enrollment packets will be mailed in September to each club. For things to go smoothly and your club to receive the packet in a timely manner, I need to know who to send it to. **If there is a change in who should receive the packet, please email your club name, insurance contact name, complete postal mailing address, and phone number to [moinurance@kc.rr.com](mailto:moinurance@kc.rr.com) by Saturday, September 10, 2017.**

**DO NOT USE previous year forms. Use only 2018 forms. Anything not on 2018 forms will be returned to you to complete on the correct forms.**

**Make sure to pay State dues by November 1<sup>st</sup> and make sure to have your initial insurance enrollment turned in by November 1<sup>st</sup> to be eligible for the \$35 reimbursement. This is a great benefit to clubs, so make sure you don't miss out.**


Remember to submit new members as they join your club using the *additional enrollment* form. This can be found in your packet or on the web at [www.insurance.squaredancemissouri.com](http://www.insurance.squaredancemissouri.com)

**A reminder to all clubs holding lessons.** For your class members to be insured during your lessons you must submit a club class roster before they can be covered. There is no cost to cover new dancers in lessons. However they are only insured at and during lessons. Once your new dancer's graduate they are no longer insured until they join a club and pay the insurance premium and the club submits an additional enrollment form.

Remember to complete an accident report form for **ALL accidents** that occur at your dance, even if they appear minor at the time. It is hard to remember who, what, when, where and how weeks later; documentation at the time is best. Keep them on file and submit as needed.

## Did you know?

Car fires can happen when light is refracted by a prism hanging on the rear view mirror or other location in the car. Light becomes concentrated (refracted) on one point such as papers left on a car seat. The papers heat up and a fire results. The same thing can happen with a plastic water bottle sitting in a car with sunlight shining on it. So, don't hang light refracting prisms in your car and do not leave plastic water bottles in the car where they are in the sunlight.

**I**t is hard to believe summer is over and the fall season is upon us. We can look forward to cooler temperatures and more time to dance.

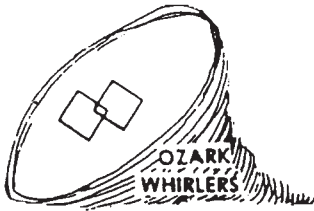
The Twirlers will again be dancing only once a month during September and October. Our first dance falls on Labor Day weekend and has been canceled. Our second dance on

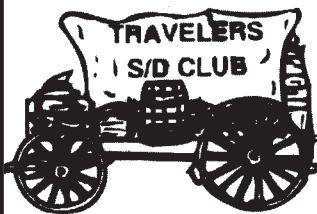

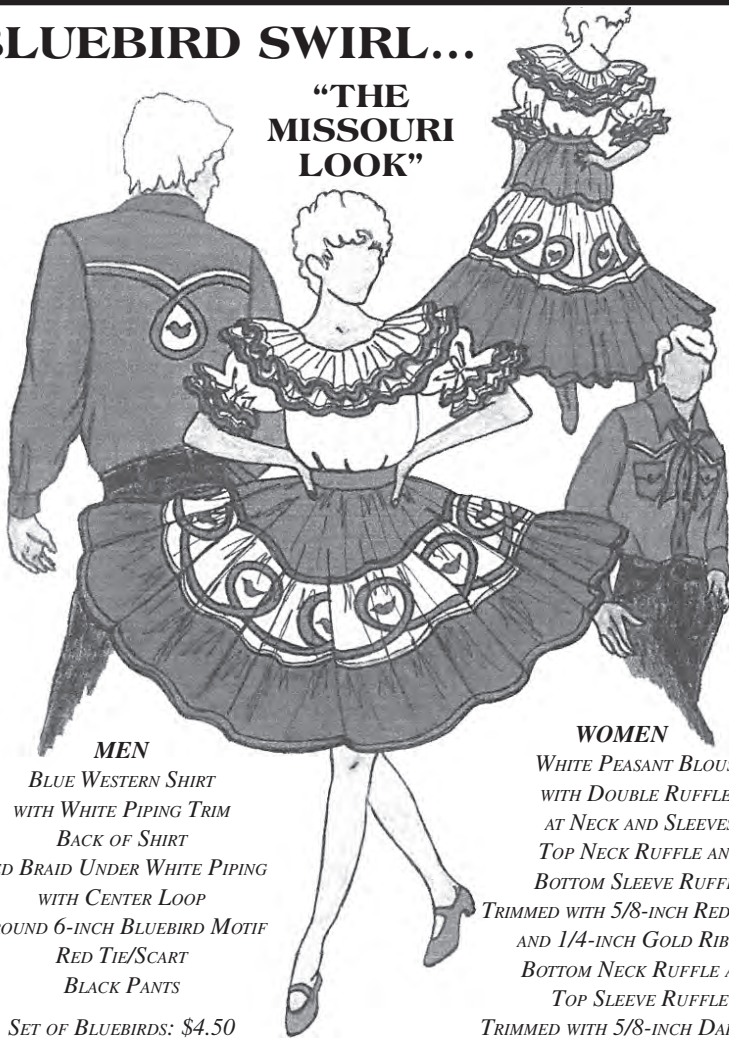

## A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

### REQUIRED:

1. Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

### Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
2. Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
3. Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

**Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.**

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.

**Roll Call:** Penny Byers. Full Quorum achieved.

**Approval of April Minutes:** President Reedy asked for corrections or additions to the April minutes. Charles Smith moved to accept the minutes as presented. Motion was seconded and carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Rosa Davis reported a beginning checking balance as of March 31, 2017 of \$19,542.61. Since the last meeting we've had Revenue of \$3,205.16 and Expenses of \$15,995.39. The ending checking account balance as of June 4, 2017 is \$6,752.38. Total CDs and interest amounted to \$50,094.12 for Total Funds on hand of \$56,846.50. The Treasurer's report will be submitted for audit.

A \$10,000 CD was purchased at the Academy Bank (19 months / 1.31% APY)

Per Jim Weber's question at the last meeting about the \$10 service charge on Feb 28, Rosa reported the checking account balance dropped below \$1,000 and that is what the bank charges if it drops below \$1,000. If anyone has any further questions, please contact Rosa.

**Membership and Club Longevity:** Rosa Davis reported we have 56 clubs this year. No Longevity Awards at this time.

**Correspondence:** Penny Byers reporting. A get well soon card for Sharon White was passed around for her hip replacement on May 24.

**Boundaries and Relations:** Ray and Vicki Wittman. No report.

**Constitution and Bylaws:** Ron & Marie Selfors. No report.

**Publications:** Carol Morris. (Absent) No report.

**DOIN'S Editor:** Edythe Weber reporting. Congratulations – all but 3 club article writers made the deadline and had their articles in before Memorial Day!! It made my job so much easier.

The next deadline is July 25 for the September/October issue. **Clubs that dance the September-August dance season should send me their full year schedule as soon as possible.** Also send to Dave if your club does ads.

Just a reminder that the forms for sending items for the DOIN'S are available and interactive on the web at [www.squaredancemissouri.com](http://www.squaredancemissouri.com) or you can request we send them to you electronically.

**DOIN'S Circulation:** Jim Weber reporting. Subscriptions for the DOIN'S this month were 266, 1 exchange copy and 13 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of 280. We received 25 renewals, 3 new subscriptions and 0 copies went to new students. We will be sending out 30 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the July/August issue.

Financial Report: The balance brought forward was \$100 with a total income of \$1,191.00 (from subscriptions & SW District DOIN'S dance). Expense of postage amounted to \$0.00. A check for \$1,191.00 was given to the Federation. The ending balance is \$100.

**DOIN's Advertising:** Dave Shafer. (Absent) No report.

**Promotions and Advertising:** Jack & Becky Rockaway. (Absent) No report.

**State Festival Site Screening:** Ron & Marie Selfors Reporting. We went to Sedalia to look at possible sites for the 2020 State Festival. Liz will bring it forward at the next meeting. It was a good view, they weren't able to get the Armory building, but they have a couple of other buildings that would work.

**Insurance Coordinator:** Jim Weber reporting. As of June 4, 2017, 1,374 dancers are insured through Missouri Federation; 328 dancers are insured through other federations; for a total of 1,702 Missouri dancers. (56 Missouri Clubs)

Remember to submit the club sponsored class form. As of January 2017, new dancers in lessons will be covered anywhere they dance, IF the club sponsoring the lessons has completed and filed the Missouri club sponsored class form for 2017. Once the new dancers graduate lessons, they are no longer insured until they join a club, pay the insurance premium and the club submits an additional enrollment form. New members are not covered until the national insurance coordinator receives the enrollment form. 100% participation of club members is required. The 2017 premium is \$4.75 per dancer.

Remember to complete an accident form for ALL accidents that occur at your dance, even if they appear minor at the time.

Financial Report: Beginning balance as of April 9, 2017, is \$280.80; total income of \$161.00 and expenses of \$144.15 leaves us an ending balance on June 3, 2017, of \$297.65.

We have added 31 new dancers since last meeting.

**Travel Missouri:** Jim Marron reporting. As of June 1, 2017, the total number of dangles given out for Missouri was 439.

**Historian:** Dan Wheeler. (Absent) No report.

**License Plate:** Sharon White. (Absent) Edythe Weber reporting. Sharon has received her first renewal for this year. Please be sending her your renewal notices so she can send you the emblem approval for you to get your license renewed in July.

**USDA:** Edythe Weber reporting. The annual Board of Directors meeting in Cincinnati is Wednesday, June 21, 2017 Hall C in the Duke Energy Center at 1:00 p.m. Our delegates should have received their packet of information.

A new discount prescription card will be introduced at the meeting. Information on the card is already on the USDA website. The old one will still be active, but we are trying to get the word out to the cardholders to switch over. We believe it will have a much better discount than the old one.

In addition, a new 19 page booklet, Communications for Square Dance Leaders, will be on the USDA publications table for the first time, hot off the presses. There is a wide variety of topics to help square dance clubs, whether announcing new class opportunities or advertising a special dance event, to get the word out to both current dancers and to the broader community of potential new dancers. This publication aims to provide some tips, hints, and information to support dance leaders in communicating about dance activities. It includes sections on traditional media, social media, and other strategies for advertising and promoting square dancing and sharing the benefits of square dancing with others.

**ARTS:** Edythe Weber reporting. Annual meeting is Sunday, June 25 in Room 236 in the Duke Energy Convention Center. The meeting will start at 9:00 a.m. and should be over by 2:00 p.m. Anyone may attend this meeting.

**District Presidents' Report:** Sharon Crisel reporting. SW District meeting is August 13th in Neosho. NW District meeting is July 22nd at the Point in Kansas City. State Fair deadline for tickets is July 1st. We had a little bit of discussion about the Square Dancer of the Year, it was brought to our attention that the rules were brought up at the February meeting and then changed; nominations need to be into your district presidents by July 1, then the district presidents need to have them to the committee chairman (Carolyn Goucher) by July 15th. That was a Standing Rule change, so check your State Festival club packet and make sure the rule has been changed on the form.

**Youth and Children's Dance:** Sharon & Larry Crisel. I have sent an application into the MOAHPERD that we have done every year for the last 12 or 13 years, except the last year. The meeting is in November, but won't hear back from anyone until September. We have always done a one hour workshop with the Physical Education and Recreation Teachers at the Lake of the Ozarks.

**Bill Morris Scholarship:** Robert Turner reporting. Please continue to think on this issue (if you want to continue it or not) and we will vote on it either at the August or October meeting.

**2017 State Festival:** Ray & Vicki Wittman. Registrations are coming in very slow. Polo shirts are selling fine, but regular T-Shirts are not. Caller/Cuer responses



are coming in. We have about 25 now. After paying \$2500 to the Cowan Civic Center, we now have about \$1,000 on hand. This money will cover the caller/cuer expenses. We visited the Cowan Civic Center this past week and told them we will not be using the theatre. There is a wide hall outside of the theatre on the 2nd floor and that is where we will be holding our workshops. We have asked Paula's workshop as a vendor and she said she would come. Do you think we need another one? The Ole Sew-n-Sew Square Dance Shop has been placing ads in the DOIN'S, I think we should invite them.

Jim Weber – one of the reasons we are not a 501C-3, is b/c at our Festivals we do not have Educational Seminars. We need to consider someone giving Educational Seminar's at our Festivals. USDA has hundreds of topics. We can use their pamphlets in the Seminar's.

**National Convention:** Carl and Cindy Boone (absent). Jim Weber reporting. If you pre-registered for the 2018 Convention, you still need to fill out the long form and get it to me. Out of the 1700 dancers we have in Missouri, we have less than 300 registered for the National Convention.

#### OLD BUSINESS

**Hall of Fame Selection Committee:** George and Cleva Roth reporting. We need a committee for the Hall of Fame Selection. You decided at the last meeting you need a list of eligible committee members. There should be a list on each table. We need a volunteer from each district. After much discussion, it was decided that the "list" IS the "ballot". Secret vote was taken by each couple voting for 4 people (each from different districts).

A short break was taken while ballots were counted.

The Hall of Fame Selection Committee will consist of: John & Beverly Stuart (St Louis District), Loretta Compton (SW District), Bob & Shirley Turner (SE District) and Liz Rooks (WC District).

Sharon Crisel moved to destroy ballots. Motion was seconded and carried.

#### NEW BUSINESS

**2018 State Festival:** Sharon Crisel reporting. We are working on a design, we haven't finalized it yet. Does anyone have past State Festival ribbons (1994 and back)? I'd like to have them.

**USDA Delegates:** President Dan Reedy reported we tabled the discussion of how our USDA delegates should vote on the 501C-3 issue, continue or end. Jim Weber moved to remove the discussion off the table. Motion was seconded and carried.

After much discussion, the vote was 4 yes continue and 3 no, end it.

Delegates are: George & Cleva Roth and John & Bev Stuart. Dan Reedy is alternate.

**2019 MO State Festival Caller/Cuer:** In Carl & Cindy Boone's absence, President Dan Reedy reported that Carl & Cindy has the following proposal:

Caller: Noah Siegmann, Rubicon, WI - \$800.00 Plus two nights lodging.

Cuer: Cathy & Fred Fischer, Conway AR - \$425.00 Plus two nights lodging.

We need Board approval before they can send contracts to them. Sharon Crisel moved to send contracts to Carl & Cindy's proposed caller/cuer. Motion seconded and carried.

**Showcase of Ideas:** President Dan Reedy reported Dave Shafer has the stuff stored. Is anyone taking it to Cincinnati? Edythe Weber went over what the job entails. After discussion, George & Cleve Roth volunteered to set-up (Wednesday at 10:00 a.m.); Dan Reedy volunteered to check on it and to tear-down (Saturday at 2:00 p.m.).

**Audit Committee Report:** Liz Rooks reporting. The 2017 committee (to look at 2016 books) consists of Curt & Phyllis Brockhaus, Tom Miller and Liz Rooks. We met on May 30th. We reviewed the following books: State Treasurer – Rosa Davis; License Plate – Sharon White; Show Me DOIN'S – Jim & Edythe Weber; Mo Fed Insurance – Jim & Edythe Weber; Show Me DOIN'S Advertising – Dave Shafer; and the 2016 Mo. State Festival – Dan & Jean Wheeler. We found all records to be in very good order.

**Bob Turner:** Earlier it was mentioned that we do not have an operating budget for this year. Therefore, I recommend we adopt last years' budget and use it this year. Recommendation was seconded. After some discussion and a suggestion to take out the puzzle sales for 2017, recommendation carried.

He is Chairman of the CALLERLAB Music Producers Committee and writes a square dance music review/square dance commentary that appears monthly in *American Square Dance Magazine* and the *The Northeast Square Dancer Magazine*.

Buddy maintains a strong home program of four weekly class/workshops in Southern California in addition to traveling on weekends and working full-time as a licensed contractor.

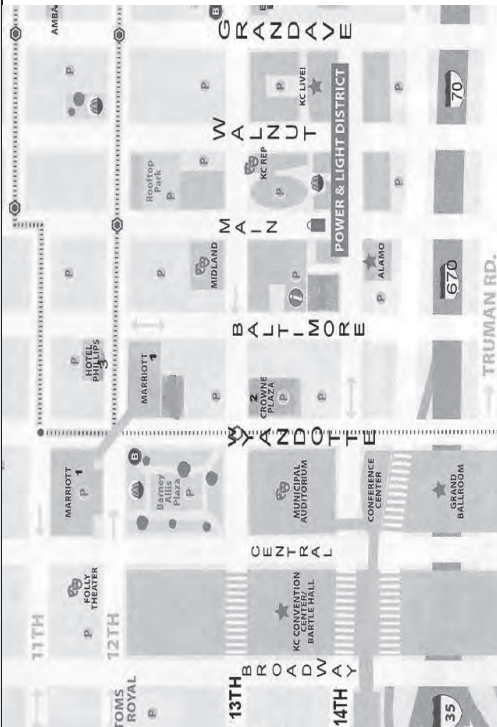
