# MISSOURI FEDERATION YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP Deadline: March 1

The Missouri Federation offers one \$500 scholarship to a deserving youth to attend any two or four year college, university, technical or trade school of their choice.

The recipient should be a graduating high school or home schooled senior residing in Missouri or an adjoining state. The applicant does not need to be a square dancer and can be a non-dancing relative of a square dancer.

### Call Ahead FIRST Before Traveling to a Dance.

Severe weather, e.g. snow, icy roads, and other winter weather events such as Flooding, Thunder Storms, Tornados or other concerns and issues may cause the club you plan to visit to cancel their dance at the last minute.

During these weather events, or if a weather event is forecast, call the club contact ahead of time to ensure that the dance you are planning to attend is either going to happen as scheduled, or has been cancelled. You can find a list of club contacts at the back of the Show-Me Doin's.

You can also tune in to your local weather forecasts on your radio, television, computer and smart phone apps before traveling, regardless of the reason of travel.

A very good investment is a NOAA Weather Radio. These can be purchased at almost any electronics store or department store. Be sure to buy one with the SAME Warning Alarm Capability and a battery backup. The voice of the National Weather Service provides alerts concerning severe weather 24 hours a day.

You can also go to weather.gov on the internet and click on whichever state you are in for the latest watches, warnings, advisories and forecasts.

If you know that road closures may be a problem due to winter conditions or flooding, tornados, severe wind conditions, or road construction, go to the State Traffic and Road Closures on the internet to find out the condition of your planned route to a dance or other event.

REMEMBER: Never attempt to drive through flooded low water crossings or other waters on the roadways.

We want to see you across a square. So, travel safely and sanely.

### THINGS I LEARN AS I GROW UP — Dave Shafer

My first experience at wearing a hat was when I was about 12 years old. I spent my summer on my grandparents farm and my grandfather took me to the general store in Aumsville, Oregon to buy me a hat. He didn't want me out working in the fields with him without a hat to protect my poor little head. I loved my hat, and still have it. With one exception, it was just like grandpa's. Maybe you have seen one, straw with a green visor across the front brim.

My next exposure to wearing a covering (military jargon) was when I joined the Army. We wore olive drab baseball caps, or service caps around the cantonment area. Otherwise it was the helmet liner and steel pot for twenty years. Starting in 1993, I started wearing hats with brims because I found that the sun was causing cancer cells to develop on top of my fair haired head. Baseball caps were a no-no, but I wore them too, for a while. Now it is hats and the wider the brim, the better.

Hats are designed to do many things. Their primary job is to protect the head from the sun, and this reduces the chances of getting cancer on the head, ears, neck, etc. They are also used to cover up "Bad hair days," while others claim they help them think (Thinking caps). Some people claim "Thinking caps" in different colors help them think in different ways, e.g. green for creativeness, black for emotions, red for seeing different perspectives, etc.

Then there are practical uses, such as using the military steel pot to heat water to wash up and shave in; heat or cook soup and stews, and carry water, etc. Hats can be used to signal someone from a distance; cover the face while sleeping; carry water; feed animals; shoo flies from the food and much more, such as hide my bald head. Hats not only protect my head from the sun, but act as an umbrella during rain and snow, and keeps my head warm during the winter and cool in the summer. Makes the wearer look younger too.

Of course, there are certain etiquette to follow, such as tipping a hat to a lady, when you meet a lady. Removing your hat in church, restaurants, at home, courtrooms and in theaters. And don't mess with or touch another person's hat. That hat is the wearer's pride and iov and means a lot to him.

Have you seen hats that have lost their shape because they are not stored properly? The brims hang down around the ears and over the face. To prevent this from happening, wad up a bath towel and push it up into the crown a ways. Leave some of the towel exposed below the hat and place it on a

- On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an emergency call for aid.





### Ray and Vicki Wittman, 2019 Square Dancers of the Year

Ray and Vicki's involvement in the world of square dancing began in the very early 1980's when they accepted an invitation to a beginners' square dance class which started them on the road to being named the Elmer Kruse Memorial Honored Dancers in 2002.

In their almost 40 years of square dancing, they have been members of the Wham Bams Club and later the Missouri Promenaders. Over the years, they have held a number of positions in the clubs as well as being angels at lessons.



It has been said of Ray: "Provide him with a piece of cardboard and some colored markers and he will create any sign or decoration needed for a special event." Ray & Vicki were the publicity chairmen for the 42nd National Square Dance Convention held in St. Louis in 1993.

They supported the St. Louis League of Clubs until 2008. They were also active in the Greater St. Louis Folk & Square Dance Federation until 2008. In 2008 the St. Louis Metro Federation was formed bringing the two previous organizations together; Ray was their first president.

They became involved with the Missouri State Federation working to make square dancing the official dance of the State of Missouri traveling throughout the state to promote this idea. They were in Jefferson City on August 28, 1995 to witness the Legislature passing the bill. They continue to be active on the state level.

Throughout their years of being involved in square dancing, it can be said that they have been true square dance ambassadors. It is with great pleasure that we recognize them as our 2019 Square Dancers of the Year.

### 2019 Caller / Cuer Hall of Fame Dennis Mineau St. Charles, Missouri

It is our great pleasure to announce the 2019 Inductee to the Missouri Federation of Square n' Round Dance Clubs Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame.



This year's inductee began dancing in the early sixties. With the help of other students in his beginning dance class, he began to secretly practice calling. After doing guest tips with local clubs, he was able to become a club caller when one of the local callers retired.

Our inductee's first club was the Morro Rockers in Morro Bay, California, followed by other clubs in California.







# Ray J. Wittman (January 3, 1932 - November 2, 2019)

Ray J. Wittman, the son of the late Emil and Anna Wittman, was born on January 3, 1932 in St. Louis, Missouri. His family moved to Los Angeles, California and eventually moved back to St. Louis when he was around 10 years old. Raymond received a GED during his duty as a St. Louis Police Officer and took college courses at Forest Park Community College. Ray served in the United States Marines until he was discharged in 1952, but remained in the Reserves until 1960.

On May 1st, 1954, Ray was united in marriage to Victoria "Vicki" Lammert at St. Ferdinand Church (now Old St. Ferdinand Shrine) in Florissant, Missouri. They shared more than 65 years of marriage together and many beautiful memories.

During his working years, Ray worked as a police officer in the St. Louis Police Department for 31 years, retiring in 1982. He was further employed as a Security Advisor to McDonnell-Douglas from 1982 to 1996.

Ray was also an artist. He painted murals on walls in his home and drew a great number of drawings for square dance events. His drawings ranged from 8' x 6' to a standard size poster board.

Since the early 1980's, after completing lessons, Ray's spare time was devoted to being an avid square dancer, first dancing with the Wham Bams and then the Missouri Promenaders. He and Vicki served as Presidents of the Wham Bams for five years and in other offices and positions at the club, district, and State levels, and as the Publicity Chairman for the 42nd National Square Dance Convention held in St. Louis in 1993. Ray and Vicki were the St. Louis District Representative for more than 25 years. He thoroughly enjoyed being an angel to new dancers. Ray and Vicki were instrumental in the merging of the Greater St. Louis Folk & Square Dance Federation and the St. Louis League of Clubs in 2008 and served as the first President of the new St. Louis Metro Federation. They were chairman of the 2003 St. Louis Jamboree and Chairman of two Missouri State Federation Festivals.

His and Vicki's devotion to square dancing earned them honors such as being named the "Elmer Kruse Memorial Honored Dancers" in 2002 and being named "Square Dancers of the Year" in 2019 by the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs, Inc.

Ray was highly involved in the movement to make Square Dancing the official dance of the State of Missouri, often traveling throughout the state to promote this idea. He was present when the Missouri State Legislature passed the bill on August 28, 1995.

Ray passed away on Saturday, November 2, 2019 in his home surrounded by loved ones in St. Louis having attained the age of 87 years.

Ray leaves to cherish his memory, his wife Victoria, two children Karen Beck and Jeffry Wittman; three grandchildren, Matthew, Barbara and Christopher and other relatives and friends. Visitation was held on Tuesday, November 5 at Hutchens Mortuary in Florissant, and services were conducted in St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church on November 6, 2019.

He will be sadly missed but fondly loved and remembered by his family and those who knew him.

We will miss you across the squares Ray.



President Bev Stuart thanked the hosts, SW District for a wonderful 60th Missouri Federation dance and for a great luncheon.

**Approval of Minutes**: President Bev Stuart asked for corrections or additions to the August minutes. Dave Shafer moved to accept the minutes as corrected. Motion was seconded and carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Rosa Davis reported a beginning checking balance as of July 31, 2019 of \$2,542.52. Since the last meeting we've had Revenue of \$2,072.03 and Expenses of \$2,369.92. The ending checking account balance as of September 30, 2019 is \$2,244.63. Total CDs and interest amounted to \$50,714.17 for Total Funds on hand of \$52,958.81. The Treasurer's report will be submitted for audit.

**Membership and Club Longevity**: Rosa Davis reported we have no more longevity awards for 2019. There are 6 for 2020. There are 47 clubs in the Missouri Federation. Two districts have paid their dues.

**Correspondence**: Penny Byers reporting. Cards that were signed and sent out were: Get Well: Ray Wittman; Thinking of You: Mary Pitts (c/o Frances Casteel) and John Stover; and Thank You to Sharon White.

**Boundaries and Relations**: Dave Byers reporting. No Report. Thank you for all the hard work combining St. Louis District and St. Louis Metro.

**Constitution and Bylaws**: Fred & Carolyn Goucher. Corrections to the Constituation/ByLaws and Standing Rules have all been made (a big thank you to Edythe Weber). Changes will be discussed under new business.

**Publications**: Carol Morris reporting. The annual Doin's dance on Sunday morning had 165 dancers and 17 callers in attendance. \$692 was donated at the door. Coffee was \$100 and doughnuts were \$47.76. A check for \$544.24 was given to Rosa.

**DOIN'S Editor:** Edythe Weber reporting.

November 25 is a big deadline for Jan/Feb 2020 issue. These items are due:

Please request your free copies to give out to your new dancers at graduations and make them aware of the magazine.

**DOIN'S Circulation**: Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. Subscriptions 290, 1 exchange copy and 15 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of 306. Electronic Doin's emailed 50.

We received 11 renewals, 2 new subscriptions and 0 copies went to new students. We will be sending out 50 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the Nov/Dec issue.

<u>Financial report</u>: The balance brought forward on Aug 18, 2019, was \$265.00 with a total income of \$195.00. Expenses were \$16.25 and a check that was mailed to Rosa in the amount of \$165 for the Federation. A check for \$178.75 was given to the Federation at this meeting. The ending balance as of October 19, 2019 is \$100.

**DOIN'S Advertising**: Dave Shafer reporting. The balance brought forward on Aug 18, 2019 was \$100.00. Total income (from DOIN'S Ads & Caller/Cuer Directory Listings) was \$556.00 and total expense for postage was \$7.35. A check for \$548.65 was given to the Federation. The ending balance on Oct 20, 2019, is \$100.00

Advertisers: 4 clubs from Central District; 1 club from NE District; 5 clubs from NW District; 1 district, 1 club and 1 caller from St. Louis District; 0 from SE and

WC Districts and 1 club from SW District. Caller/Cuer Ad's – 3 new listings and all but 1 renewal. And 1 new caller free advertising for a year.

**Promotions and Advertising**: Jack & Becky Rockaway. Had a request from a club for reimbursement for holding lessons, but club didn't provide any receipts. Jack will request receipts from them.

**State Festival Site Screening**: Jack & Becky Rockaway. Dave Shafer suggested going back to Lebanon for 2021 State Festival, but will have to move to the second weekend.

**Insurance Coordinator**: Jim Weber reporting. We had 47 attend the insurance seminar (27 clubs represented). The deadline to have your insurance completed has been extended from November 1 to December 1. Insurance only, dues are still due by Nov 1 for the rebate.

As of October 19, 2019, we have 1,192 dancers insured through Missouri Federation; 304 dancers insured through other federations; for a total of 1,496 Missouri dancers. (47 Missouri Clubs).

Markel/Bollinger Insurance company has created an online portal for clubs to sign in and complete your insurance forms. USDA Insurance internet portal http://usda.rpsbollinger.com/#/ This info is now on Missouri Federation website under insurance tab. You will also find a "how to" video on the new enrollment system. Thank you to those who have started using the system.

The 2020 Insurance premium is now \$4.85 per dancer. (it went up \$0.10 cents). When the 2020 USDA Insurance Portal is ready for 2020 enrollment, I will send each club an email with instructions on how to complete their 2020 USDA insurance enrollment.

Do nothing until you receive the 2020 enrollment instructions.

Clubs holding lessons: you MUST submit the club sponsored class form. There is no cost to cover new dancers in lessons. Once lessons are over, the dancers are no longer insured until they join a club. As new members join, make sure you submit additional enrollment forms.

Remember to complete an accident form for ALL accidents that occur at your dance, even if they appear minor at the time.


