Things I Learn as I Grow Up by Dave Shafer

During winter months, clean ALL windows on your vehicle of ice and snow. Peep holes do not work. Side and rear windows need to be cleaned too. You must be able to see all around you in order not to have an accident. You want to see those who are looking out of their peep hole(s) so you can avoid them and not scare the heck out of them. Don't forget the exterior mirrors. They are fragile, so if you do not have exterior heated mirrors, use deicer or a blow dryer to clean them of ice and snow. I learned the hard way. Hit the brakes a little too hard and all that snow on top will be on your windshield, so clean the roof of your vehicle too.

Just because you have four-wheel drive or all-wheel drive does not mean you can drive faster during inclement weather. These vehicles cannot travel any safer on ice or snow-slick roads than other vehicles and can slide, skid or run off the shoulder of the road just as fast as any other vehicle. Slow down according to driving conditions. Doing donuts on an icy highway is frightening when you are the one spinning out to meet an on-coming vehicle or a 100 foot plunge off the highway.

To improve traction on ice and snow, add weight to the rear of your car or truck. Sandbags can be purchased at most hardware stores. If you become stuck in an icy or snowy area, use the sand under your tires to add traction. This will allow you, in most cases, to get out of being stuck. The forty pound bags of cat litter will work too, but leave the cats at home. If the snow is wet, unless used in abundance, cat litter may smear like the clay it is instead of adding traction.



Call Ahead FIRST Before Traveling to a Dance.

Severe weather, e.g. snow, icy roads, and other winter weather events such as Flooding, Thunder Storms, Tornados or other concerns and issues may cause the club you plan to visit to cancel their dance at the last minute.

During these weather events, or if a weather event is forecast, call the club contact ahead of time to ensure that the dance you are planning to attend is either going to happen as scheduled, or has been cancelled. You can find a list of club contacts at the back of the Show-Me Doin's.

You can also tune in to your local weather forecasts on your radio, television, computer and smart phone apps before traveling, regardless of the reason of travel.

A very good investment is a NOAA Weather Radio. These can be purchased at almost any electronics store or department store. Be sure to buy one with the **SAME** Warning Alarm Capability and a battery backup. The voice of the National Weather Service provides alerts concerning severe weather 24 hours a day.

You can also go to weather.gov on the internet and click on whichever state you are in for the latest watches, warnings, advisories and forecasts.

If you know that road closures may be a problem due to winter conditions or flooding, tornados, severe wind conditions, or road construction, go to the State Traffic and Road Closures on the internet to find out the condition of your planned route to a dance or other event.

REMEMBER: Never attempt to drive through flooded low water crossings or other waters on the roadways.

We want to see you across a square. So, travel safely and sanely.

A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.

Roll Call: Penny Byers. Full Quorum achieved. 4 Guests: Floyd & Judy Englehart, USDA VP Plains Region, Roslie Mogerman of Travelers Square Dance Club, and Kevin Bersing.

Approval of August Minutes: President Reedy asked for corrections or additions to the Aug minutes. Fred Goucher moved to accept the minutes as presented. Motion was seconded and carried.

Treasurer's Report: Rosa Davis reported a beginning checking balance as of July 31, 2017 of \$6,216.09. Since the last meeting we've had Revenue of \$1,034.67 and Expenses of \$4,516.92. The ending checking account balance as of October 22, 2017 is \$2,733.84. Total CDs and interest amounted to \$50,195.57 for Total Funds on hand of \$52,929.41. The Treasurer's report will be submitted for audit.

I moved the CD purchases from "Revenue" & "Expenses" to "Transfers NET" and I have added "Mo Fed Scholarship" to "Expenses".

Membership and Club Longevity: Rosa Davis reported we have 20 clubs that have paid their 2018 dues. At this point we have 56 clubs. No Longevity awards this month.

Correspondence: Penny Byers reporting. A get well soon card was passed around for John Stuart and sympathy cards were passed around for the Buck Family and Pat Coster, for the loss of Caller Mike Kelley.

Boundaries and Relations: Ray and Vicki Wittman. No report.

Constitution and Bylaws: Ron & Marie Selfors. Bob Turner handed out a revision to the By Laws concerning the Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs Scholarship. (Article XVII)

Publications: Carol Morris reporting. Friday and Saturday nights, we had 6 new subscriptions and 12 renewals for the Doin's. Then today we had 18 renewals. We had 189 people sign in for the Doin's Dance this morning. Of that 189, 12 were callers. Donations today was \$682, our expenses were \$43, we had a profit of \$639.

DOIN'S Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. We want to thank all the club article writers. Without you and your dedication to helping your club get the word out about your upcoming dances, the magazine would be just a bunch of paper with staples down the side. Keep up the good work!

The next deadline is November 25 for the first issue of 2018, January/February. Items

that are due are your club article, your dance location listing, the 2018 schedule, and check your contact in the Doin's to make sure it is a current dancer who knows what is going on in your club. Try to use cell phones if possible.

Again, the forms for sending items for the Doin's are available and interactive on the web at www.squaredancemissouri.com or you can request we send them to you electronically.

DOIN'S Circulation: Jim Weber reporting. Subscriptions for the DOIN'S this month were 326, 2 exchange copies and 13 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of 341. We received 24 renewals, 8 new subscriptions and 0 copies went to new students. We will be sending out 38 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the September/October issue. The 38 postcards may go down depending on who all renewed this weekend at the dance.

Financial Report: The balance brought forward was \$100.00 with a total income of \$525.00 (from subscriptions). Expense of postage amounted to \$8.24. A check for \$516.76 was given to the Federation. The ending balance is \$100.

Jim is looking for a replacement for Doin's Circulation.

DOIN's Advertising: Dave Shafer. The balance brought forward on Aug 13, 2017 was \$100.00. Total income (from DOIN'S Ads & Caller/Cuer Directory Listings) was \$837.65 and total expenses (postage) was \$6.65. A check for \$831.00 was given to the Federation. The ending balance is \$100.

I need your club schedules if you have not gotten them to me yet. I'm willing to work with you on Ad's for clubs, District Dances, personal, etc.

Promotions and Advertising: Jack and Becky Rockaway. We received a letter from one of the clubs that received a grant. They told us how they used it and the number of students they have.

State Festival Site Screening: Ron & Marie Selfors Reporting. We received an invite by the SW District to go to Springfield and take a look at the Oasis as a potential site. They had no pricing available yet and had no understanding of what the Visitors Center or Chamber might contribute to make that happen. Report is we found the site interesting but don't know yet if we will be able to use the site.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. As of October 22, 2017, 1,379 dancers are insured through Missouri Federation; 328 dancers are insured through other federations; for a total of 1,707 Missouri dancers. (56 Missouri Clubs)

Clubs holding lessons: You **MUST** submit the club sponsored class form. There is no cost to cover new dancers in lessons. Once your new dancer's graduate they are no longer insured until they join a club and pay the insurance premium and the club submits an additional enrollment form. The 2017 premium is \$4.75 per dancer.

Remember to complete an accident form for **ALL accidents** that occur at your dance, even if they appear minor at the time.

The 2018 insurance packets were mailed in September. The 2018 insurance premium will remain the same \$4.75 per dancer. (send in Form 1, 2 & 3)

DO NOT use the 2017 insurance forms, this will just slow things down, I will have to send them back to you.

For your club to receive the \$35.00 club reimbursement, your 2018 club State dues must be paid by your district to the State Treasurer and the Insurance Chairman has received your club 2018 insurance forms by the November 1, 2017 deadline.

Financial Report: Beginning balance as of August 13, 2017, is \$297.95; total income of \$24.25 and expenses of \$181.42 leaves us an ending balance on October 21, 2017, of \$140.78

SW District is losing three clubs; NW District is losing three clubs; WC District is losing 1 club.

Travel Missouri: Jim Marron reporting. As of October 19, 2017, the total number of dangles given out for Missouri was 444.

The title of their program is "Jazz up Your Fitness with Square Dancing." It has been set for November 10 from 4:15 – 5:15pm in room Marbella B & C. Gene Wilson (Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame 2017) will do the program along with Larry & Sharon Crisel & Dave Schafer & any Angels that may be able to attend.

Youth Hospitality at State Convention. Sharon Crisel & BobTurner had applications for Missouri Scholarship & USDA Scholarship as well as info on Youth at Nationals. 7-10 Adults – No youth.

Mo Fed Scholarship: Robert Turner reporting. The Mo Fed Scholarship will soon be on the website. Please promote this Scholarship in your area.

2017 State Festival: Ray & Vicki Wittman. Attendance this year was 409 which includes 50 non-paying (callers/cuers/past presidents); Caller did a great job; Auction was very good – we think about \$849; 8 callers did not show up (some due to illness or death in the family); We would like to pay our sound person out of our profits; We could not get anyone to man the concession stand so our daughter volunteered (I did not realize you were supposed to get the Girl Scout or Boy Scouts in the area to do this).

National Convention: Carl and Cindy Boone reporting. Out of the 1,705 dancers we have in Missouri, we have 348 registered for the National Convention, 1,674 total registered. We hope to get to 4,000. We have board meetings every month now. 248 days away (as of Oct 22). National callers are out there promoting the Convention as well.

OLD BUSINESS

Hall of Fame Selection: George and Cleva Roth reporting. Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame for 2017 is Gene Wilson.

Square Dancer of the Year: Fred & Carolyn Goucher reporting. Square Dancers of the Year for 2017 are Larry & Sharon Crisel.

Ron Selfors: White Paper – "re-look" "re-focus" "recruitment" and "re-tension". This is going to be a major task to undertake. I would like volunteers to be on the committee with me. We will probably do the most part by tele-conference and emails.

The committee will be made up of volunteers: Merle Hall, Fred Goucher, Carl Boone & Dan Reedy. We still need members from different areas and districts, callers/cuers and definitely youth members.

Youth at 2018 Nationals: Sharon Crisel & Edythe Weber reporting. It was suggested that Sharon try talking to the Mayor to see if they will honor the verbal agreement. We look forward to caller Joe Saltel and Curers Shirley & Don Heiny. If anyone has stayed at a really bad hotel in this area, please let us know so we don't have it on the list for next year.

Jack Rockaway: SE District asked for 50 of the Learn to Dance signs and NW District asked for 30 signs. (\$8.44 each).

Liz Rooks: Many of you attended the Missouri State Fair Dance. As best as we could count, 200 folks showed up. We passed out almost all of the 300 tickets we had requested. I think the weather kept some people away. I have the brochure with the ad where we added our website at the bottom of it, if anyone would like to see it.

George Roth: 20/20 Caller/Cuer selection committee met and we have the following recommendation: Romney Tannehill featured caller for \$800 & 2 nights lodging; Natalie Sprocey featured cuer for \$350 & 2 nights lodging.

Nominating Committee Report: George & Cleva Roth reporting. We have election of new officers for 2018 at our October meeting. We would like to present our 2018 MFSRDC Slate of Officers. President: Ron & Marie Selfors (Central District); 1st VP: John & Beverly Stuart (St Louis District); 2nd VP: Jack & Becky Rockaway (NW District); 3rd VP: Merle & Madeline Hall (NE District); Secretary: David & Penny Byers; Treasurer: Rosa Davis; Past President: Dan Reedy. President Dan Reedy asked 3 times if there are any nominations from the floor. Dave Shaffer moved to close nominations and accept the slate of officers from the committee by acclimation. The motion was seconded and carried.

Edythe Weber: Article XII of the Standing Rules is labeled Officer Memorials. Section III addresses that a suitable floral arrangement or a monetary donation to a charitable organization will be sent upon notification of death a state caller/cuer. I would like to move that Mo Fed makes a \$75 donation to a charitable organization the Pat Coster designates for Mike Kelley. Motion seconded and carries.
