

THINGS I LEARN AS I GROW UP — Dave Shafer

A person either likes or dislikes coffee. While growing up, I didn't drink coffee. That was for adults only according to mom. It wasn't until I was 18 that I ever got to try it, and I didn't really like the taste. Besides, it was hot. Later, I found that drinking coffee is an acquired taste, not a taste that one naturally has.

Making the Army a career changed me in many ways, making me more adventurous, comfortable in public speaking, and drinking coffee. There were times that if you didn't drink coffee, there just wasn't anything else to drink. AND, Army coffee was usually strong and bitter (called battery acid or varnish remover), but there were times that the coffee (joe) was actually good to the taste buds. Then while stationed overseas, we had a mess sergeant who had a pair of Olive Drab (OD) wool boot socks. So what do boot socks have to do with making coffee? He put the coffee grounds in the socks, tied a knot in the open end and tossed them into the kettle. When the coffee was done, out came the socks, grounds and all. There were those who wouldn't drink his coffee because they couldn't get past the socks, but the coffee was clear and very good. He had the science of making tasty coffee tuned to an art.

Some people seem to overdo the drinking of coffee by carrying a steaming cup everywhere they go. In Germany, we had a Major who carried his cup of Java everywhere he went. The enemy would not have had a hard time finding him because he dribbled coffee up and down the halls, stairs, on desks, sidewalks and everywhere else he went. We tired of cleaning up after his visits and strolls, so we all chipped in, and during an awards ceremony presented him with a sippy cup. No more dribbles.

Today, coffee comes in about every flavor imaginable. I find many of them good, but they can't replace a really good cup of black coffee.



LET'S TOOT OUR HORN

A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.

Lynn Nelson, 2018 Caller/Cuer Hall Of Fame

Lynn's family moved to Kansas City area in 1988 when her husband's work with the Santa Fe Railroad transferred their family to the area. They took lessons with the Swangers Square Dance Club in 1989 and became members of this club.

In June of 1996, she decided to become a caller. She started by attending Kaw Valley Caller School, instructed by Dana Schirmer in Topeka, Kansas, and a group of dancers. They met weekly and were a big help in improving her calling skills.



In July of 1997, she attended the Heart of America Callers School, held in Kansas City and instructed by Tony Oxendine and Jerry Junck. In September 1997, she attended the Golden Triangle Square Dance Caller College held in Woodville, Texas, with Wayne Morvent and Wade Driver. In 2000, 2004 and 2010 she again went back to the Heart of America Callers School to work with Jerry Junck, Paul Henze and Tim Marriner to try to refine some of her skills.

She has been the Club Caller for the B-N-R Squares since May '97. In 1999, she was asked to be the club caller for the Mustangs Square Dance Club in Overland Park, Kansas. The Mustangs closed the club in May 2011.

Since becoming a caller, she has become active in several Callers' organizations including, CALLERLAB; KAMO Callers, Cuers and Partners; NE KS Callers, and KS State Callers. She has served as an officer in several positions in both NE KS Callers and KAMO Callers.

In the spring of 2014, she was honored to be named Co-Caller of the Year and inducted into the Heart of America Federation's Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame.

In the years since she began calling, she has traveled all over the states of Kansas and Missouri, up into Nebraska, Iowa, down to Arkansas and Texas, in Illinois and even out to Wyoming to call and has danced in several other states, as well. In 2015, she began teaching lessons in the Rio Grande Valley in Texas and was able to call a dance there, as well as continuing lessons in 2016. As of 2017, in Texas, she has a full program of lessons and a weekly dance, as well as a couple of special dances. She has also called at several national conventions and state conventions.

Whenever ask, she does specials for schools, youth groups, retirement homes. Always trying to get the activity out for all to see. She also has served on many committees for the national square dance conventions.





- 1. When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/her.
- 2. Remaining dancers join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3. Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arch.

He was club caller for the Western Twirlers in Joplin from 1988 until he retired from calling in 2010. He also called for the Center Creek Squares in Sarcoxie, MO and other clubs during his 62 years as a caller. He was a well-known caller in Kansas, Oklahoma, Arkansas as well as Missouri. Although he retired from calling, he continued to attend the Western Twirlers' dances.

Van supported many square dance functions throughout the years including the area Kidney Foundation Dance and Cerebral Palsy Square and Round Dance benefits. He taught beginner classes for many years and included workshops for beginners before his club dances. He was inducted into the Missouri Square Dance Caller / Cuer Hall of Fame in 2005.

He is survived by his lovely wife Elfriede. They met in 1981 while she was taking square dance lessons and they were together ever since. He is also survived by six daughters, fifteen granddaughters and many great grandchildren and great-great grandchildren.

Services were held on October 17, 2018 in the Park Plaza Christian Church with burrial in the Ozark Memorial Park Cemetery.


2018 Square Dancer of the Year Ralph & Sarah Meservey

(7 Executive Board / 15 District Directors / 10 Staff & Past Presidents) Guests: Ruth Ann Reynolds, new Doin's Circulation Manager; Shirley Winans; SW District Secretary, Roslie Mogerman, Central District; John & Dorothy Robin and Jim & Donna Barks (in charge of the meal), SE District, & Mary Pitts' sister from California.

President Ron Selfors thanked the hosts, SE District and all their clubs for a fun Federation dance and a great lunch.

Approval of Minutes: President Selfors asked for corrections or additions to the August minutes. Edythe Weber moved to accept the minutes as corrected. Motion was seconded and carried.

Treasurer's Report: Rosa Davis reported a beginning checking balance as of July 31, 2018 of \$7,150.92. Since the last meeting we've had Revenue of \$1,446.43 and Expenses of \$2,859.93. The ending checking account balance as of September 30, 2018 is \$5,737.42. Total CDs and interest amounted to \$50,467.32 for Total Funds on hand of \$56,204.74. The Treasurer's report will be submitted for audit.

I moved matured Security Bank CD to Academy (24months @ 2.68% APY)

Membership and Club Longevity: Rosa Davis reported we have 49 clubs; only have 3 districts that have paid dues.

Correspondence: Penny Byers reporting. Get well soon card was passed around for Sharon White. Sympathy card was passed around for Van Greenwood family.

Boundaries and Relations: Ray and Vicki Wittman. No report.

Constitution and Bylaws: Merle Hall. The 501c3 amended copy was sent out.

Publications: Carol Morris reporting. We had 181 (includes 12 callers), signed in to the Doin's benefit dance this morning. We raised \$562.10 (after expenses) for the Doin's. We had 30 renewals and 1 new subscription.

DOIN'S Editor: Edythe Weber reporting.

The next deadline is November 25 for the January/February 2019 issue. I know we all have better things to do than to work on Doin's articles, so please send early. Read the Editor's notes in the Nov/Dec issue and make sure we have everything we need from your club: 1) 2019 dance schedules 2) Updated location listing 3) Check contact listing in the club directory 4) New officers if your district president contact info has changed.

The first "electronic" subscription version was sent out with the Sept/Oct issue, articles and all. I had one funny person who told me they had trouble working the word search. I almost believed them.

Jim has been working with Ruth Ann Reynolds, teaching her the circulation manager job. Give Ruth Ann some space and a little time to get comfortable in her new role. Thanks Ruth Ann for volunteering.

We are having some trouble with the club article form sending from the web. If you use it, please send me a separate note that you used it, so that I can check with Dan if I didn't get it. Dan is very good about forwarding me info he gets. We are still trying to figure out what is causing the problem. I always

send a reply to you that we got your item, article, whatever it is. If you DO NOT get a reply within a few days, contact me. But please, do use the forms for sending items in for the Doin's. They are available on the web at www.squaredancemissouri.com. Click on Federation Information, then Show Me Doin's. Send direct from the web or print out.

DOIN'S Circulation: Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. Subscriptions for the DOIN'S since last meeting were 296, 2 exchange copies and 17 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of 315.

We received 55 renewals, 9 new subscriptions and 0 copies went to new students. We will be sending out 28 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the Nov/Dec issue. The electronic copy of the Doin's in now available. You must complete and sign form to receive via Email.

<u>Financial report:</u> The balance brought forward was \$100.00 with a total income of \$615.00 (from subscriptions). Expense of postage and supplies amounted to \$5.60. A check for \$609.40 was given to the Federation. The ending balance is \$100.

DOIN'S Advertising: Dave Shafer Reporting. The balance brought forward on Aug 19, 2018 was \$100.00. Total income (from DOIN'S Ads & Caller/Cuer Directory Listings) was \$956.00 and total expenses (postage) was \$6.70. A check for \$949.30 was given to the Federation. The ending balance on Oct 21, 2018, is \$100.00

Promotions and Advertising: Jack & Becky Rockaway reporting. Grant request from Ramblers in the NW District for \$300. We need to order a few more square dance signs. Carolyn Ahart asked if she could get some round dance signs. Jack will look into this.

State Festival Site Screening: No Report.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. As of Oct 21, 2018, we have 1,283 dancers insured through Missouri Federation; 335 dancers insured through other federations; for a total of 1,618 Missouri dancers. (49 Missouri Clubs). 19 clubs have paid their 2019 Ins. Premiums.

Clubs holding lessons: you MUST submit the club sponsored class form. There is no cost to cover new dancers in lessons. Once your new dancers graduate they are no longer insured until they join a club and pay the insurance premium and the club submits an additional enrollment form. If your class continues in 2019 you MUST resubmit your club lesson form for 2019.

As new members join your club, make sure you send in an additional enrollment form. They are not insured until the national insurance coordinator receives the enrollment form.

Remember to complete an accident form for ALL accidents that occur at your dance, even if they appear minor at the time.

The 2019 insurance packets were mailed in September; the 2019 insurance premium will remain the same \$4.75 per dancer.

DO NOT use the 2018 Insurance forms, this will just slow things down, because I will have to send them back to you. Please use the 2019 insurance forms in the packet.

For your club to receive the \$50 club reimbursement, your 2019 Club State dues must be paid by your district to the State Treasurer and the Insurance Chairman has received your club 2019 insurance forms by the November 1, 2018 deadline.

Financial Report: Beginning balance as of August 19, 2018, is \$336.66; total income of \$33.25 and expenses of \$245.06 leaves us an ending balance on Oct 20, 2018, of \$124.85.

Travel Missouri: Jim Marron reporting. Absent. No Report.

Blue Bird Coordinator: Madeline Hall reporting. The bluebirds have been made and are of good quality. They have been bagged in groups of 11 (10 for skirts & 1 for mans shirt) and there is 10 yards

of blue braid in the packages to be sold. I priced the package at \$15. That includes a set of directions. This price reflects a profit of approximately \$3.70 per package. Which will help to offset the cost of material, baggies and postage, if needed.

I displayed them at the State Festival and sold 2 sets for an income of \$30. I have a request for reimbursement for costs to make the birds and supplies to create the packages in the amount of \$42.35. There are more packages to be sold.

Webmaster: Dan Wheeler reporting. If you get an E-Mail from the SquareDanceMissouri.com team, delete it. It will tell you to enter your password to verify your E-Mail. It will tell you that if you don't do it, all your E-Mail will be deleted. Don't do it. Delete the E-Mail.

There are actually a very few of you who have Square Dance Missouri or We Square Dance E-Mail addresses with passwords, so it shouldn't be a problem. However, if the sender is sending the E-Mail to addresses on my domains, he may be doing it on other domains.

Almost all the E-Mail addresses on Square Dance Missouri or We Square Dance are auto forwarder addresses. They do not store any E-Mail anywhere. They forward the E-Mail to your real E-Mail address. Therefore, there is no E-Mail being stored to be deleted.

There is one actual We Square Dance E-Mail address. She got the E-Mail to enter her password. She did it, and it took me a week to figure out how to get her E-Mail working again. Just for the record. There is no SquareDanceMissouri.com team. I'm it.

So far this month, The Missouri Festival website has had about 650 hits and about 2600 for the year. The Missouri Federation has had about 800 hits so far this month and almost 1100 for the year.

I have told you that there are about 20 years Missouri Federation Minutes available On the Missouri Federation website. There are also district meeting minutes from Southwest and northwest district meetings. Your district minutes can be there if you send them to me. Please send them to me in MS Word (doc) format. You can do that using Word or Open Office, And Please Use any font other than Calibri.

For the first time this year there were special "Smart Phone Ready" web page caller schedules on the Missouri Festival website. I hope some of your used them. These are not "Apps". I don't know how to write apps, and it is expensive to get an app listed on your cell phone menu.

The 2019 Missouri Festival website is up and running. All registration forms are available there.

I am removing the prices from the Blue Bird pages pending receiving new up to date information.

Jean & I will be on vacation October 26 through November 9. The program director told me that I will have internet at all the hotels where we will be.

Historian: Dan Wheeler reporting. I have started an obituary page. It has links to all the obituaries that I have had on the website in the past. I am not making a big thing about it on the website. There is no button on the left side of the page to take you directly to it. Its purpose is strictly historical. If you want to see it, there are links to it from the History and Archive buttons.

I want to thank the people who got me the information so quickly about Van Greenwood. I was able to get an announcement on the website Sunday afternoon, and the complete obituary uploaded Monday afternoon.

I would prefer to put obituaries on the website only for people known in the state. Since this is a requirement that has no real definition, I will leave it up to you. If you know of someone who dies who you think should have his obituary there, send me the information and I will put it on the website. I will not argue with you about it. However, I would encourage you that none of you die off early just to get your obituary on the website. It's really not worth it.

License Plate: Sharon White. Absent. No Report.

USDA: (United Square Dancers of America) Edythe Weber reporting. The winter meeting will be Jan 24-26, 2019 in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania. The Eastern Region Vice Presidents have planned a full weekend of activities, including a dance at a local club and some sightseeing.

ARTS: (Alliance of Rounds, Traditional & Square Dance) Edythe Weber reporting. We have the license plate covers here for sale, \$5 each. Several people purchased at the August meeting in Eldon, and we ran out.

Missouri Federation Scholarship: Robert Turner reporting. We received a thank you letter from Hannah Gentry, the 2018 Scholarship winner. Letter is attached. We received an update from Sharon White, on her grandson, who was the winner of the very first scholarship. He's in Georgia training for a job similar to TSA Inspector. He appreciates the help he received through the Scholarship. His college major was criminal justice.

2018 State Festival: Larry & Sharon Crisel reporting. Our unofficial attendance was 412-418. (we had about 125 register at the door). Between \$1,000 - \$1,100 was raised from the silent auction. Winners of cash raffle - \$300 Carol Dodd, \$150 John Robbins and \$50 Jan Vaughn. Winner of the Branson get-away to Branson at the "Stone Castle Lodge" was Cleva Roth. Winner of the quilt was Virginia Vinyard (Nancy Wheelers sister). Winners of the 50/50 pot – Friday night Penny Byers \$94 and Saturday night Madeline Hall \$140. Dan Wheeler did a fantastic job getting all info on the website. Our Committee Chairmen and helpers made our job very easy. A big thank you to Kenny Bailey for helping John Stuart with the sound. The final report and payment to the state will be made next meeting.

Unfinished Business:

National Convention: Carl and Cindy Boone. A big thank you to all that helped. You all made this a huge success. People were saying this was one of the best Nationals they've ever been to. That's because we all worked together as a team. Some ranked it in the top 10, others ranked it in the top 5. Ways & Means items were donated to State, they raised \$257 from the table this weekend. The 67th NSDC Shirts were donated to the Warrensburg & Cameron VA's as a service project. We have 41 extra belt buckles, lots of bolos and pins. If you want any, let me know. All bills were paid except the Marriott. We were 310 rooms short - \$45,000. We have offered them \$37,000, we are hoping they will accept that.

2019 State Festival: Catherine McLemore reporting. Approximately 70 dancers registered so far. Sold almost all t-shirts & polos during festival weekend, so we will be ordering more in the next day or two. We will try to have shirts and registration table at all district dances and as many other dances as possible. We have had a donation of a 14K gold and diamond ring for a raffle prize. Discussed benefits of staying at the Oasis hotel - \$95 room rate, nice full breakfast, all-inclusive venue, free dry camping on back parking lot. All food & non-alcoholic beverages bought through the Oasis catering will be deducted from facility rental fee. There are many restaurants of all price points in the immediate area. The Holiday Inn and Double Tree will also honer the room rate when the Oasis is filled, with free

shuttle to/from. We will now accelerate our efforts in promotion and fund raising.

Section 4. Floral arrangements and/or donations will be of a reasonable amount not to exceed \$75.00 per memorial.

Article XIII Federation Member Memorials

The Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs, Inc. will donate a one-quarter page of The Doin's publication for a memorial for a recently deceased member of the federation. A full page will be donated for a deceased president of past president of the federation.

Proposed Standing Rule Changes Related to Memorials:

Article XII Officer Memorials

Section 1. A suitable floral arrangement or monetary donation to a charitable organization will be sent upon notification of the death of any of the following individuals

A. A present elected officer of the Federation as defined in Article V, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-Laws

B. A past president of the Federation

C. A recipient of Square Dancer of the Year or Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame Award

D. A present or past state caller or cuer

Section 2. A floral arrangement or charitable donation will be of a reasonable amount, not to exceed \$75.00 per memorial.

Section 4. Floral arrangements and/or donations will be of a reasonable amount not to exceed \$75.00 per memorial.

Article XIII Federation Member Memorials

Section 1. Based on a request by a district or club president, the Missouri Federation of Square 'N Round Dance Clubs, Inc. will donate a one-quarter page of The Doin's publication for a memorial for a recently deceased member of the Federation. The requesting district or club will provide the contents of the memorial to The Doin's editor.

Section 2. The Federation President, in coordination with the appropriate district President, will prepare a full-page memorial for publication in The Doin's for a deceased president of past president of the Federation.

After much discussion about whether the Standing Rules needed to be changed or not, it was decided that the SOP (Standard Operating Procedures) books needs to be updated, made more user friendly and put online. We have moved some boundaries, moved some clubs into different districts, trying to make the numbers a little more even. This is nothing set in stone. We are just not people who will bring problems to your attention without trying to help come up with a solution. It's very important we get something done ASAP. (Maps & info sheets attached).

Tony has received two Gold Records for outstanding sales of "Pretty Woman" on Ranch House Records and "The Square Dance Is On" on Lou Mac Records.


