Caller/Cuer Scholarship

The Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs is announcing a Scholarship program for Callers and Cuers. A total of \$500 is available, per year, to assist in the costs of attending caller or cuer training. If more than one caller or cuer requests reimbursement, the \$500 will be prorated among those requesting the funds.

Criteria for receiving scholarship funds are:

1. Show proof of successfully completing an acknowledged calling or cueing school within the past 12 months.
2. Be a member of an acknowledged caller or cuer association, CALLERLAB, American Callers Association or ROUNDALAB.
3. Reside within a district of the Missouri Federation and/or be affiliated with a club of the Missouri Federation.
4. Show proof of BMI/ASCAP licensing.
5. Provide Business card or desired ad layout for the *Showme Doins*.

Send all requested information to the President of the Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs for presentation of the request at the next available State Board of Directors meeting.

Call Ahead FIRST Before Traveling to a Dance

Severe weather, e.g. snow, icy roads, and other weather events, such as Flooding, Thunder Storms, Tornadoes or other concerns may cause the club you plan to visit to cancel their dance.

During weather events, or if a weather event is forecast, call the club contact ahead of time to ensure that the dance you are planning to attend is either going to happen, or has been cancelled. You can find a list of club contacts at the back of the Show-Me Doin's.

If you know that road closures may be a problem due to winter or flooding conditions, go to the State Traffic and Road Closure on the internet to find out the condition or your planned route.

REMEMBER: Never attempt to drive through flooded low water crossings or other waters on the highway.

We want to see you across a square. So, travel safely and sanely.

EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID

What Should You Do?

When someone falls at a dance, there are certain procedures that should be followed as a matter of safety. Do you know what they are?

First, if the accident happens while dancing a tip, the ECMA (Emergency Call for Medical Aid) procedures should be followed. In short, 1 dancer should attend to the fallen dancer while the other six dancers in the square form a perimeter around them and raise their arms while holding hands to signal to the host club that there is a medical emergency. One individual from the host club should determine if it is necessary to call 911 and if it is, they should place the call so that the exact address can be given to the dispatcher. Emergency services are busy enough without receiving a call from everyone in the room with a cell phone, most of whom wouldn't know the specific address.

If the ECMA procedures are implemented, the caller should continue with the dance as though nothing has happened so that not every dancer in the room rushes to the side of the fallen dancer. This often impedes the efficiency of emergency services or needed assistance.

If the fallen dancer thinks they can get up, then they should be allowed to make that attempt on their own. If they need assistance to steady themselves as they stand up, that's different than people trying to lift them to their feet. Everyone wants to be helpful but not everyone knows the proper body mechanics needed to assist someone to their feet. Not only could they cause further injury to the fallen dancer, but they could also injure themselves in the attempt.

If the fallen dancer is unable to bear weight on their own, then it is imperative that someone call 911. Once the First Responders have arrived, they can use their expertise to evaluate the injured dancer and determine if transport by ambulance is necessary or if it would be safe for them to be transported by private vehicle.

Every club should have a copy of the "Club Accident Report" available at each dance. (A copy is available on the Square Dance Missouri Website) Whether or not you think medical care will be needed, this report should be completed. If the injured party does seek medical care, the form should be filed with USDA within 48 hours.

If you have any questions regarding the proper procedure for filing a claim, check with the Insurance Coordinator.

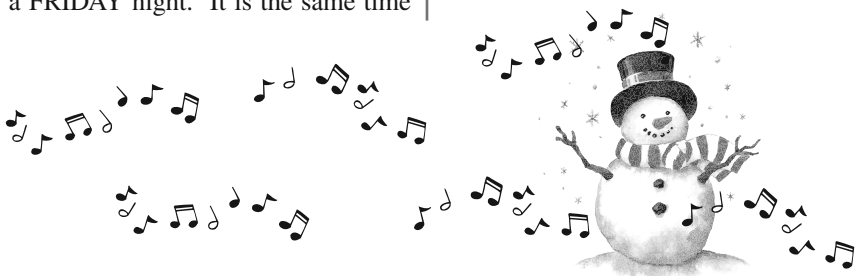

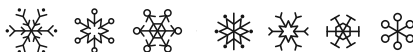

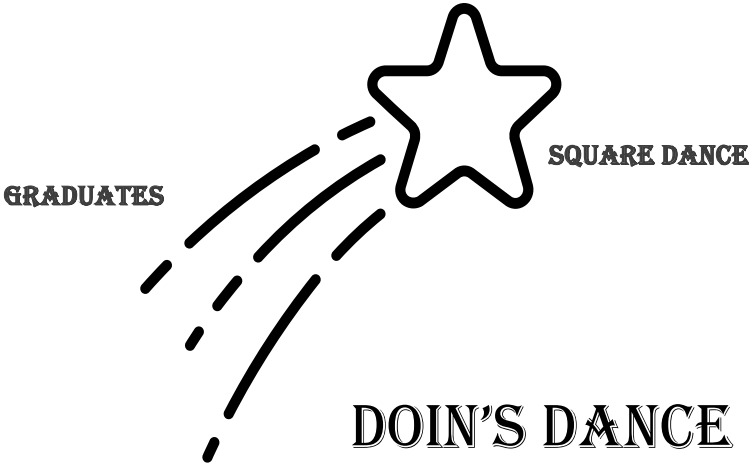
