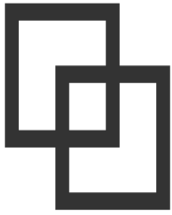

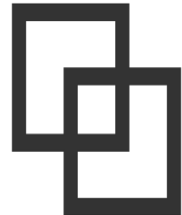

(1931 - 2023)



Barbara H. Turner passed away January 25, 2023. She was a member of the West County Spinners since 1984. She and her husband, Dave, were extremely active in the square dancing community, local, state and nationally.

As a West County Spinner, they held office as the club treasurer and president. She never missed a year as an angel to those learning to square dance. They served on the Board for the National Square Dance Convention®, held in St. Louis in 1993. As Services Chairman, their wide-spread responsibilities included room preparations, communications, food services, first aid, security and sounding the dance halls for the more than 18,800 attendees.

Barbara and Dave served as the Presidents of the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs in 2002, having previously held the offices of Treasurer, Secretary, Third, Second and First Vice-President. Barbara served as the Federation Parliamentarian for several years after going out of office. In 2004 and 2010 they were co-chairmen of the Missouri State Festival. They served as the Representative-At-Large for the St. Louis Metro Square and Round Dance Association and served as volunteers in civic and charitable organizations in their community for many years.

Barbara was very instrumental in getting square dancing recognized as the State Folk Dance in 1985 and working for several years in successfully getting our Square Dance License Plates approved. She and the committees met with state legislators and many other state officials in leading these two programs to successful implementation.

Barbara and Dave also enjoyed camping, traveling and time with family. She also was a volunteer docent at the Gateway Arch for many years. Shortly after Dave's passing in 2015, Barbara moved to Florida and quickly became an active volunteer for several area organizations. A few years ago, she moved back to Missouri, residing in a senior living residence in Farmington to be near family. She and Dave combined their love of square dancing with their zeal for community service. She and Dave touched many lives and will be fondly and long remembered.

It was Barbara's wish to be donated for medical research. A celebration of life was held February 2 at Schrader Funeral Home & Crematory in Ballwin, Mo.

3. Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arch.
4. On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an emergency call for aid.

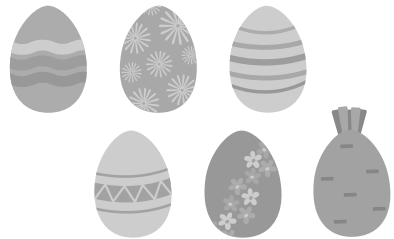
