1. ALL clubs should provide updated location listing for the pull-out section in the Jan/Feb 2020 issue. All locations, even temporary ones, should be listed.



- 2. Clubs dancing January-December dance year need to provide a full year schedule to us. ALL Clubs ALL dates. Don't assume we know. If you have a date that you haven't confirmed a caller yet, put TBD (to be determined). If you haven't updated it by the time it rolls around, we will contact you if we have questions.
- 3. Make sure the club contact in the directory is a current dancer who knows what is going on. A cell phone is best, but we understand if you don't want to share a cell number. But if someone calls while you are at the dance, who's going to answer that home phone number?

Also, as lessons begin, don't forget we provide one issue for each new dancer (single/couple) for your graduation. What a better way to let them know how and where to get out and dance! There's a form to make your request on; please use it. Order EARLY. That form is available online or by requesting it from us. TO: All Missouri Clubs

USDA notified me today that the 2020 cost for insurance will Increase by \$0.10, the new rate will be \$4.85 per member.

DO NOT start 2020 enrollment at this time. The 2020 USDA insurance enrollment system portal is not ready to start enrollments.

When the 2020 USDA insurance enrollment system portal is ready to start enrollments, I will notify you and provide you with the new link to the 2020 USDA insurance enrollment system portal.

Things you can do to be ready to use the 2020 USDA insurance enrollment system portal when it becomes active:

- Have your complete club roster ready. First and Last name of all members. And if your club member is insured through another club make sure you have that club name.
- 2. Have all your club dance locations names and mailing addresses
- Also have all your club dance locations additional insured, names and mailing addresses.

If you do this ahead of time, your club 2020 insurance will go smooth and quick when I send you the 2020 USDA insurance enrollment system portal link.

I was told this should be the first week of November.

Therefore the insurance deadline for Missouri insured clubs is extended to December 1.

I will be holding a Missouri USDA insurance seminar on how to use the new USDA Insurance portal at the State Festival, Saturday at 1 pm. All club insurance contacts should attend this insurance seminar. This will help you when is time to do your 2020 enrollment.



Beginner Callers Support

TO RECEIVE 1/4-PAGE FREE ADVERTISING IN THE SHOW-ME DOIN'S FOR ONE YEAR

Submit the following to the State Board of the Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs:

- 1. New caller show proof of successfully completing an acknowledged calling school within the past 12 months.
- 2. Be a member of an acknowledged caller association CALLERLAB or American Callers Association.
- 3. Reside within a district of the Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs and/or be affliated with a club of the Missouri Federation.
- 4. Show proof of BMI/ASCAP licensing.
- 5. Provide business card or desired ad layout for the Show-Me Doin's.

Send all requested information to the President of the Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs for presentation of request at the next available State Board meeting.

Call Ahead FIRST Before Traveling to a Dance.

Severe weather, e.g. snow, icy roads, and other winter weather events such as Flooding, Thunder Storms, Tornados or other concerns and issues may cause the club you plan to visit to cancel their dance at the last minute.

During these weather events, or if a weather event is forecast, call the club contact ahead of time to ensure that the dance you are planning to attend is either going to happen as scheduled, or has been cancelled. You can find a list of club contacts at the back of the Show-Me Doin's.

You can also tune in to your local weather forecasts on your radio, television, computer and smart phone apps before traveling, regardless of the reason of travel.

A very good investment is a NOAA Weather Radio. These can be purchased at almost any electronics store or department store. Be sure to buy one with the SAME Warning Alarm Capability and a battery backup. The voice of the National Weather Service provides alerts concerning severe weather 24 hours a day.

You can also go to weather.gov on the internet and click on whichever state you are in for the latest watches, warnings, advisories and forecasts.

If you know that road closures may be a problem due to winter conditions or flooding, tornados, severe wind conditions, or road construction, go to the State Traffic and Road Closures on the internet to find out the condition of your planned route to a dance or other event.

REMEMBER: Never attempt to drive through flooded low water crossings or other waters on the roadways.

We want to see you across a square. So, travel safely and sanely.

Publications: Carol Morris reporting. Doin's staff is getting ready for the State Festival. Coffee will be provided by the hotel at \$25/per gal, paid by the donations at Sunday's Doin's Dance. Donuts will also be provided

DOIN'S Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. AGAIN, I can't tell you how important it is to use the club name as the subject of your emails. Nothing else is necessary. Anything else should be AFTER the club name.

It seems that everybody must be getting their magazine on time. We have only had one call since the big mess-up with the May/June issue. We love it when you get your magazine on time.

November 25 is a big deadline for 2020. Wow, it doesn't seem possible. These items are due:

There's a form to make your request on; please use it. Order EARLY. That form is available online or by requesting it from us. Please request your free copies to give out to your new dancers at graduations and make them aware of the magazine.

DOIN'S Circulation: Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. Subscriptions 304, 2 exchange copies and 17 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of 323. Electronic Doin's emailed 48.

We received 30 renewals, 8 new subscriptions and 0 copies went to new students. We will be sending out 6 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the Sept/Oct issue.

<u>Financial report</u>: The balance brought forward on June 2, 2019, was \$100.00 with a total income of \$555.00. Expense of postage and supplies amounted to \$3.15. A check for \$386.85 was given to the Federation and another check was mailed to Rosa in the amount of \$165.00. The ending balance as of Aug 17, 2019 is \$100.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reported. As of August 18, 2019, we have 1,184 dancers insured through Missouri Federation; 304 dancers insured through other federations; for a total of 1,488 Missouri dancers. (47 Missouri Clubs).

Markel/Bollinger Insurance company has created an online portal for clubs to sign in and complete your insurance forms. USDA Insurance internet portal http://usda.rpsbollinger.com/#/ This info is now on Missouri Federation website under insurance tab. You will also find a "how to" video on the new enrollment system. Thank you to those who have started using the system.

When I know the 2020 insurance premium, I will send each club a letter with instructions on how to complete their 2020 USDA insurance enrollment. DO NOTHING until you receive the 2020 enrollment instructions.

Clubs holding lessons: you MUST submit the club sponsored class form. There is no cost to cover new dancers in lessons. Once lessons are over, the dancers are no longer insured until they join a club. As new members join, make sure you submit additional enrollment forms.

Remember to complete an accident form for ALL accidents that occur at your dance, even if they appear minor at the time.

Financial Report: Beginning balance as of June 1, 2019, is \$95.60; total income of \$9.50 and expenses of \$9.30 leaves us an ending balance on August 17, 2019 of 95.80.
