

We were happy to see a good turnout from area dancers at the Nationals in Mississippi. It was great to re-connect with dancers from all around.



To: All Missouri Federation Member Clubs

We are reaching out to the Missouri Federation Clubs to let you know due to basically 2 years of no income the Federation feels we have reached the point we need roll back some of our expenses. Therefore, we are temporarily putting some programs on hold and cutting out others we may be able to do without. We feel the Federation is important to maintain as it brings all the clubs together with one voice in the state and the nation.

The way this will most directly affect your club will be temporary suspension of reimbursement for lessons and advertising. Also, it may affect the amount of insurance rebate your club receives. We will know more for sure when we get the 2022 budget completed.

Just some thoughts of ways to handle this... if clubs can get their caller to donate a night of calling, promote this dance as a "lesson cost benefit dance" then use the funds from this dance to help pay your caller and venue for lessons. As a part of that, try your best to attend the "benefit dance" of your club and surrounding club dances.

If you need promotional materials like flyers, signs, etc., reach out to someone on the board. Others might have some things they can share.

Lastly, it is very important to promote and attend the Missouri Federation State Festival this year and encourage other dancers you haven't seen in a while to register and attend as well. This is the primary income for the Missouri Federation.



- Remaining dancers join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.

DOIN'S Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. We have reduced the "Covid-19" disclaimer at the beginning of each district.

I am working on the September/October magazine. So far, and it's early yet, I have 4 articles. The deadline is July 25. We will see how many I get next week and how many I need to send a note.

If dances are cancelled, be sure to let Dan Wheeler know for the web version of the Dance Calendar. His website calendar is the most up-to-date.

DOIN'S Circulation: Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. Subscriptions for the DOIN'S this month were 222, exchange copies 1, and 14 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of238. We had 48 electronic subscriptions, 14 renewals 7 new subscriptions and no new student copies. We will be sending out 11 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the September/October issue.

Financial report: The balance brought forward was \$100 with a total income of \$315.00 from subscriptions & DOIN'S dance callers. Expense of postage amounted to \$3.60 and Other \$129.99. A check for \$133.69 was given to the Federation. The ending balance is \$100.00.

DOIN's Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. We had a balance brought forward of \$100.00. We took in revenue from DOIN'S ads and caller/cuer listings of \$456.00 and two Doin's subscriptions and expenses totaled \$30.00 (send subscriptions to Doin's Circulation. A check was given to the Federation for \$456.00; leaving a balance of \$100.00.

Promotions: Fred & Carolyn Goucher: August 7, Columbia Bicentennial celebration dancing from 2:00 to 2:50; would like to have one or two squares to dance. Will have post cards promoting square dancing to hand out.

Member Services Committee: Fred & Carolyn Goucher. No report.

State Festival Site Screening: Madeline & Merle Hall. The committee toured the Mathewson Exhibition Center & Lowell Mohler Hall for the purpose of using it for the 2022 state festival and recommends it to the Federation for approval.

Insurance Coordinator: Edythe Weber reporting: Financial Report: Beginning balance as of February 1, 2021 \$1,527.15, total income of \$1,220.35 and expenses of \$2,260.75 leaves an ending balance on June 30, 2021, of \$486.75. Has a small deposit to make and a check to write

to USDA that will be reported at the next meeting.

1,059 dancers are insured through Missouri Federation and 256 dancers are insured through other federations for a total of 1,315 Missouri dancers in 44 clubs.

- If your club has a new insurance person, please let me know their contact information: Name, Address, Phone and Email. I will make sure they have the instructions on how to use the enrollment portal. It would also be helpful to them if you were to take the time to train them from your end.

- You should never delete a dancer from your roster after initial enrollment.
- The 2021 Insurance premium is \$4.85 per dancer
- Remember to complete an accident report form for ALL accidents that occur at your
 dance, even if they appear minor at the time. It is hard to remember who, what, when,
 where and how weeks later; documentation at the time is best. Keep them on file and
 submit as needed.
- If you need additional information or have questions, please contact me. If I do not know the answer, I know who to contact to get it.

Travel Missouri: Jim Marron reporting. No report.

Blue Bird Coordinator: Madeline Hall. No report.

Webmaster: Dan Wheeler reporting. The 2021 Missouri Festival Committee needs to check the website to see that the website has all the pages that should be there.

When you request changes to the website, it helps if you tell me where the changes need to be made. Club information, schedule changes & E-mail changes are in a database and I can find them easily, but address & phone number changes can appear in many places. I receive many change requests where the requester fails to mention the club name.

As clubs start having dances, it is more important than ever that you keep me informed of your schedules and dances.

I have received information on individual dances, but not many actual schedules.

There has been a major problem with the websites I do. Our provider has made a change in the way he requires the code be written. It has to do with the code I use on the drop down menus on all the club websites. I have rewritten the code so that it works and I have started updating all the club websites. In the meantime, I have found a work around that seems to be working with the club websites that haven't yet been updated.

If you notice the drop down menus on your club's website are not working properly, let me know and I will fix them.

The new drop down menus look slightly different, but I doubt that you would ever notice the

difference unless you had the old pages and new pages side by side.

Historian: Dan Wheeler reporting. No report.

License Plate: Catherine McLemore reporting. Since last meeting in April, I have had one new license plate request for two years, ten two-year renewals, and one one-year renewal. Therefore, I collected \$575, and given out \$230 in rebates. This leaves me with a balance of \$758.36.

Please encourage all square dancers to consider getting these license plates. They really do attract attention to the activity.

USDA: Edythe Weber reporting. The meeting was held Wednesday, June 23 from Jackson, Mississippi. The combo in-person/Zoom meeting went well. We had a little trouble with hearing the Zoom people; but we did the best we could do.

I (Edythe) was elected to USDA Secretary for 2021-2022.

Jim and I were presented with a very long presentation.

I think our delegates should report on the meeting.

ARTS: Edythe Weber reporting. Our hybrid in-person/Zoom meeting went well on Sunday, June 27, 2021 at the Visit Jackson meeting room; 14 people were in attendance.

Nothing much going on at this time. We are hope to have more about the video project this fall.

District Presidents' Report: Robert Turner, Southeast District president, reporting. Square Dancer of the Year Committee has only received one nomination; deadline for submitting is August 1.

Wood River, Illinois club St. Louis District will be closing at the end of the year.

Northeast and Southeast have 100% of their clubs dancing and most of the clubs in the Northwest District are dancing.

Planning to have the dates and locations for 2022 state meetings at the October meeting.

Youth and Children's: Merle Hall reporting. Youth (4-H) groups that shut down during Covid have not wanted to get started again.

Mexico and Macon public schools are interested in teaching the square dance curriculum this fall if Merle will help them.

4-H group in Kirksville wants to restart lessons in October.

Mo Fed Scholarship: Bob & Shirley Turner. No report.

2021 State Festival: Dave Shafer. 100 registrations have been received; shirts and ribbons have been ordered and will be in shortly. A hand quilted quilt will be raffled; tickets and a picture were handed out to districts present for their help in promoting the festival and the raffle.

He read a list of committee chairmen. Reminded attendees of the Saturday evening meal.

2022 State Festival: Penny Byers. Dave & Penny Byers and Gary & Gay Spencer are the co-chairmen for the 2022 Festival to be held October 7-9. Most of the committee chairmen have been secured, the theme, colors, and shirt design have been selected.

Committee is recommending keeping registrations fees and advertising rates the same.

The Convention & Visitors Bureau is working with us to promote the festival and will work with merchants, especially restaurants, to see if they will stay open later in the evening during the festival.

The caller and cuer who were contracted for the 2022 festival are unable to fulfill the contract as they had been contracted for the third weekend. Dan Preedy from Washington state and Bob & Gerry Tevlin have been contracted as the caller and cuer for the 2022 festival.

Old Business:

Cathy Hall gave the second reading of the proposed changes presented at the April meeting to the Constitution and Bylaws. (See wording at the end of the minutes).

President Byers asked for a vote on accepting the proposed Constitution Bylaws change. Vote was in the majority to approve.

President Byers talked about the work of the Budget Deficit Committee appointed at the last meeting with the purpose of reporting today. The committee members are Rosa Davis, Cathy Hall, Bob Turner, and President Byers.

Cathy Hall presented an amended budget for the rest of this year and looking forward to next year reflecting the proposed changes they are recommending and copies were handed out; it was also posted in the reports link on the website. Vote taken and the Standing Rule change was approved. (See wording at the end of the minutes.)

Fred Goucher reported for the Nominating Committee. The committee is recommending the Federation consider the feasibility of changing the length of the terms of the officers.

Following discussion, President Byers will appoint a committee to look at the length of terms of officers, etc.

The committee is recommending carrying over this year's officers to 2022; all have agreed to continue. Vote will be taken at the October meeting.

Dave Shafer reported on the Show Case of Ideas at the 2021 National Convention and shared information regarding missing items we are supposed to have and to be on the lookout for them.

Debbie Moffitt, Beaux & Belles, Northeast District asked about their reimbursement for hosting this meeting. They will be reimbursed under the old policy of \$200 for hosting a meeting.

Carolyn Goucher, Promotions Committee Chairman, asked for clubs who have yard signs promoting square dancing to let them know how many they have on hand as the committee is trying to get an idea of how many are still around or might be needed.

George Roth made a motion for the Federation to adopt the USDA Proclamation for Jim and Edythe Weber be entered in our permanent records. Motion seconded and carried.
