Caller/Cuer Scholarship

The Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs is announcing a Scholarship program for Callers and Cuers. A total of \$500 is available, per year, to assist in the costs of attending caller or cuer training. If more than one caller or cuer requests reimbursement, the \$500 will be prorated among those requesting the funds. Criteria for receiving scholarship funds are:

- 1. Show proof of successfully completing an acknowledged calling or cueing school within the past 12 months.
- 2. Be a member of an acknowledged caller or cuer association, CALLERLAB, American Callers Association or ROUNDALAB.
- 3. Reside within a district of the Missouri Federation and/or be affiliated with a club of the Missouri Federation.
- 4. Show proof of BMI/ASCAP licensing.

Send all requested information to the President of the Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs for presentation of the request at the next available State Board of Directors meeting.



- Remaining dancers join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arch.
- 4. On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an emergency call for aid.
