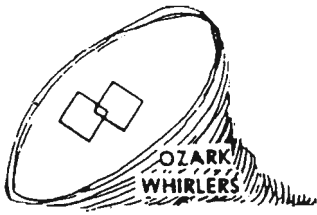

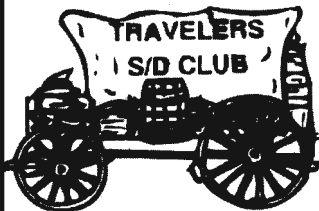

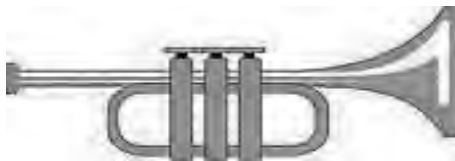

**EMERGENCY CALL FOR  
MEDICAL AID**

1. When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/her.
2. Remaining dancers join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
3. Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arch.
4. On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an emergency call for aid.

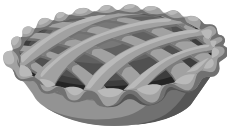

## HISTORY OF THE HOEDOWNERS SQUARE DANCE CLUB



When most people think of getting active or exercising, they picture gyms, healthy clubs, bicycles, or pools. However, if one ventured in the Roundhouse in Wood River last Saturday, they would have seen a lot more laughs than any gym could boast. The Hoedowners Square Dance Club in Wood River is a long-standing, excited group of seniors who enjoy a regular schedule of music, socialization, healthy activity, and fun. Most of us haven't completed a do-si-do since a grade school gym class, but these square dancers encourage you to visit them and consider a social activity that is almost too much fun to be healthy!

Celebrating their 70th anniversary in 2019, the Hoedowners Square Dance Club of Wood River is the oldest square dance club in Illinois. In 1947, Ring and Marjorie Ringering attended a Boy Scout event featuring a program on square dancing, and their feet started tapping. They learned how to dance and call, and soon started teaching classes in their apartment, and by 1949 they had formed "Ring's Hoedowners Club." The name eventually was changed to the "Hoedowners Square Dance Club", and the organization boasts a long and varied history.

One member reminisced that in the 1950's, the group met on Sunday afternoons in a local church with a television in the adjoining room. Their kids could watch television while the parents danced away the afternoon. Other members remember when they traded babysitting with other dancers so everyone could occasionally enjoy a night away.

In the post-WWII era, the club thrived as many towns in the metro-east had similar square dance groups. Back then, members could attend dances almost every night of the week, but over the years, most groups merged or folded. The Hoedowners, however, continued to thrive.

Today, the group is part of the St. Louis Metro Square and Round Dance Association, a group of nine clubs in the St. Louis metro area. Each club has scheduled dances, usually twice a month, and they strive to schedule the dances so they don't conflict with other groups. Members can visit various chapters and dance almost as often as they wish.

Ruth Leech joined the Hoedowners ten years ago – she had attended a 50th wedding anniversary party featuring square dancing as entertainment; she thought it looked like fun, so she came back and joined in the new dancer training of the Hoedowners and Dandy Dancers since she wanted to learn as quickly as possible. She was able to dance at the national convention in Louisville, Kentucky the following spring with the 50th wedding anniversary couple. Another member, Henry Kallal, agreed to his first dance, just to pacify

a neighbor who kept inviting him to visit. He told his wife, “We are going to have to go at least once; we’ll get there, say we didn’t like it, and go home.” However, he found that “the people were the nicest you ever want to meet and we loved it.” He and his late wife were members for ten years! Henry is now co-president of the club.

Current co-president, Pat Vogel, said she was going through a divorce and was lonely when someone invited her to square dance. She said, “I never laughed so much in my life,” and has continued attending for 13 years!

The most veteran dancers, though, are Agnes and Bo Semith, who have been part of the group for 48 years. Bo has been calling dances for 50 years! “We were PE majors in college and we had to take activity electives. We met in a square dance class and we’ve been dancing ever since.”

Agnes told us that she started with lessons, as did most of the group, but today’s lessons are a little more relaxed. Ring Ringering, the founder, originally taught lessons at his home in the late 1940’s. It was very crowded, and he carefully structured the dance education. Men were taught to promenade with their shoulders touching, and taught dancers to slide their feet, not pick them up. He didn’t allow any dancers to join the cub dances until they were deemed “ready.”

Today, the club offers lessons, taught by Agnes and Bo, both for beginners and advanced students. The beginner classes start in the fall, usually September, and last through the school year, or until the dancer graduates. By the next fall, the new dancers have learned enough to participate in the regular dances, but can polish their skills with Tuesday evening classes and workshops around the area. The club hosts a dance two Saturday nights a month. Current co-president, Pat Vogel, says “Learning to square dance is a commitment because lessons are every week and they build on each other, so a person can’t come one week, be gone for three, and return. So much is taught. . . but it’s fun because of the music, the laughter, and the friendships.”

The music of today’s square dance isn’t what most of us would expect, either. The Hoedowners often feature songs classified as oldies, country and western, modern, spiritual – even Lady Gaga was heard on a recent evening. One member said, “If it’s a really popular song, someone has probably written a square dance routine to it.”

Whether one is interested in the social connections, the physical activity, or just loves good music, square dancing is alive and well

in the metro area. Over and over, the members continually shared the same idea – “Come have a good time with us. Square dancing is good for the mind, soul, and body.”

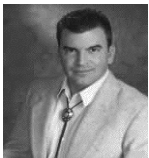

Minutes of April 19, 2020

Presidents Fred and Carolyn Goucher called the meeting to order at 12:11p.m. via FreeConferenceCall.com.

**Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag:** Fred Goucher

**Pledge of Allegiance to the Missouri Flag:** Fred Goucher

**Invocation:** Dave Byers gave the invocation

Fred thanked Liz Rooks for her efforts in helping get the meeting set-up and information out.

**Roll Call:** Liz Rooks. Full Quorum achieved. (7 Exec. Comm, 14 Dist Dir / 11 Staff/PP)

**Approval of Minutes:** President Goucher asked for corrections or additions to the February 16, 2020 minutes. There was one correction needed in line 112 regarding the total income on the Insurance Report; the correct figure should be \$505.90.

Edythe Weber moved to accept the minutes as corrected. Motion was seconded and carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Rosa Davis reported a beginning checking balance as of January 31, 2020 of \$1,220.17. Since the last meeting we have had Revenue of \$10,094.81 from redemption of Security Bank CD #...4622 and \$1,994.96 in regular deposits and Expenses of \$526.14. The ending checking account balance as of March 31, 2020 is \$12,783.80. Total CDs and interest amounted to \$40,724.16 for Total Funds on hand of \$53,507.96. A CD with Academy Bank with a February 14, 2020 maturity date has been renewed through 2022. The Treasurer's report will be submitted for audit.

**Membership and Club Longevity:** Rosa Davis reported we have 46 clubs this year.

Longevity awards will be awarded to Twirl-A-Rounds (SW District) for 35 years since May 1985 and Crosstrailers (NW District) for 70 years since May 1950 the next time we are able to gather in person.

It was announced at our last meeting that the Hoedowners club is the oldest club in the MO Federation with 71 years. Rosa discovered later that Western Twirlers in the SW District will be celebrating 72 years this year.

**Correspondence:** Liz Rooks reporting. No correspondence has been received that needs to be shared. A sympathy card will be sent to the family of Larry Butler.

**Boundaries and Relations:** Dave Byers, chairman, shared the letter the committee plans to send to all clubs sharing information about the need to reorganize the districts and asking for their thoughts, opinions, questions, etc. He hopes to have some feedback to bring back to our next meeting.

**Constitution and Bylaws:** Dave Shafer. The recommended change for Standing Rule Article V, Section 2E should not have been a part of this report as it was approved at our February meeting.

Discussion and approval of Article X Appointive Committee, Section 4 Standing Committees, Letter F State Festival Site Screening Committee will be taken up under Old Business.

Changes are needed to the Constitution, Article 5, Section 2D for the treasurer; those will be worked for possible presentation at the next meeting.

Also, the committee has been asked to look at the Standing Rules Article 3 Board of Directors' Meetings, Section 1 regarding the number of meetings per year.

**Publications:** Carol Morris. No report.

**DOIN'S Editor:** Edythe Weber thanked all club writers for getting their articles in taking into account the uncertainty surrounding if dances and activities would actually be able to take place in light of the Covid-19 situation. The following statement was put before each district's article: "Due to the coronavirus situation, please consult the Federation website and/or call the club contact listed in the Club Directory of the Doin's to find out if the club is dancing or not. Stay safe, stay well, this too shall pass, and we will be back on the dance floor soon."

**DOIN'S Circulation:** Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. Subscriptions for the DOIN'S this month were 290, 1 exchange copy and 14 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of 305. We had 59 electronic subscriptions, 19 renewals 6 new subscriptions and 27 copies went to new students. We will be sending out 29 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the May/June issue.

Financial report: The balance brought forward was \$100 with a total income of \$375.00 from subscriptions & DOIN'S dance callers). Expense of postage amounted to \$16.77 and papercard supplies for \$19.09 A check for \$339.14 was given to the Federation. The ending balance is \$100.

**DOIN's Advertising:** Dave Shafer reporting. We had a balance brought forward of \$100. We took in revenue from DOIN'S ads and caller/cuer listings of \$368.00, Expenses totaled \$7.75. A check was sent to the Federation for \$360.25, leaving us a balance of \$100.

Some of our yearly advertisers have not renewed for this year due to the Covid-19 situation.

**State Festival Site Screening:** Jack & Becky Rockaway submitted the following Toot Your Horn Report: Cross Trailers 2 years, Live Wires 1st Time Award, and Silver Dollars 3 years.

**Insurance Coordinator:** Edythe reported for Jim Weber. 1,095 dancers are insured through Missouri Federation and 357 dancers insured through other federations for a total of 1,452 Missouri dancers in 46 clubs.

When a club has a new insurance contact, let Jim know their name, address, phone and e-mail so he can contact them with instructions on how to use the enrollment portal.

The 2020 Insurance premium is \$4.85 per dancer.

Clubs holding lessons must submit a Club Sponsored Class form which is found on the Missouri website under the insurance tab. There is not cost to cover new dancers in lessons.

Once new dancers graduate they are no longer insured until they join a club and pay the insurance premium and the club adds them to their online roster via the insurance portal and submits the new roster with insurance fees.

As new members join your club, make sure to add them through the insurance portal. They are not insured until you enroll them through the USDA portal and new roster and funds have been received by the Insurance Chairman.

Remember to complete an accident report form for ALL accidents that occur at your dance, even if they appear minor at the time. It is hard to remember the who, what, when, where, and how weeks later; documentation at the time is best. Keep the report on file and submit as needed.

Financial Report: Beginning balance as of Feb 16, 2020, is \$286.40; total income of \$33.95 and expenses of \$90.25 leaves us an ending balance on April 8, 2020, of \$230.10.

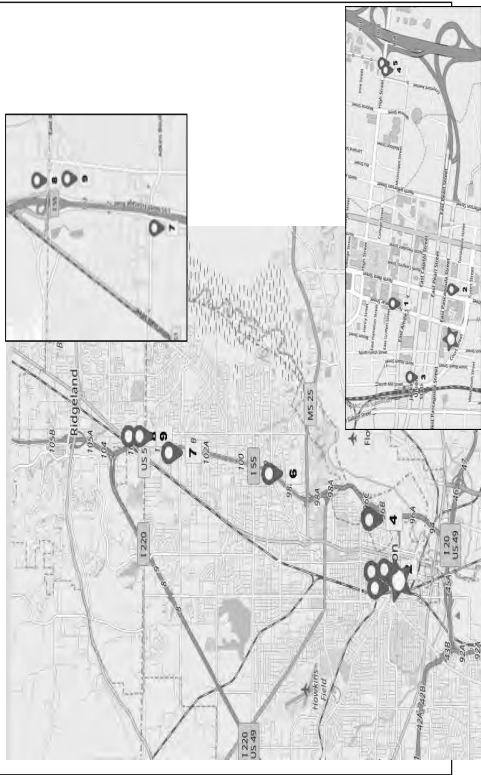
