Editors' Notes



Due to the cancellation of the State Festival in October, some ads were changed. Text in articles sent was not changed, so please just disregard.

Important upcoming deadline – November 25.
These items are due:

1. Clubs dancing September 2020 to August 2021 should have already provided a list of dance dates with callers, themes, locations, etc. for your club. We understand how hard this is going to be right now, but please try to give us the best info you can. If you are able to hold your dance(s), wonderful. If you are not, we can cancel. But I need the dates before I can do anything.
2. ALL clubs should provide updated location listing for the pull-out section in the Jan/Feb 2021 issue. All locations, even temporary ones, should be listed.
3. Clubs dancing January-December dance year need to provide a full year schedule for 2021 to us. ALL Clubs – ALL dates. Don't assume we know. If you have a date that you haven't confirmed a caller yet, put TBD (to be determined). If you haven't updated it by the time it rolls around, we will contact you if we have questions.
4. Make sure the club contact in the directory is a current dancer who knows what is going on. A cell phone is best, but we understand if you don't want to share a cell number. But if someone calls while you are at the dance, who's going to answer that home phone number?

Also, as lessons begin, don't forget we provide one issue for each new dancer (single/couple) for your graduation. What a better way to let them know how and where to get out and dance! There's a form to make your request on; please use it. Order EARLY. That form is available online or by requesting it from us. Please request your free copies to give out to your new dancers at graduations and make them aware of the magazine.

Answers to Your Covid-19 Insurance Questions

The USDA Insurance is two parts: Part 1 is liability insurance which covers your club and your dance location. Part 2 is individual accidental medical insurance (*accidental* being the operative word).

1. Will our insurance cover dancers who have contracted the COVID-19 virus?
No. Our insurance is for medical benefits associated with an accident at any regularly scheduled and sponsored activity. The USDA insurance has never covered any type of virus.
2. If our state, county or city has said no public gatherings will our insurance cover our dances?
No. If your state, county or city says no public gatherings, and your club meets, then the law has been broken and there is no coverage. If your state, county or city is opened up for public gatherings and allowing groups to gather, and the clubs are following CDC and local guidelines, then your club would be covered.
3. If someone sues?
When a dancer sues the club and/or club officers, that dancer will have to complete a claim. The claim will be submitted to the insurance company. The insurance company will then be in charge of the claim. NO LONGER will the club have any involvement with the lawsuit. The insurance company and their team of lawyers will handle it. DO NOT consult a lawyer on your own, it voids the liability insurance.
4. Are visitors insured?
Yes and No. If the visitor is a member of another club which is a member of the USDA Insurance program the answer is Yes. If the visitor is not a member of any club or is a member of a club that does not participate in the USDA Insurance program the answer is No. The club should still complete an accident form and keep it on file.
5. Are Students covered by our insurance?
Students are covered for nine months of instruction. After nine (9) months they are no longer insured. When they join the club the insurance fee must be submitted to your insurance chairperson. The rate is not prorated. If they join in December then they still pay the full amount.
NOTE: Due to the COVID-19 virus the insurance company will acknowledge that there is a break in the 9-month instruction period. The total combined number of weeks of instruction should not exceed 9 months.

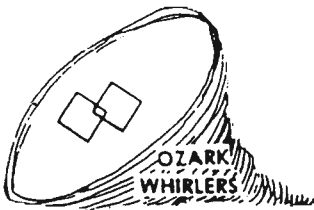

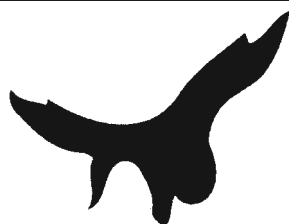

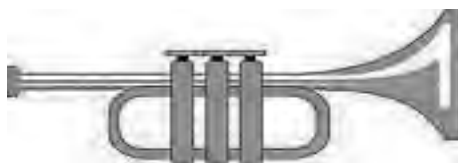

**EMERGENCY CALL FOR
MEDICAL AID**

1. When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/her.
2. Remaining dancers join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
3. Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arch.
4. On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an emergency call for aid.

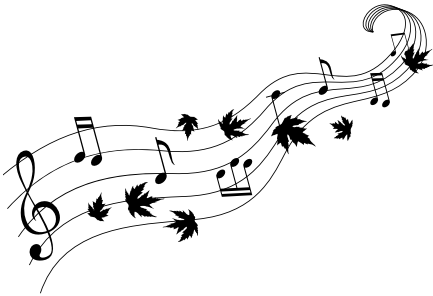

HISTORY OF THE WESTERN TWIRLERS SQUARE DANCE CLUB

Western Twirlers Square Dance Club was established in 1948 in Joplin Missouri. The club belonged to the Tri State Square Dancing Association & Northeast Oklahoma Square Dance Association before Missouri Federation was established in 1959. The club danced at several locations in Joplin before building the Joplin Square Dance Center in the early 80's for all the area clubs to dance at. In 1982 they formed a Board to help work on finding property and raising necessary funds. They purchased land December 6, 1983 for \$2,700. In 1985 construction started. The cost was \$30,000.00 for 100 Ft X 50 Ft. building. Due to the tremendous support of this area, a lot of past dancers volunteered their time to help build this building. A lot of benefits were also held, particularly the memory board. For a small fee, dancers could have their names engraved into it. This board is behind the caller stand in great appreciation of our past. A Grand Opening dance was held on August 8, 1986, with area callers for an afternoon dance and Virgil Gemeinhart, from Springfield, for the main evening dance. The building was built with a concrete floor with tile to dance on. In 1997 a new wood floor was added with a cost of \$25,000. This building can hold 12 squares on the floor comfortably, along with a Caller Stage, full kitchen, large bathrooms, and tables for socializing.



Past Club callers have been Floyd Sill, who called 25 plus years retiring in 1987. Van Greenwood then became Club Caller from 1988 thru 2010. Van called for more than 60 plus years in the four-state area. He and Elfrieda remained members until Van's passing in 2018. Van & Elfrieda always set at the 1st table to greet everyone. Van & Elfrieda, in later years, were members of the Center's Board and Elfrieda still remains, and is still dancing with us today. Also original Board members and present Presidents of the Board are Wayne & Doris Donham. They have danced since 1978. Sadly we lost Wayne in the past year. Wayne & Doris have maintained and cleaned every inch of this building. Wayne will always be there to sweep the floor during the last tip. Van Greenwood's voice will always be heard in this building by us present members.

Western Twirlers has been thru many changes and challenges thru these years. They have changed from dancing every Saturday night to 1st, 3rd & 5th Saturday's, then to 1st & 3rd Saturdays. In 2011 we changed to once a month.

On November 9-10, 1963 the 3rd Annual Missouri Federation Festival was held in Joplin at the famous Connor Hotel (built in 1906 with a grand staircase made of marble) at 4th & Main, and Saturday's evening dance was held at R & S Stadium at 3rd & Virginia. Club caller was Floyd Sill, State Presidents were Ray & Georganna McCulley. This was also the 1st year for the souvenir program books. The dance had live music and included round dancing. In 1967 Western Twirlers Presidents were Conrad & Joyce Butler, club dues to Missouri Federation was \$1.00. In 1968 the State Festival was held again in Joplin at the Memorial Hall. In 1970 John & Karen Eubanks became Secretary of Southwest District Square Dance Association. In 1971 they became Vice President of Southwest District. John Eubanks became a caller about the same time and became Western Twirlers Club caller in 2019. In 1982 Southwest District had 44 clubs. In 1983 Club dues were \$ 3.00, Show-Me Doin's magazine was \$5.00. Missouri ranked 6th in the world in Square Dance Clubs. In 1984 the State Festival had 1,260 registered dancers, making that year the biggest Festival so far. In 1995 membership in Missouri consisted of 132 clubs and the State Festival had 900 dancers. Missouri Governor Mel Carnahan signed a bill to make Square Dancing the Official American Folk Dance of Missouri. (Currently 31 states have designated Square Dancing as their State Folk Dance.) In 1998, the State Festival was held in Joplin at the High School with the theme "Bee at State in '98". State Presidents were Mark & Rosalee Mortensen of Richland. Also the state license plate bill was passed, but the Governor vetoed the bill. (However the State License plate bill did pass in 1999.) The 1998 Festival's Saturday night's After Party was held at the Square Dance Center hosted by local clubs. The After party started at 11:00pm till ??? to a packed building!! (Remember we danced on a nearly new wood floor!) In 2005 Club Caller Van Greenwood received the Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame award. In 2010 a Facebook page was set up along with an email address for extra contact information as we move into the Internet world. On May 22, 2011 an F5 Tornado tore thru Joplin's middle section. The Center was not harmed even though several past and present dancers lost their homes. 2019 Southwest District hosted the MO State Festival in Springfield for its 60th anniversary. Club caller was John Eubanks and State Presidents were John & Bev Stuart.

This club and building has hosted many benefit dances, too many to count. Many thanks to those who have passed that started this club, building, and who have been members. Thank you to the original board members of Jerry & Scarlet Upton, Bill & Mary Watson, Cecil & Betty Clevenger, and Wayne & Doris Donham, the Tri State Square Dance Association (that no longer exists) Northeast Oklahoma Square Dance Association, Southwest District, and Missouri Federation of Square & Round Dance Clubs. Thru these 72 years we have gone from a very large club to a small size club. We are still there to socialize with each other, past and future dances. Now in 2020 we have Covid-19 giving us even bigger challenges, since we have not been able to dance in three months. What will the future hold for us now?

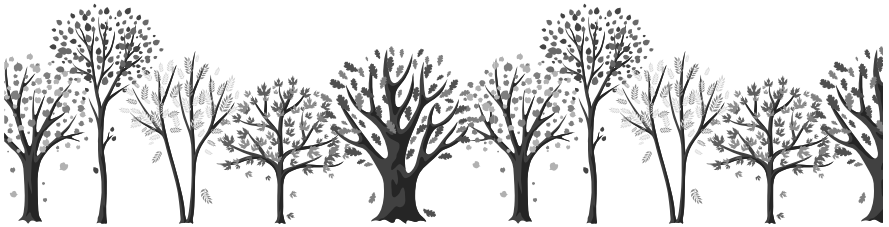

Dave Shafer moved to accept the minutes as corrected; motion was seconded and carried.

Treasurer's Report: Rosa Davis reported a beginning checking balance as of March 31, 2020 of \$12,783.80. Since the last meeting, Revenue of \$743.94 and Expenses of \$3,805.40. The ending checking account balance as of May 31, 2020 is \$9,722.34. Total CDs and interest amounted to \$40,714.16 for Total Funds on hand of \$50,446.50. The Treasurer's report will be submitted for audit.

Rosa presented an updated Request for Reimbursement form.

Membership and Club Longevity: Rosa Davis reported we have 46 clubs this year. A longevity award will be presented to River City Squares in Lexington for 30 years as of July.

Boundaries and Relations: Dave Byers, chairman, presented two options for realignment of our square dance districts. Option #1 for 4 districts: North 8 clubs and 245 dancers, Kansas City 12 clubs and 410 dancers, South 17 clubs and 381 dancers, and St. Louis 9 clubs and 416 dancers.

She reminded us one that once an issue is printed and schedules change that issue can't be reprinted and resending the electronic version when changes are made is not possible either. Therefore, if you are planning to attend a dance, it is best to check with the club contact.

She also reminded everyone that Dan can easily put "Cancelled" by a club dance.

DOIN'S Circulation: Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. Subscriptions for the DOIN'S this month were 281, exchange copies 1, and 14 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of 296. We had 60 electronic subscriptions, 7 renewals 2 new subscriptions. We will be sending out 11 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the July/August issue.

Financial report: The balance brought forward was \$100 with a total income of \$135.00 from subscriptions. Expense of postage amounted to \$10.49. A check for \$124.51 was given to the Federation. The ending balance is \$100.

DOIN's Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. We had a balance brought forward of \$100. Revenue from DOIN'S ads and caller/cuer listings of \$-170.00; Expenses totaled \$7.75. A check for \$162.25 was mailed to the treasurer leaving a balance of \$100. He reminded that when sending a check for advertising to identify what advertisement it is for.

Promotions and Advertising: Jack & Becky Rockaway. No report.

State Festival Site Screening: Dave & Penny Byers. No report.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. 1,095 dancers are insured through Missouri Federation and 357 dancers insured through other federations for a total of 1,452 Missouri dancers in 46 clubs.

He asked for clubs to let him know when they have a new insurance contact person by sending him their name, address, phone, and e-mail so he can contact them with instructions for how to use the new enrollment portal. He also needs to be notified with when a club adds a dancer or dance facility; also never delete a dancer from the club roster after initial enrollment.

The 2020 insurance premium is \$4.85 per dancer.

Clubs holding lessons must submit a Club Sponsored Class form found on the Federation website; this is not done through the portal. New graduate dancers are not

covered until they join a club and pay the premium and the club adds them to their online roster via the portal and submits the new roster with appropriate fees.

New club members need to be added to your roster using the portal; they are not covered until they are enrolled through the new USDA portal and the new roster and funds are sent to the insurance chairman.

An accident form for ALL accidents that occur at a dance, even if it appears minor, needs to be completed and kept on file to submit if needed.

Financial Report: Beginning balance as of April 9, 2020, is \$230.20; total income of \$58.20 and expenses of \$25.15 leaving an ending balance on June 1, 2020, of \$263.15.

Travel Missouri: Jim Marron reporting. No change since last report.

Blue Bird Coordinator: Madeline Hall. No report.

Webmaster: Dan Wheeler reporting: Website hits were down in May. There are dances starting in June. It is more important than ever that clubs keep me informed about dances that will happen, and dances that are cancelled. One club, that has a hall population limit, keeps me informed when the dance for that night is full. I have added the Square Dancer of the Year criteria and Nomination form and the Caller / Cuer Registration-Profile to the 2020 State Festival website.

Historian: Dan Wheeler reporting. No report.

License Plate: Catherine McLemore reporting. There has been one request for a one-year renewal. The \$25 check has been deposited and a \$10 rebate check sent. The current account balance is \$83.36.

She reported she is looking forward to more renewals in the next two months as that is when most renewals are due and hopefully receiving several new plate requests.

USDA: Edythe and Jim Weber reporting. The United Square Dancers of America annual meeting will held via Zoom computer or phone on Saturday, June 20. Those involved in the meeting will receive an e-mail with the Zoom meeting sign-in information.

USDA is now a 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Group Exemption Administrator.

Missouri is in the process of filing for the USDA 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Group Exemption. At the present time only USDA Affiliates may apply for the USDA 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Group Exemption.

At the upcoming USDA meeting June 20th the USDA Executive Committee is asking the USDA Board of Directors to approve a bylaws and standing rules change to add a membership of Associate Membership. This will allow Districts and Clubs to become members of USDA and to apply for the USDA 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Group Exemption.

ARTS: Edythe Weber reporting. The ARTS annual meeting will held via Zoom on Sunday, June 21. Those involved in the meeting will receive an e-mail with the Zoom meeting sign-in information. Anyone wanting to be included in the ARTS meeting info should send a message to Jerry Reed, ARTS Executive Director, at director@arts-dance.org.

Youth and Children's Dance: Merle Hall. All youth activities have been put on hold because of Covid-19. It is doubtful any resume in time to be ready for the State Fair dance. As of now, they are still not allowed to resume by the 4-H Council.

Mo Fed Scholarship: Bob & Shirley Turner. The 2020-2021 Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs scholarship recipient is Brianna Butler of Eureka, Missouri. She is the daughter of Brian and Jana Butler and the granddaughter of Billie Jean Butler and the late Larry Butler.

2020 State Festival: Liz Rooks. Plans continue to be made for the 2020 State Festival. August 1, 2020 is the deadline for submitting nominations for the Caller-Cuer Hall of Fame to John & Bev Stuart and Square Dancer of the Year to Liz Rooks. Each club should and district president should have received the appropriate forms and criteria for these nominations. They are also posted on the Festival Website. Also on the Festival website is the Caller-Cuer Registration form. While the June 1 deadline has passed for signing up to call or cue on the regular schedule, callers or cuers who have not signed up yet can do so and will be placed on a back-up list to be used if a regularly scheduled caller or cuer is unable to fill an assigned slot.

Old Business:

Billie Jean Butler reminded everyone of the July 1 deadline to order tickets and or parking passes for the State Fair Day of Dance. She also explained that as of Friday, June 5 the governor has not made a decision on whether or not to hold the Fair; that decision is to be made by June 15.

Liz Rooks explained the purpose of the \$550.00 is for the State Fair Souvenir booklet and the daily schedule to promote square dancing from the standpoint of letting the public know how they can find information regarding square dancing in their local area or what is happening across the state.

New Business:

Dave Byers, Boundary and Relations Committee Chairman, shared the following questions or comments that were a part of the feedback in the responses received regarding the two redistricting options.

How would the number of delegates for each district be determined: a) each district has 3 delegates - our current way of the president and 2 delegates; or b) the number of delegates per district is dependent on the number of clubs per district (this might mean each district would have a different number of delegates)

Does there need to be a minimum number of clubs that would constitute a district?

Dave Shafer brought the following change to the Working Rules, Article XIII Officer Memorials up for a vote.

AS READS:

**Article XIII: Officer Memorials
Section 1.**

A suitable floral arrangement will be sent upon the death of a current elected officer of

the federation as defined in Article V, Section 1 of the Constitution and Bylaws.

Section 2.

Also included as recipients of floral arrangements upon death will be the past presidents.

Section 3.

A suitable floral arrangement or monetary donation to a charitable organization will be sent upon notification of death of a state caller or cuer.

Section 4.

Floral arrangements and/or donations will be of a reasonable amount not to exceed \$75.00 per memorial.

CHANGE TO READ:

Article XIII: Officer Memorials

Section 1.

A suitable floral arrangement or monetary donation to a charitable organization will be sent upon notification of the death of a current elected officer of the federation as defined in Article V, Section 1 of the Constitution and Bylaws.

Section 2.

Floral arrangements or monetary donations to a charitable organization will be sent upon notification of the death of past presidents and state callers and cuers.

Section 3.

Floral arrangements and/or donations will not exceed \$75.00 per memorial.

Recommendation came from the committee, no second needed. Motion was voted on and carried to make the changes.

Dave Shafer reported he has also been working on updating the job descriptions for officers and committees. To date he has completed 13 and is working on the others.

Dave Shafer on behalf of the Central District which is hosting the 2021 Missouri State Festival, asked for their start-up money in the amount of \$2,500. Motion was seconded and passed.

Calendar of Events

Dave Shafer reported the Travelers' Club in Pulaski County has received approval to resume dancing.

The July campout in the Northeast District is still planned.

The West Central District Dance, Aug 9 in Chillicothe is still planned.

Dan Wheeler reported the obituary for Jerry Haag, square dance caller from Cheyenne, Wyoming was on the website.

The next state board meeting will be August 16 either in the St. Louis or Northeast District. Decision of meeting location will be announced closer to time.

A motion to adjourn was made by Madeline Hall, was seconded, and carried. Meeting adjourned at 1:23 p.m.
