To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents, or Club Presidents or by visiting www.squaredancemissouri.com). Each time a participant who has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district, he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.

ARE YOU A 100% DOIN'S CLUB?

Have you ever wondered what a 100% Doin's Club is? Did you even know there was such a thing? Do you want to become one? Well, here is what it's all about!

Every member of your club (one per household) pays for a subscription to the Show Me Doin's magazine. The program really does not have a year, since subscriptions are taken all year long and are paid one year at a time. You just have to be a paid subscriber to the Show Me Doin's.

How do you get them to do that? Well, there are a couple ways:

- Put the subscription rate of \$15 in your club dues. Everybody pays
 it. Everybody completes the subscription form, even if there are no
 changes to their current address, phone or email. The club
 treasurer sends a club check to the Doin's Circulation manager
 (Penny Byers) with the completed subscription forms. Easy as pie.
- 2. If you don't want to do that, then somebody in your club (maybe the treasurer when they collect dues or when new members join) asks each member of the club if they subscribe to the Doin's. Make it a question on your club application form. Make a list of the yes's and no's. If everybody does, then send that list to Penny. If you get new members later, do that same thing again and send her that new list. If there are questions, be assured we will contact you. (We don't need the list unless everybody is a YES.)

Sounds pretty simple, doesn't it! Talk to your club members about this. **WE** would **LOVE** to present **MORE CLUBS** with our **100% DANGLE** each year. We usually do it at the Doin's Dance on Sunday following the festival weekend in October. But if you are not there, which would be sad, we will make sure you get it!



EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID

- When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/her.
- Remaining dancers join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3. Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arch.
- On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an emergency call for aid.






