

EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID

- 1. When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/her.
- 2. Remaining dancers join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3. Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arch.
- 4. On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an emergency call for aid.

TRAVEL MISSOURI PROGRAM



Participants may let people know what they have done by displaying the TRAVEL MISSOURI Bar with the District dangles identifying where they have danced. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.

Participation in TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant(s) may at their discretion obtain the Travel Missouri Bar and earn dangles from the Program Manager. To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI card (which may be obtained from the Manager, District Presidents, or Club Presidents or www.squaredancemissouri.com). Each time a participant who has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district, he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.





LET'S TOOT OUR HORN

A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square
 dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any
 announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in
 grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.

Dan is very good about forwarding me info he gets. We are still trying to figure out what is causing the problem. I always send a reply to you that we got your item, article, whatever it is. If you DO NOT get a reply within a few days, contact me.

DOIN'S Circulation: Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. Subscriptions 304, 2 exchange copies and 17 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of 323. Electronic Doin's emailed 24.

We received 88 renewals, 25 new subscriptions and 9 copies went to new students. 35 renewals at State dance. We will be sending out 30 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the Jan/Feb issue.

<u>Financial report:</u> The balance brought forward was \$100.00 with a total income of \$1,867.10 (from subscriptions & Doin's Dance at State Festival). Expense of postage and supplies amounted to \$73.33. A check for \$1,770.19 was given to the Federation. The ending balance is \$100.

DOIN'S Advertising: Dave Shafer Reporting. The balance brought forward on Oct 21, 2018 was \$100.00. Total income (from DOIN'S Ads & Caller/Cuer Directory Listings) was \$704.00 and total expenses (postage) was \$6.70. A check for \$697.30 was given to the Federation. The ending balance on Dec 9, 2018, is \$100.00

State Festival Site Screening: No Report.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. As of Dec 9, 2018, we have 1,283 dancers insured through Missouri Federation; 335 dancers insured through other federations; for a total of 1,618 Missouri dancers. (49 Missouri Clubs).

Remember to complete an accident form for ALL accidents that occur at your dance, even if they appear minor at the time.

USDA Insurance Program is working on a way for clubs to fill out and complete your forms through a portal. Watch for more info to come.

For 2019, we have 979 dancers insured the Missouri Federation; 254 dancers insured through other Federations. Total Missouri dancers 1233. Total Missouri clubs 45.

Financial Report: Beginning balance as of October 21, 2018, is \$223.03; total income of \$4,671.00 and expenses of \$4,686.49 leaves us an ending balance on December 8, 2018, of \$207.54.


